



## Project Overview

KEEP is an evidence-based support and skill enhancement program for foster and kinship parents of children ages 4-12 (KEEP Standard) and teens (KEEP SAFE). The evidence base for the KEEP model is extensive, including six randomized controlled trials, multiple independent evaluations of national and international implementations across varied cultural contexts, and numerous publications in peer-reviewed journals. Research outcomes include decreased placement disruptions, decreased child behavior and emotional problems, decreased caregiver stress, and increased foster parent retention, among others.

Since receiving legislative funding to implement statewide, with a contract period that began in November of 2019, KEEP has contracted with eight provider agencies, including two culturally-specific providers to directly support positive outcomes for populations disproportionately represented in the Oregon Child Welfare System. Six months into this contract period, the KEEP service area has expanded from three Oregon counties to all 36, including access for families in remote rural areas via Tele-KEEP. In response to COVID-19, the KEEP program quickly shifted all in-person KEEP groups to an online platform with little to no interruption in services. Since the issuance of the Stay Home Executive Order, KEEP implementation has continued on schedule by expanding service areas, training provider agencies who are certified in KEEP Standard in the delivery of KEEP SAFE, and developing affinity groups for foster/kin parents of LGBTQ+ and gender non-conforming youth and for foster/kin parents who are deaf or hard of hearing.

The KEEP program continues to develop partnerships across all DHS districts, with Every Child Oregon and the Oregon Foster Parent Association, with tribal leadership and community stakeholders. Together we are building community and sustainability through the provision of positive and effective supports for foster and kinship parents.

### Contracted Providers:

- Oregon Community Programs – Delivers KEEP in District 5
- Family Resource Center – Delivers KEEP in District 10
- Options Douglas – Delivers KEEP in District 6
- Family Nurturing Center – Delivers KEEP in District 8
- Oregon Social Learning Center Developments, Inc. -Delivers Tele-KEEP to all other districts
  - We are continuing to seek KEEP providers for Districts 4 and 7, but in the interim are providing KEEP via Tele-KEEP

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### **Enrollment**

As of April 30<sup>th</sup>, we have enrolled 537 foster and kinship families in KEEP. Of those, 326 were enrolled in the six-month contract period that began in November 2019.

### **Upcoming Trainings:**

- 5-day training for new KEEP Group Leaders at Centro Cultural: May 25-29
- 3-day training in KEEP SAFE (adolescents) for Options PDX and Oregon Community Programs: May 26-28
- 5-day training for new KEEP Group Leaders at NAYA: June 10-12, 15-16

### **Certifications:**

*Certified Group leaders have successfully led three groups, demonstrate consistent model fidelity, and participate in coaching monthly rather than weekly.*

- Three new certified KEEP Group Leaders at Options PDX

### **Updates on Culturally-Specific and Affinity KEEP Groups**

- New Spanish-language Tele-KEEP group starting May 14<sup>th</sup>
- Currently recruiting families for a LGBTQIA+ affinity group with a tentative start date of May 26<sup>th</sup>
- NAYA to begin KEEP delivery for tribal foster/kin families in June
- Centro Cultural to begin KEEP delivery for Spanish-speaking foster/kin parents in June
- Currently putting systems in place for providing KEEP to foster/kin parents who are deaf or hard-of-hearing
