What is Job Development?

A Job Developer identifies job opportunities in the workplace where your skills match the employers need.

Job Development may include support with the application and interview process, and visits with potential employers.

Example:

Stephanie's Job Developer, Allison, meets with her regularly to talk about the type of job she would like and to learn about her strengths and interest. Allison has learned a lot about what Stephanie wants to do, or enjoys doing most.

Allison went with Stephanie to meet the owners of a few shops in her community. They learned about what the employers needed and began

to see where her skills would be a good match.

Allison practiced how to do interviews with Stephanie, and Stephanie became more comfortable answering the questions about herself. With practice, she learned skills to help her get the job she wants!
