Their conventionally grown strawberries are grown in San Diego County and Ventura County and their organic strawberries are grown in Monterey County. All of Sheri's family members have a specific job on the farm. Sheri's job is working the farmers' markets. She loves selling her berries directly to customers because she gets to talk to all of the people who visit the Williamson Farms stand. Sheri says that growing up on a farm was fun. "You don't think of it as work when you get to drive a tractor, especially when you're a little kid!" Sheri says the best thing about being a farmer is working for herself and being able to see all of the people who appreciate her hard work. Being a California farmer makes her feel like she's giving back because she's providing good tasting, healthy food that's been grown in state rather than imported. Sheri's favorite time at the farmers' markets is when she knows her strawberries are at their peak color and sweetness.
