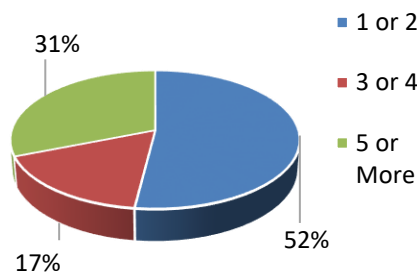

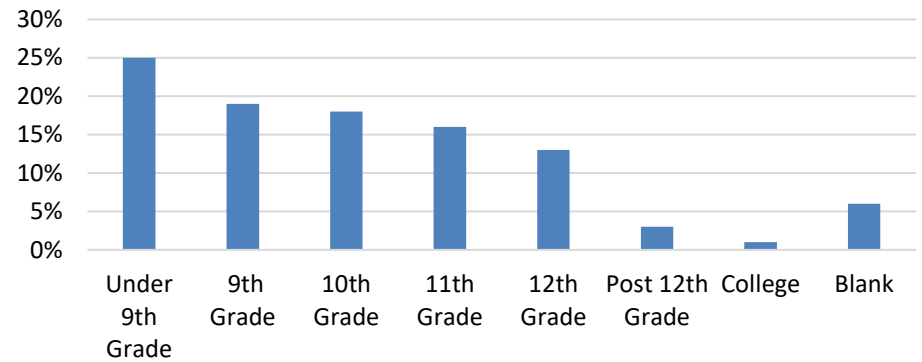

Number of services received (FY17)

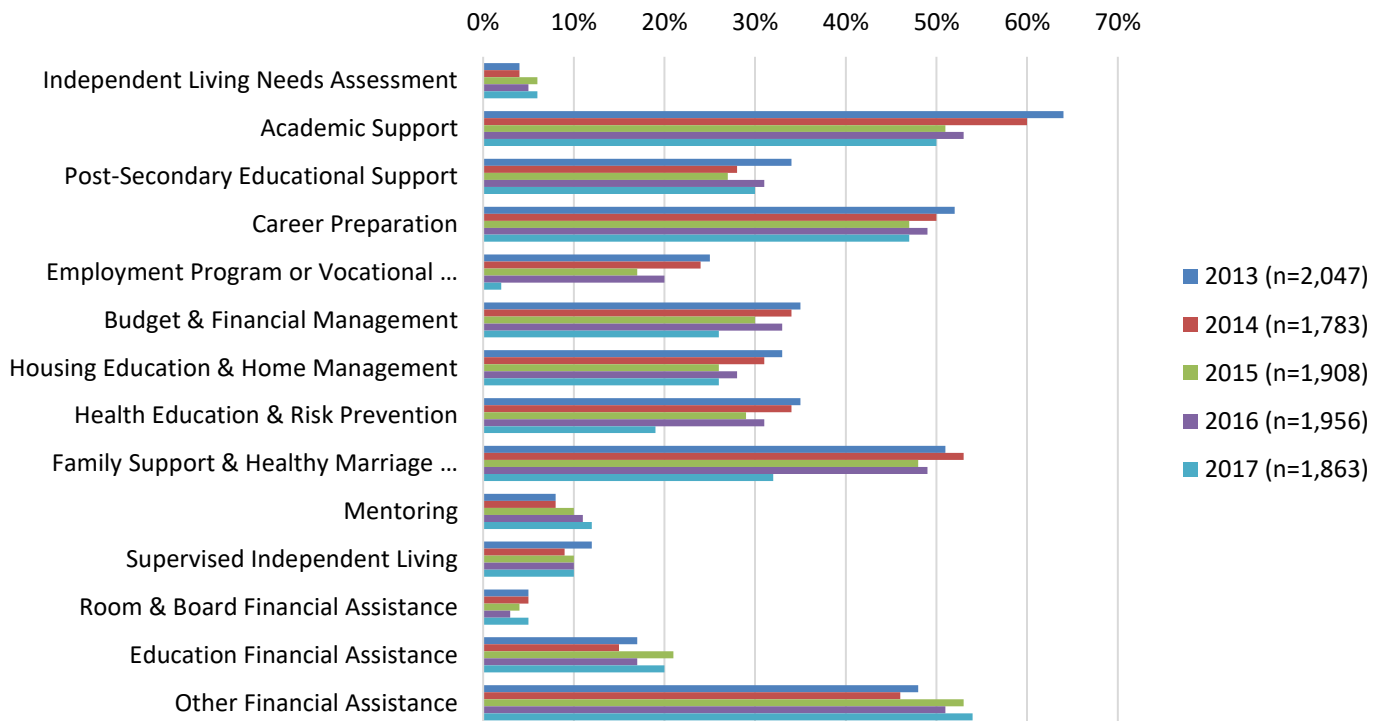


Education level of youth receiving (FY 17)

Percent of youth receiving each service (of total youth served)




