### What is Employment Path?

Employment Path Services are services to provide learning and work experiences. It may include volunteer opportunities.

The goal of Employment Path Services is for an individual to develop general employment skills that may be used in an integrated job.

These are time limited services as outlined in your ISP, which means they can only be used until your goal has been met. Specific goals will be written into your ISP and will be reached through an ongoing person-centered planning process.

### Example:

Janice wants a community job where she gets to meet a lot of

new people, but needs to work on some skills – like handling cash and customer service. Her Service Coordinator connects her with Joe, an Employment Path Specialist.

Joe helps Janice get a chance to volunteer at a local bookstore and other small businesses. She also worked with Joe on answering phone calls and responding to questions.

After a few months of practicing, Janice is doing great and she is confident to take the next step of looking for her individual job!
