Lead Organization	Sweet Home School District
Goal #1	Reclaim positive trajectory of student success post-pandemic with at least 90% of 9th graders on-track towards graduation.
Short-Term Outcome	Student success advocates are reinstated for 9th grade student weekly mentoring and grade monitoring. 9th grade success team is meeting once a month to review data and student supports. Study skills, technology and careers will be incorporated into the mandatory 9th grade class.
Long-Term Outcome	The overall 9th grade on-track data will increase by 15% with the largest increase seen in students with disabilities.
Goal #2	Reclaim positive trajectory of student success post-pandemic with at least 85% graduation rate.
Short-Term Outcome	Systemic and accessible programs are in place for credit recovery, mental health counseling and student support.
Long-Term Outcome	Graduation rates will increase 3-5% each year.
Goal #3	Students will document and track post-secondary plans following graduation and will move along a deliberate path through school toward their preferred next steps in college or career.
Short-Term Outcome	Teachers and counselors actively encourage students who are members of groups of students not typically engaged in advanced coursework or career and technical courses to pursue these paths in accord with their post-secondary plans, as expressed in the student's education plan and profile.
Long-Term Outcome	Student enrollment in advanced coursework and career and technical courses will increase by 20% with the largest increase seen in students with disabilities.
Dropout Prevention Activity #1	Staffing: Re-Engagement Specialist, Essential Skills Coordinator/Grad Coach, 9th Grade Success Coach and staffing (outside contracted hours) for credit recovery activities including winter/summer school, after school Homework Hub and individualized student tutoring.
