Goal #1	90% of students will be on-track to graduate by spring of 2022 and 95% of students by 2023.
Short-Term Outcome	Ninth grade success team (teachers and relevant support staff) are meeting regularly, looking at data, student supports are tracked for effectiveness and students and families are involved in the evaluation of those supports. Development of a middle school - high school bridge program to help support the on track team goals. Increase 9th grade on track especially in the Students from racial or ethnic groups that have historically experienced academic disparities, Students navigating houselessness and foster care, Students experiencing poverty focal groups.
Long-Term Outcome	9th grade on track will increase by 10%. Graduation rate will increase by 10%, mirroring the increase with 9th grade on track.
Goal #2	Continue to increase the number of students that are accessing CTE and advanced classes on campus.
Short-Term Outcome	Teachers actively encourage students who are members of groups of students not typically engaged in advanced coursework or career and technical courses to pursue these paths in accord with their post-secondary plans, as expressed in the student's education plan and profile, especially the Students navigating houselessness and foster care, Students experiencing poverty focal groups. Increased number of students taking CTE and advanced classes. Increased number of middle school students taking high school credit classes. Increased number of opportunities to work with local industry in partnerships.
Long-Term Outcome	Middle school students will begin to take exploration CTE courses to help provide an earlier pathway to a career for them. More students will be placed in career internships that closely match their career interests. Increased graduation rate
Goal #3	85% of students will be regular attenders by spring of 2022 and 90% of students by 2023.
Short-Term Outcome	Creation and implementation of advisory SEL curriculum. Creation of alternative class choices and modalities to meet the needs of all students. Implementation of program to increase interests, clubs, activities, etc. to spark student interest.
Long-Term Outcome	Regular attenders will increase by 10% - 20%. Increased graduation rate Increased CTE completers
Dropout Prevention Activity #1	The 9th Grade Success team will continue meeting every 2 weeks in the 2021-22 school year, to improve the economically disadvantaged students on track and graduation rates . The 9GS team will initially focus on individual students using available data sources.

Dropout Prevention Activity #2	Teachers in grades 8 through 12 will be trained in the use of the Data Warehouse by fall 2021 with additional training opportunities throughout the 2021-22 school year. 9GS teams and teachers will get trained in SEL curriculum and implement it starting in 2021-22 school year.

Dropout Prevention Activity #3	Continued funding for administrator who focuses on ninth grade on track and middle school transition initiatives.
Goal(s) this activity addresses	Goal 1 , Goal 3
Career Technical Education Activity #1	In 2021-22 through 2022-23 certified staff will be selected and certified as CTE instructors in the areas of Graphic Design, Natural Resources-Fish Hatchery Operations, 3D Printing-CnC Operations, Robotics (ROV) and Welding and Automotive. We will continue to look for staff that can be dual certified in CTE in order to strengthen and expand our programs. This will help with staff salaries in CTE courses as well.
Goal(s) this activity addresses	Goal 2 , Goal 3
Career Technical Education Activity #2	The district finished the construction of a new CTE facility in January 2020.. For the 21-22 school year we will installing the airline and adding industry standard machines. We will continue to support the Natural Resources program of study and fish hatchery maintenance. The graphic design program will also need supplies such as large format printer ink and raw materials.

Career Technical Education Activity #3	We hired an Autos and Welding instructor at the beginning of the 2019-20 school year. A portion of this position will be supported with HSS funds.
