# This is where we left off last time on communications and HTO Seeds

- **Communication Partners**– What organizations do we want to connect with?
  - How many organizations to connect with? To fund?
  - Included content: What should SEEDS pay for?
    - OHA could provide support through communications training
- **Their audience** – Who should the organizations reach?
- **Funding** –More organizations/ \$ or fewer organizations/ \$\$?
  - Total funding = \$\_\_\_\_\_ for 2023
  - Total funding = \$30/40K for 2022, spent ~\$17,500 – VICTORIA CHECK
