Hello!

We are happy to tell you about an option to find a homecare worker, personal support worker or personal care attendant (in-home care provider). **The service is called Carina.** Carina is a free care matching service that helps people quickly find in-home care providers.

Getting started on Carina is easy.

Here is how it works:

Register:

After you register, you can use the search and filter tools to find an in-home care provider near you.

Message:

You can send messages, chat by phone and meet in person for a screening interview and final interview.

Match:

Once you find the right fit, get approval from your case manager, services coordinator or personal agent to get started with your new in-home care provider.
