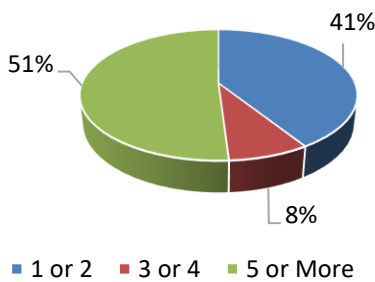

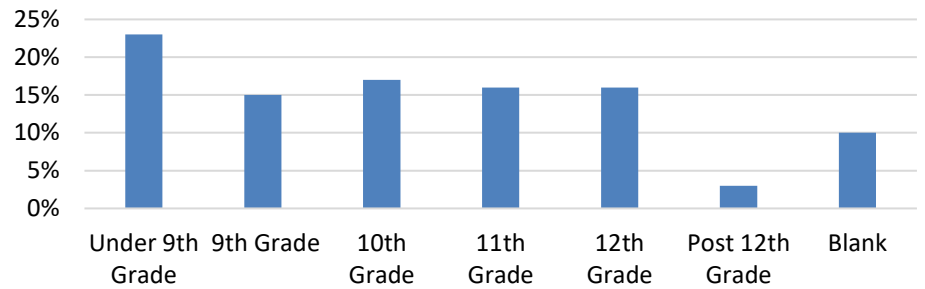

Number of services received (FY20)

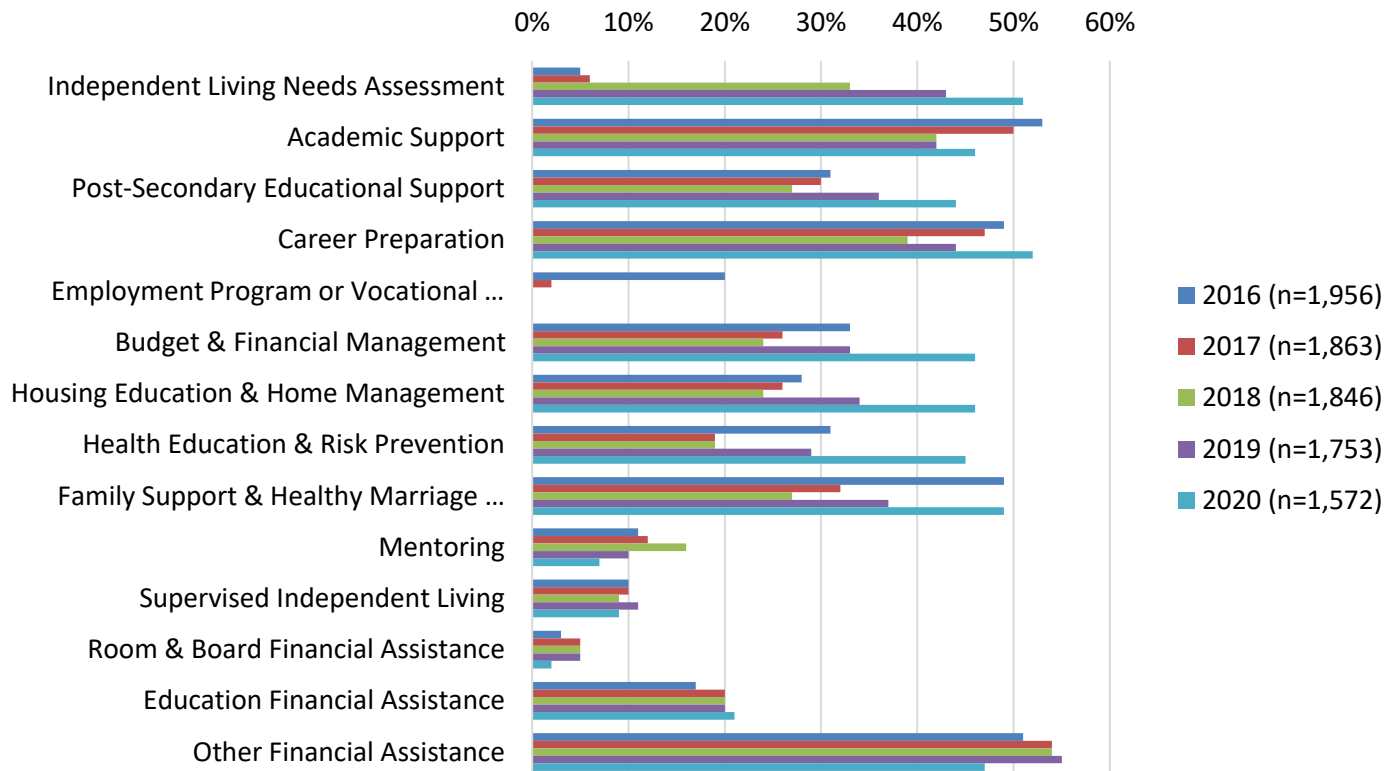


Education level of youth receiving services (FY 20)

Percent of youth receiving each service (of total youth served)

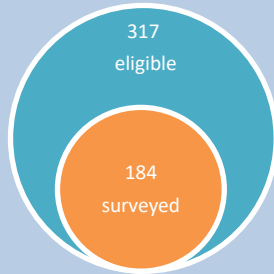
