- If a 60 day deadline falls on a Saturday, Sunday or federal holiday, the due date is the next business day. Claims in Error Status due to the extended due date will be manually approved.
- In a leap year:
 - *60 day deadline = March 31
 - **60 day deadline = February 29
- Downward revisions have no due date. The revision needs to be submitted with the next original claim. Example: If a downward revision to a September Claim is discovered in May, the September claim would need to be revised when the May original is submitted.
- One time exception If you fail to file an original or upward revision within the prescribed timelines, a request for a One-time exception can be made in writing to ODE–Child Nutrition Programs. A sponsor may only have a one-time exception in a 36 month period per program (NSLP, SBP, CACFP, and SFSP).
- Claim exceptions for late claims due to circumstances beyond your control flood, fire, technology crash - may be granted without the 36-month period per program restriction. An exception request must be made in writing to ODE-Child Nutrition Programs. These exceptions are then requested by the ODE on behalf of the sponsor to USDA Western Region.
