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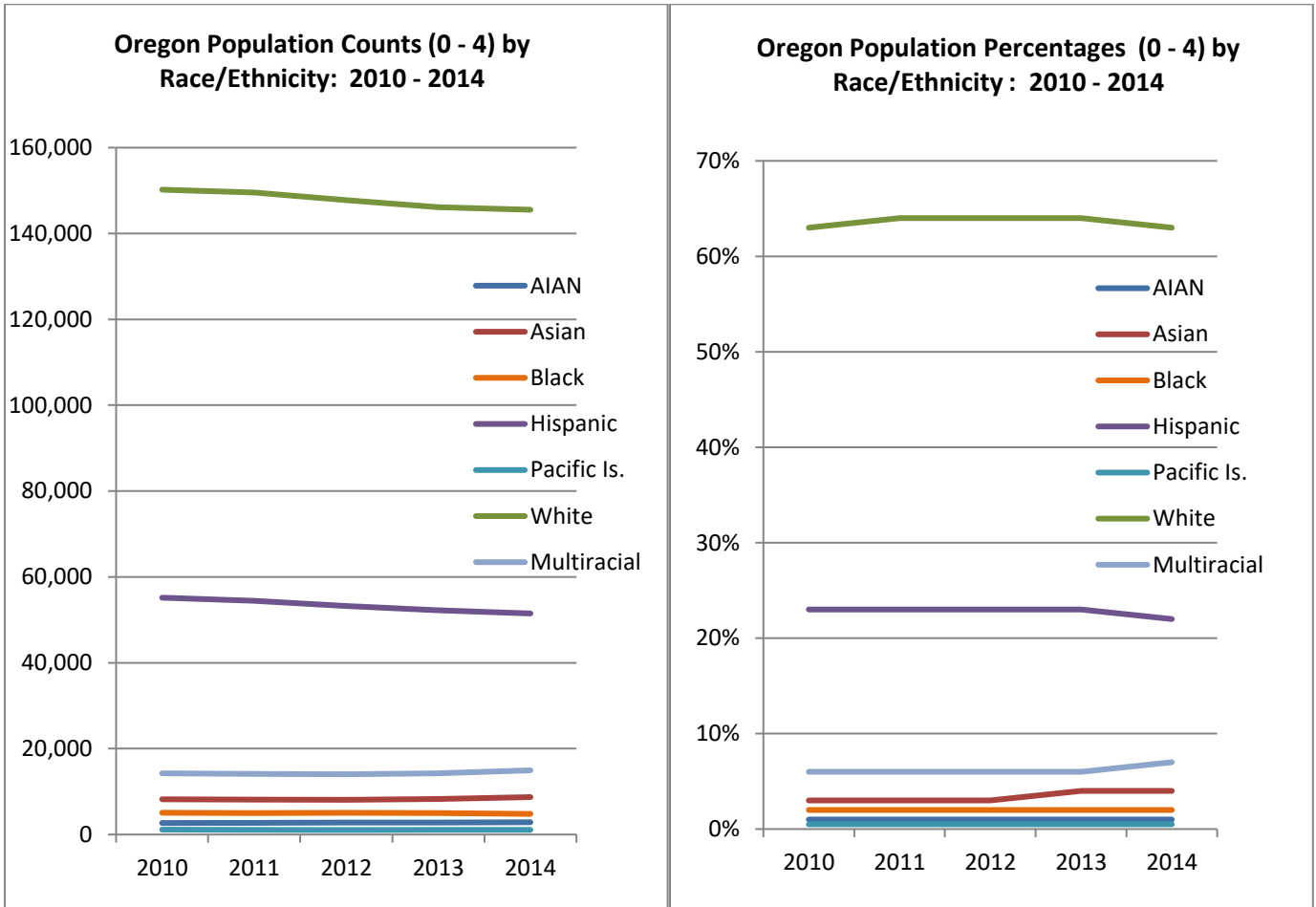

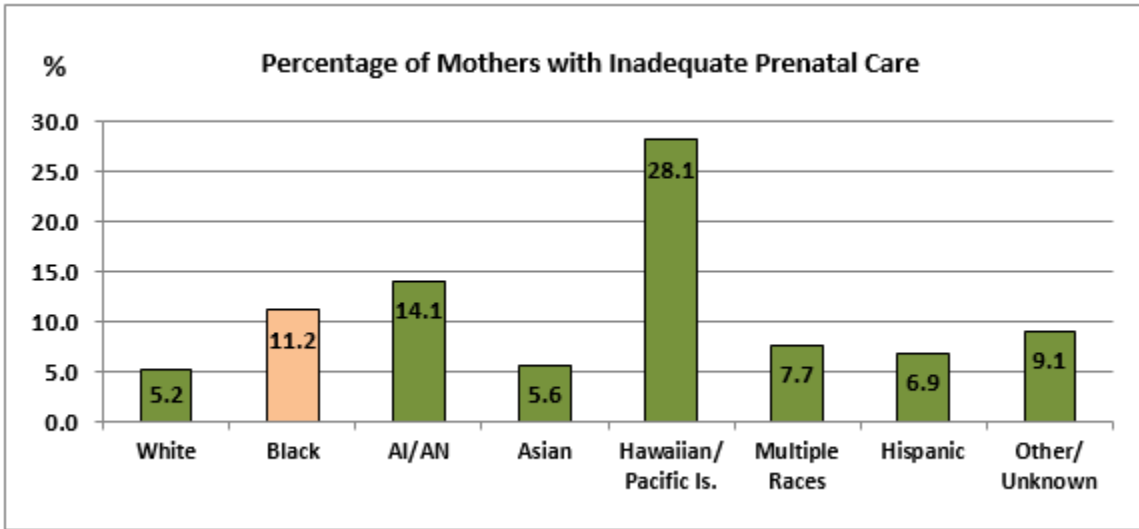

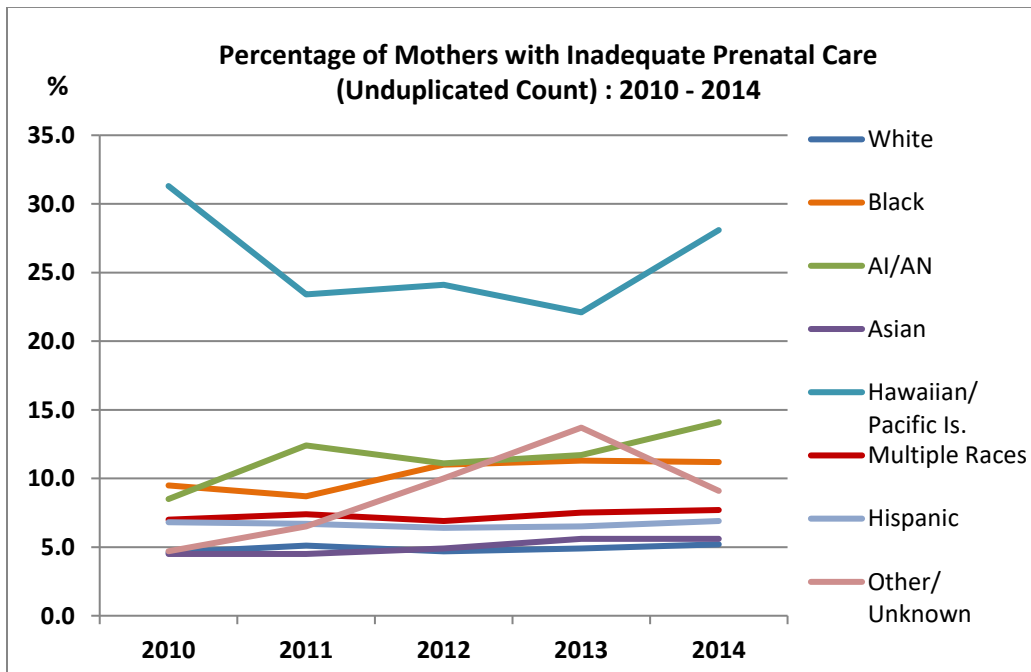

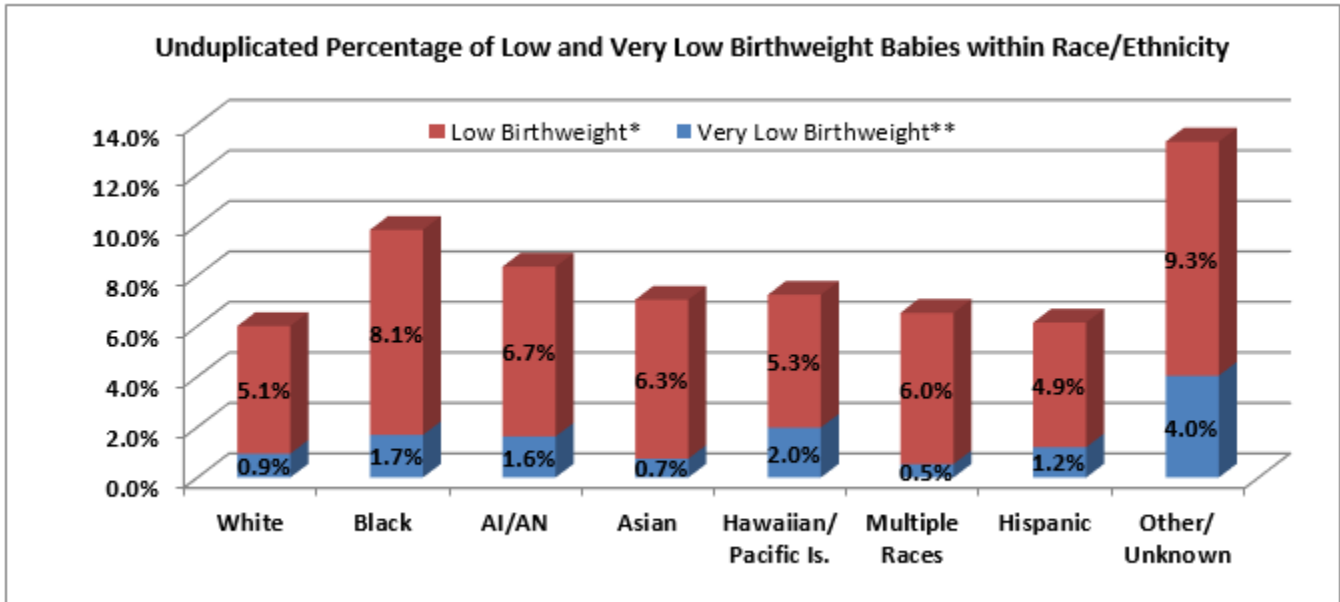

Two Year Olds Up-to Date Immunization Rates by Race/Ethnicity: 2010 – 2014

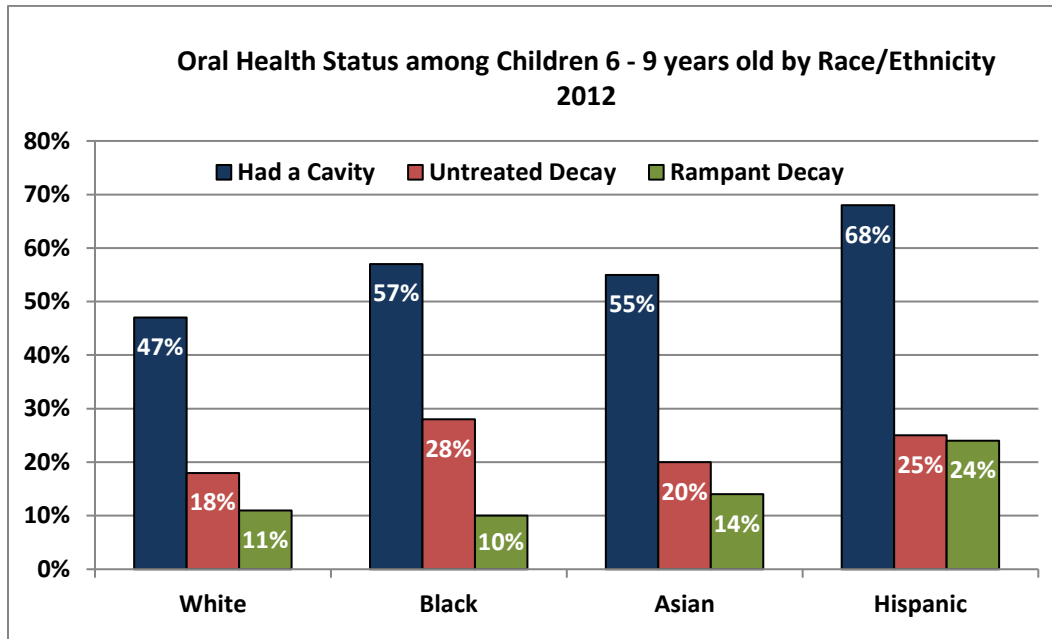

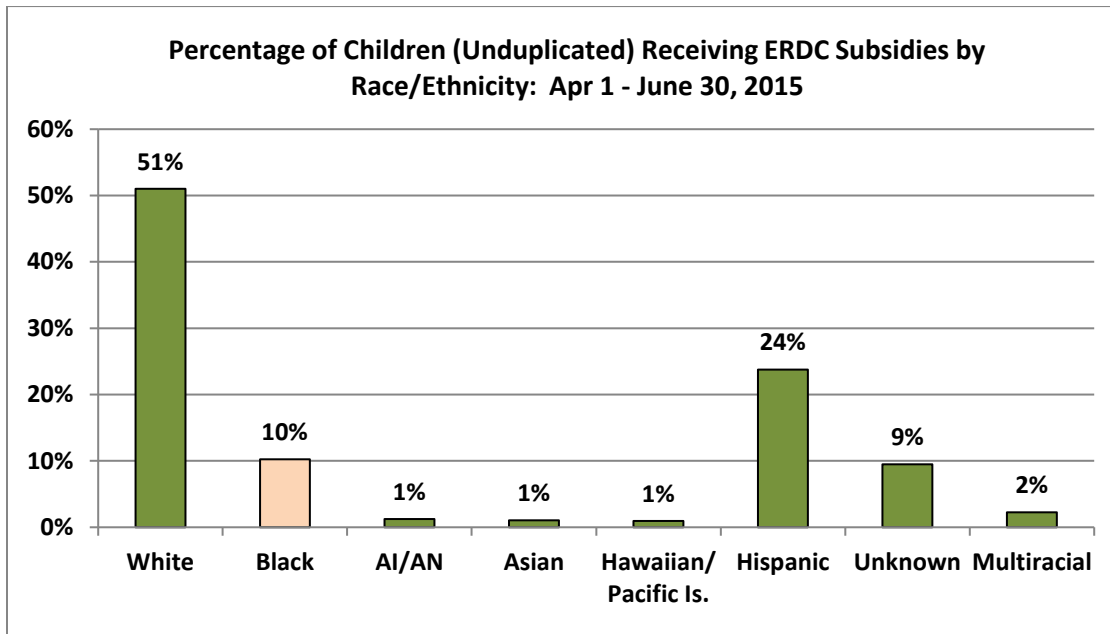
