Fee-For-Service behavioral health fee schedule

- Provides information by code including rendering provider types
- Most of the proposed child-level CPT codes are listed in MH outpatient services tab or Applied Behavior Analysis tab
- Codes not listed in fee schedule:
 - Preventative Medicine Counseling
 - Multi-Family Group Training Session
 - Education and training for patient self-management by a qualified, nonphysician health care professional using a standardized curriculum, face-to-face with patient (could include caregiver/family)



Definitions for outpatient behavioral health services and provider types

As examples you'll find these provider types in the definitions (among many other definitions):

- Licensed health care professional
- Qualified mental health associate
- Qualified mental health professional
- Peer support specialist
- Peer wellness specialist



Provider enrollment

- MMIS provider enrollment portal is used for enrolling providers in Fee-For-Service
- If provider is enrolling as an encounter-only or CCOonly provider, the CCO supports enrollment on behalf of the provider
