Workgroup Charter

Effective February 2020

I. Authority

Work group reports to the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) Health Policy & Analytics Division (HPA). Any recommendations needing CCO Pharmacy Director input, as agreed upon by the voting bodies, are moved forward to the Pharmaceutical and Therapy (P&T) Committee for presentation and consideration.

II. Scope/Purpose

The workgroup is a forum for OHA to work with CCOs to share input on pharmacy policies, discuss experiences and share best practices. The workgroup is also a forum for CCOs to collaborate around drug standards and strategies to:

- Share best practices;
- Review and provide input to HPA/OHA on policies and materials related to pharmacy standards and drug classes;
- Bring member engagement to the table when needed;
- Discuss safety and quality improvement;
- Support culturally and linguistically appropriate outreach, engagement and communication;
- Strategize on coordination of care as it relates to CCOs;
- Notify participants of law and policy changes impacting CCO pharmacy programs; and
- Promote stewardship of the healthcare dollar and high-value medication use.

III. Timing/Schedule

Usually the 1st Thursday of every even-numbered month (February, April, June, August, October, December).

IV. Co-chairs/Chair and Staff Resources

Co-chairs: elected by committee for one year, with an option of a second year

OHA: Pharmacy Program Policy Advisor or designee

V. Work Group Membership

Members of the workgroup will include pharmacy leadership from CCOs. OHA will participate if necessary for specific topics. Other interested stakeholders may also attend meetings and provide public comment.
