RE: Oregon Health Authority Monthly Update on Ongoing and Emerging Issues

Dear Governor Brown:

This letter is the Oregon Health Authority's (OHA's) November 1st monthly issue update. We have one issues that has been resolved to communicate this month.

OHA's Issue Resolution Leadership Team and the Issue Resolution Project Team have been meeting jointly to provide leadership oversight and to ensure progress continues to be made in resolving identified issues. We are also continuing ongoing research and analysis into previously documented issues and documenting new issues. The Issues Log is attached and includes all documented issues. This cover memo provides detail related to new issues or material updates to existing issues. Issues that have previously been reported as resolved have been removed from the log.

Previously Documented Issues

Issue Number 021-17: Alignment of Federal Financial Reports – Budget Neutrality

Status: Resolved

Estimated Impact: No financial impact; change to federal reporting requirements only **Summary:** As previously communicated, the OHA provides various reports to the Cent

Summary: As previously communicated, the OHA provides various reports to the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid Services (CMS) to demonstrate compliance with federal requirements and ensure accurate federal funding. Two of these reports – CMS 64 and Schedule C – are not directly comparable because the CMS 64 reports all Medicaid expenditures (not just those associated with the 1115 Waiver) and the Schedule C reports only those expenditures associated with the 1115 Waiver based on the demonstration year shown on the CMS 64. The CMS 64 report is used to support OHA's claims for federal funding. CMS would like states with federal waivers to use Schedule C as the basis for reporting budget neutrality. The OHA has worked with CMS to convert the compliance and federal funding reports into the Schedule C format with confirmation from CMS that the conversion satisfies their requirements.
