### Top 10 Truck driver At Fault Errors:

1. Speed
2. Fail to Remain in Lane
3. Following too Close
4. Improper Lane Change
5. Fail to Yield Right of Way
6. Inattention
7. Improper Turn
8. Sleep/Fatigue
9. Disregard Sign
10. Improper Backing

### Top Ten Car Driver at Fault (versus CMV) Errors:

1. Following too closely
2. Fail to Remain in Lane
3. Fail to Yield Right of Way
4. Disregard Sign or Signal
5. Driving too Fast for conditions
6. Inattention
7. Improper Passing
8. Drinking Alcohol
9. Improper Turn
10. Sleep/Fatigue
