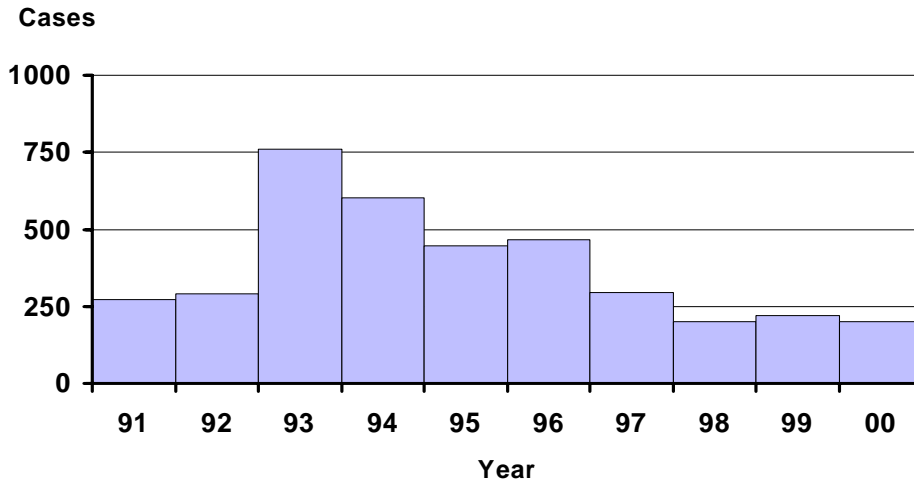

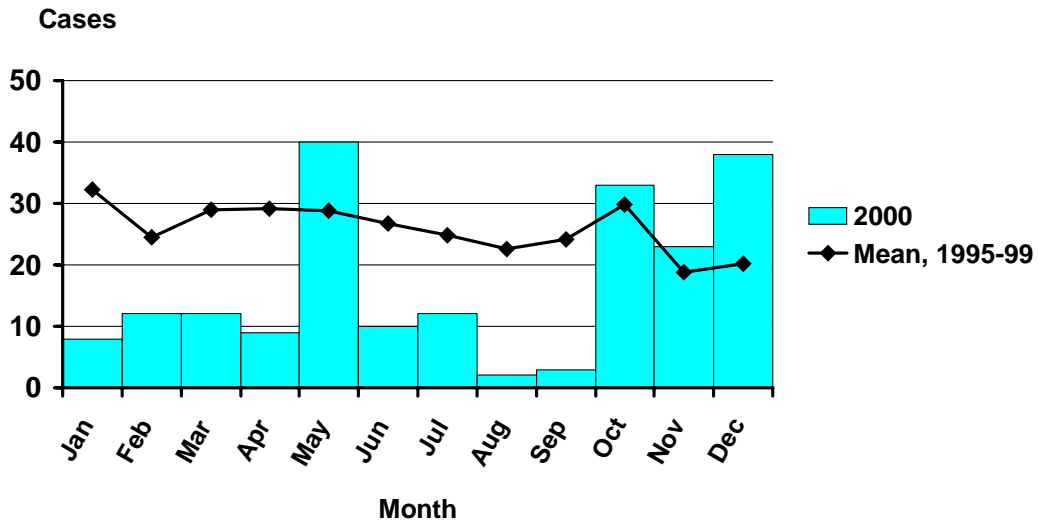

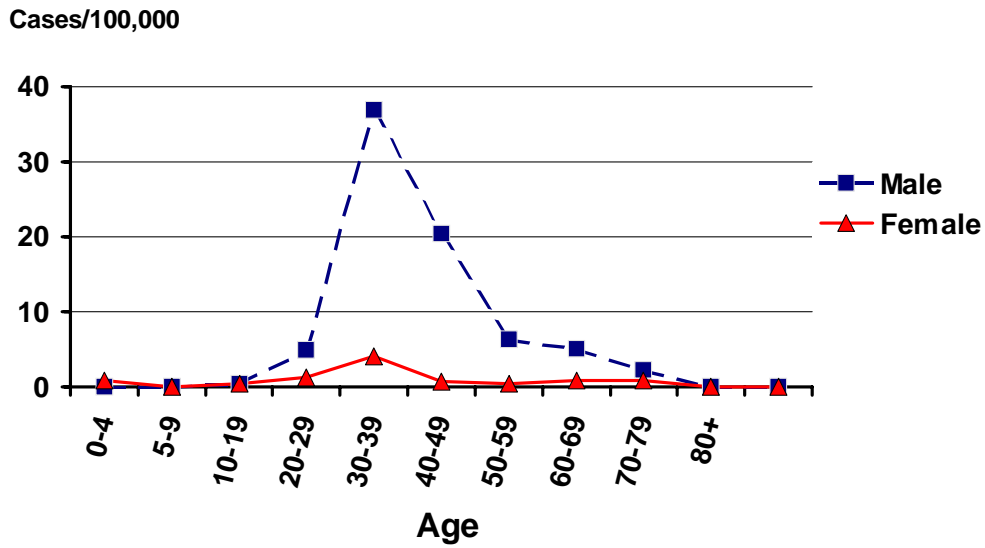
AIDS by Year Oregon, 1991-2000



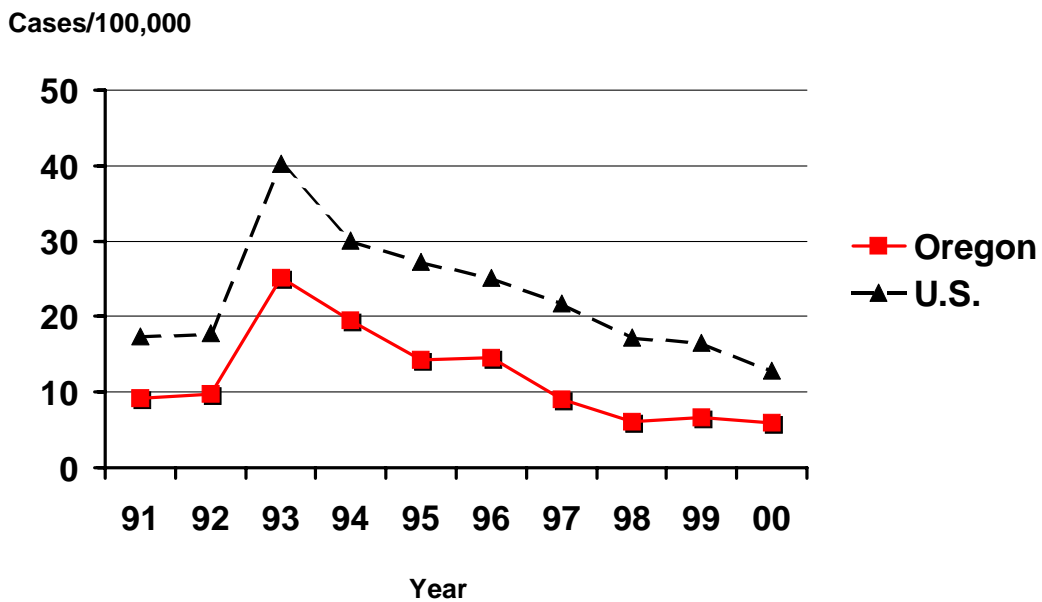
AIDS by Onset Month Oregon, 2000



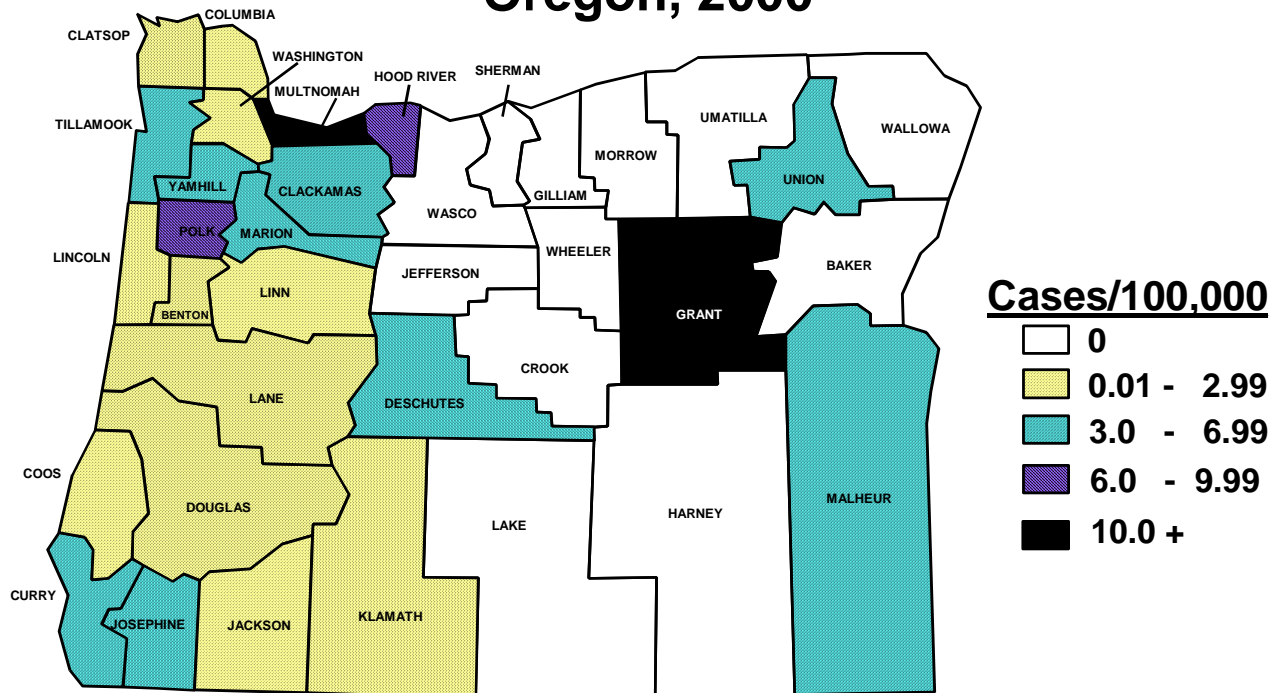
Incidence of AIDS by Age and Sex Oregon, 2000



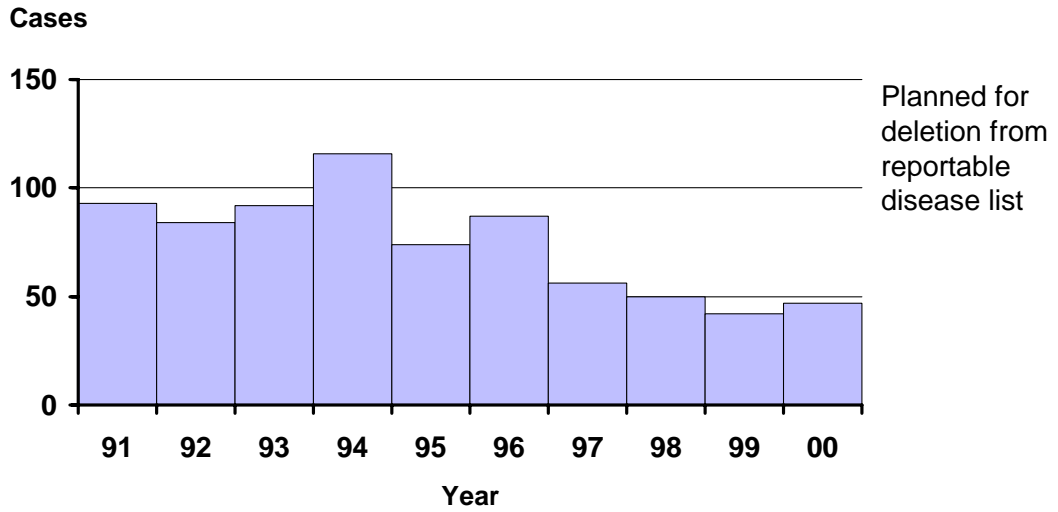
Incidence of AIDS Oregon vs. Nationwide 1991-2000



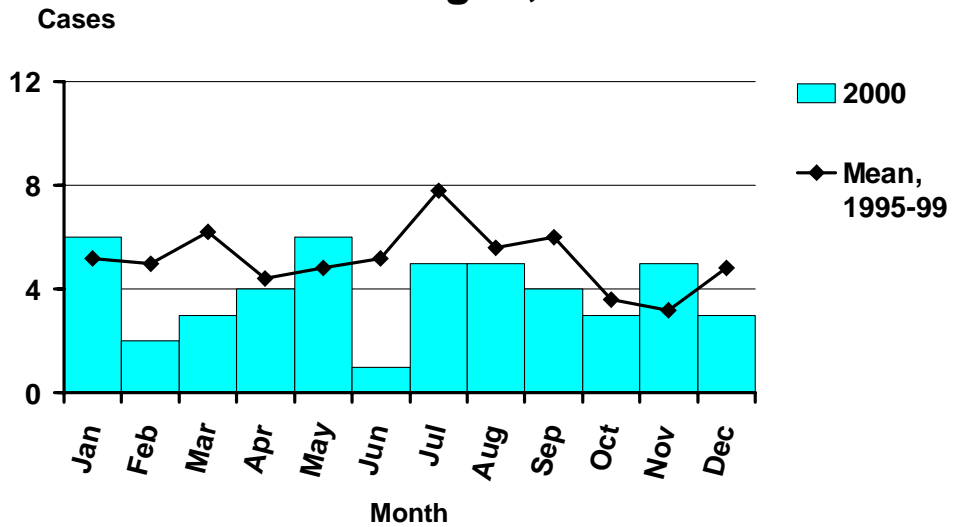
Incidence of AIDS by County Oregon, 2000



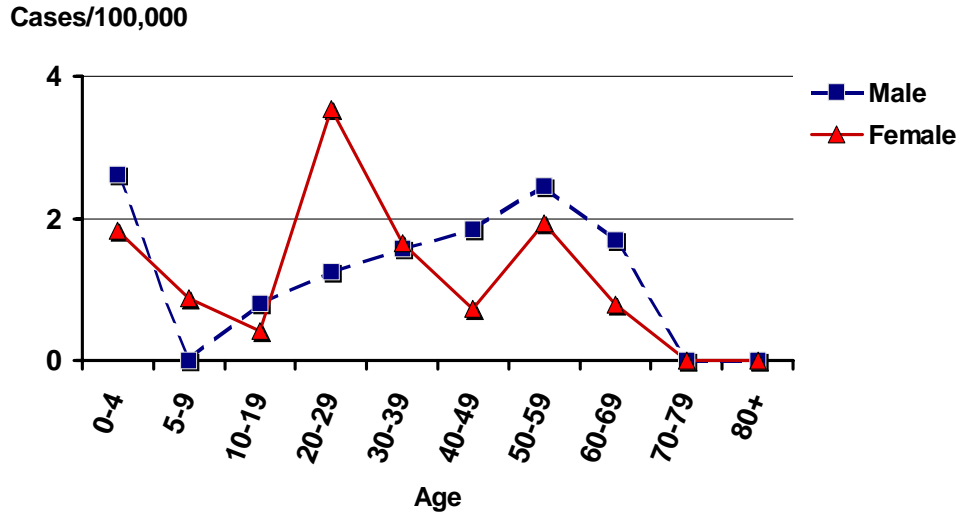
Amebiasis by Year Oregon, 1991-2000



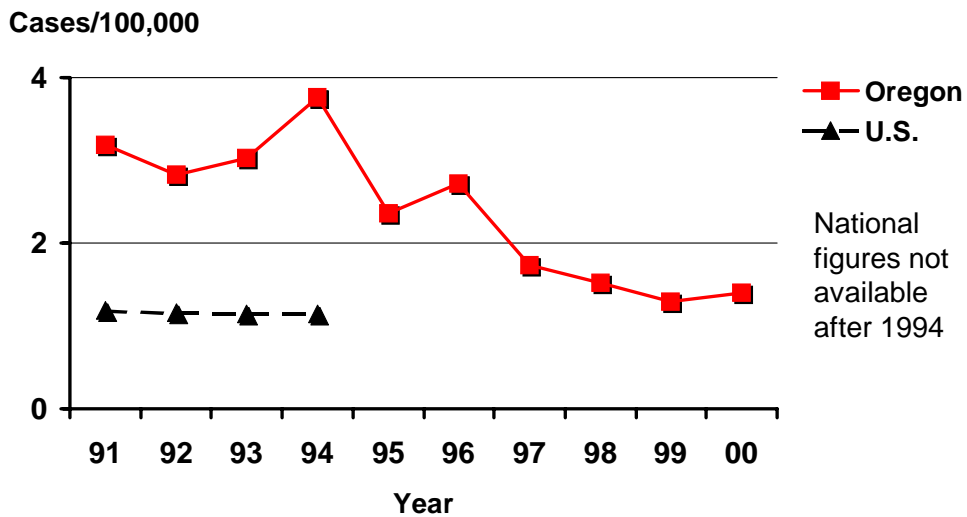
Amebiasis by Month Oregon, 2000



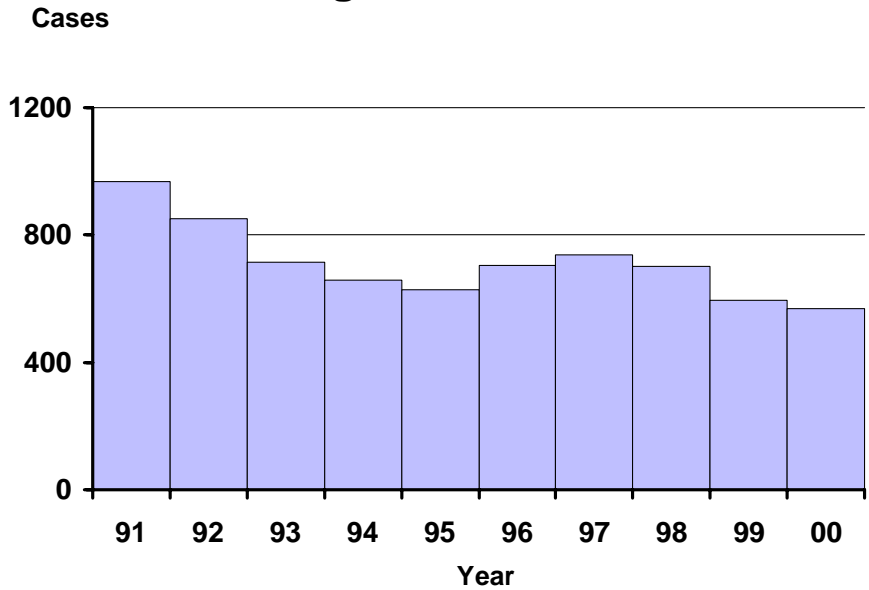
Incidence of Amebiasis by Age and Sex Oregon, 2000



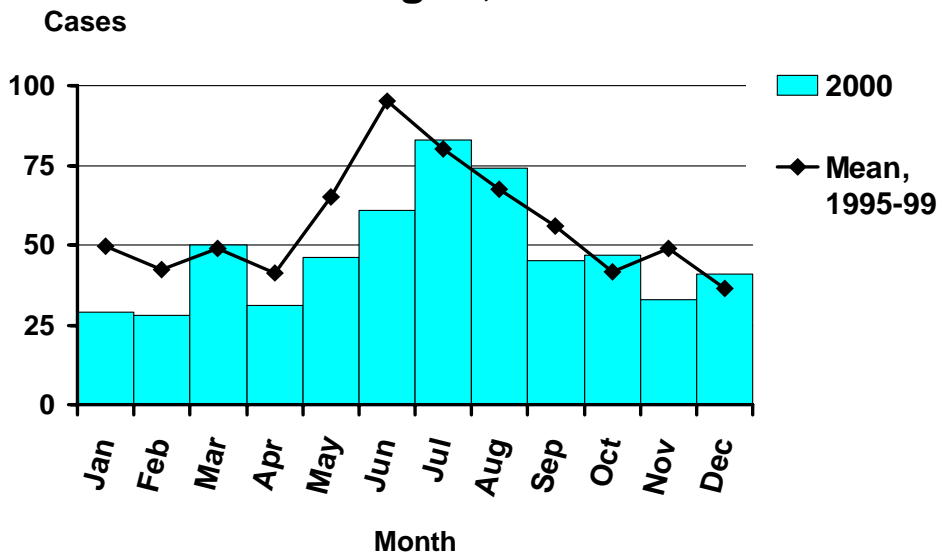
Incidence of Amebiasis Oregon vs. Nationwide 1991-2000



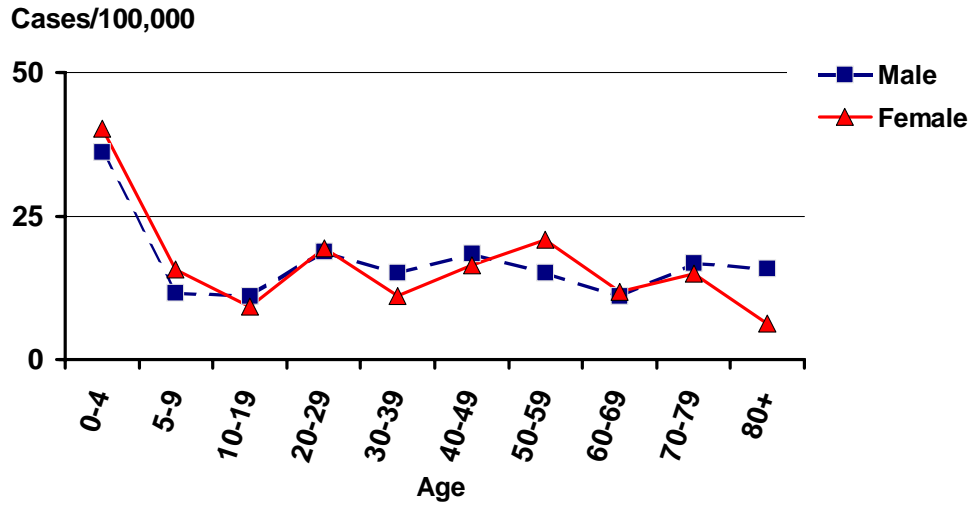
Campylobacteriosis by Year Oregon, 1991-2000



Campylobacteriosis by Onset Month Oregon, 2000

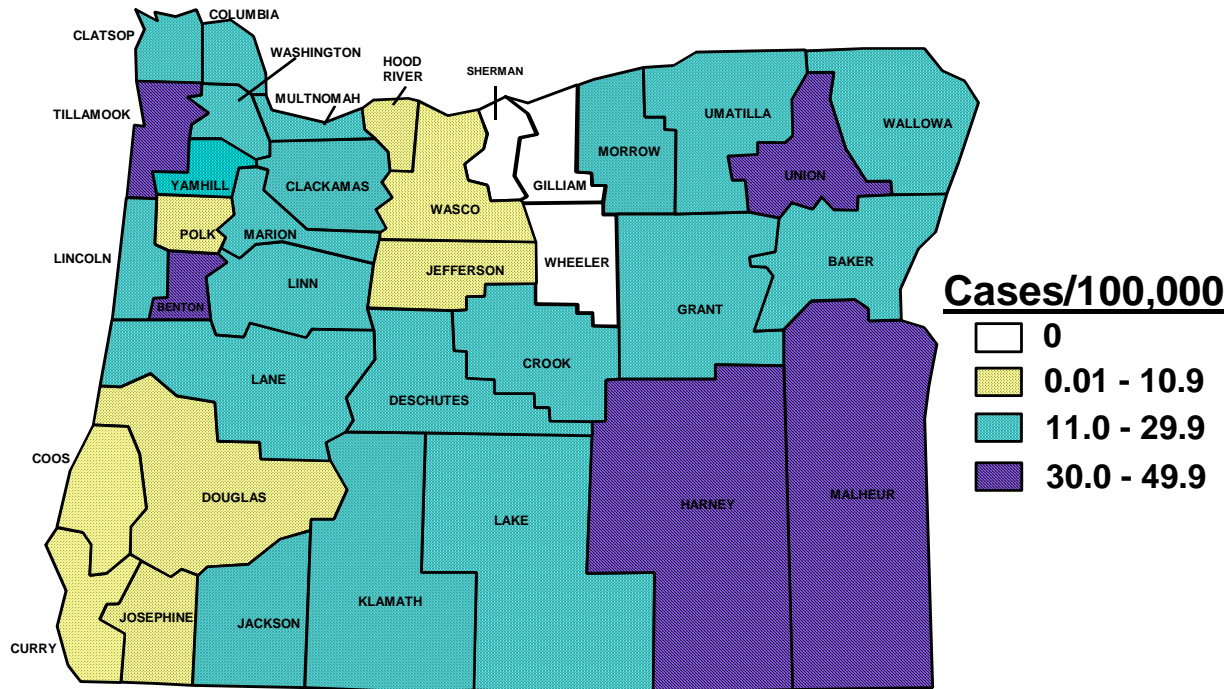


Incidence of Campylobacteriosis by Age and Sex Oregon, 2000

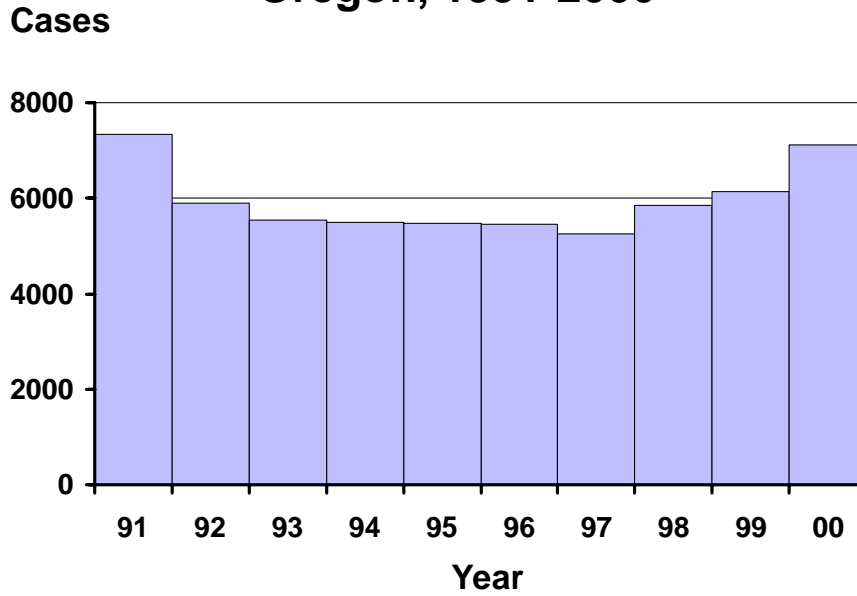

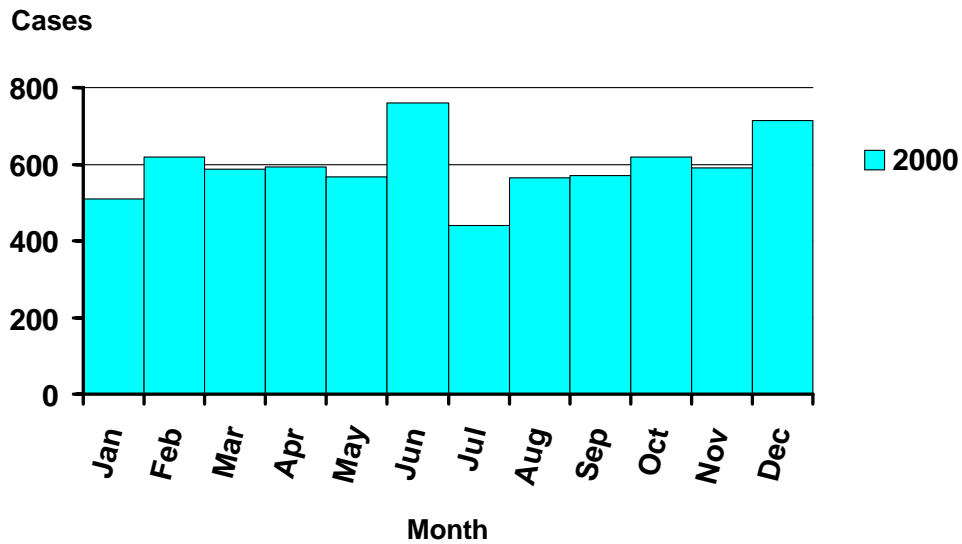
Incidence of Campylobacteriosis by County Oregon, 2000



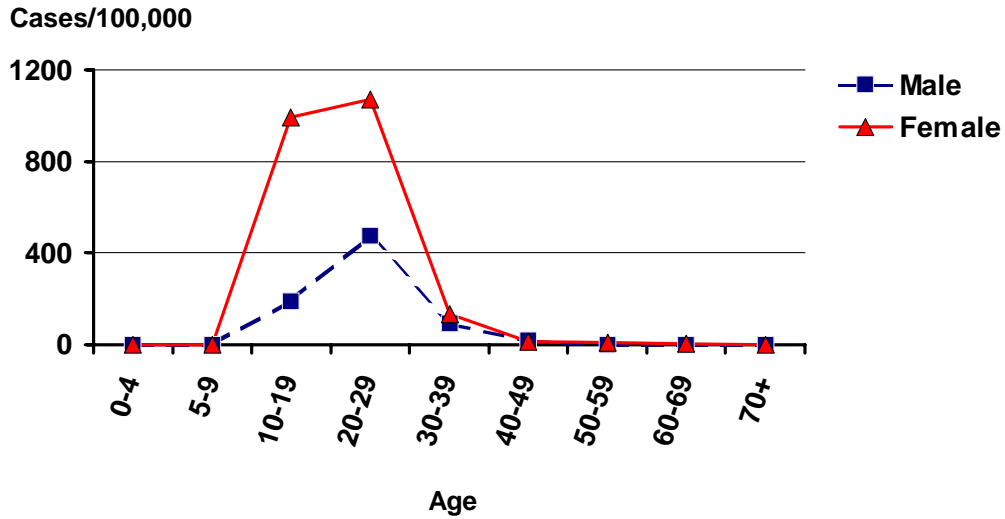
Chlamydiosis by Year Oregon, 1991-2000



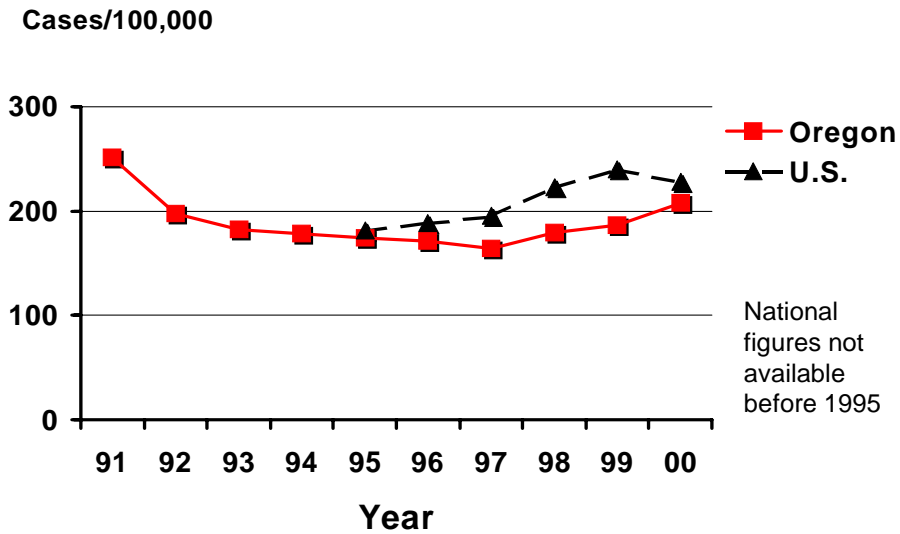
Chlamydiosis by Onset Month Oregon, 2000



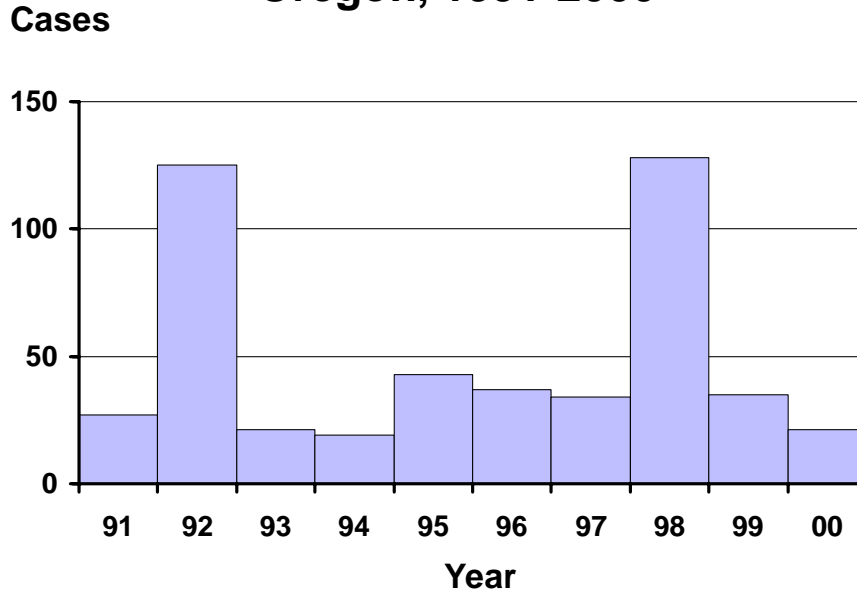
Incidence of Chlamydia by Age and Sex Oregon, 2000



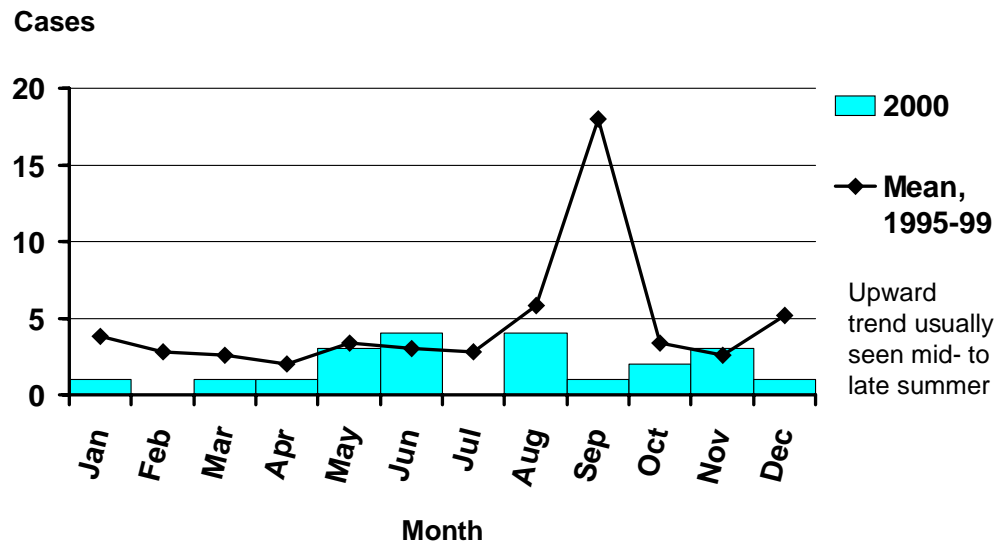
Incidence of Chlamydia Oregon vs. Nationwide 1991-2000



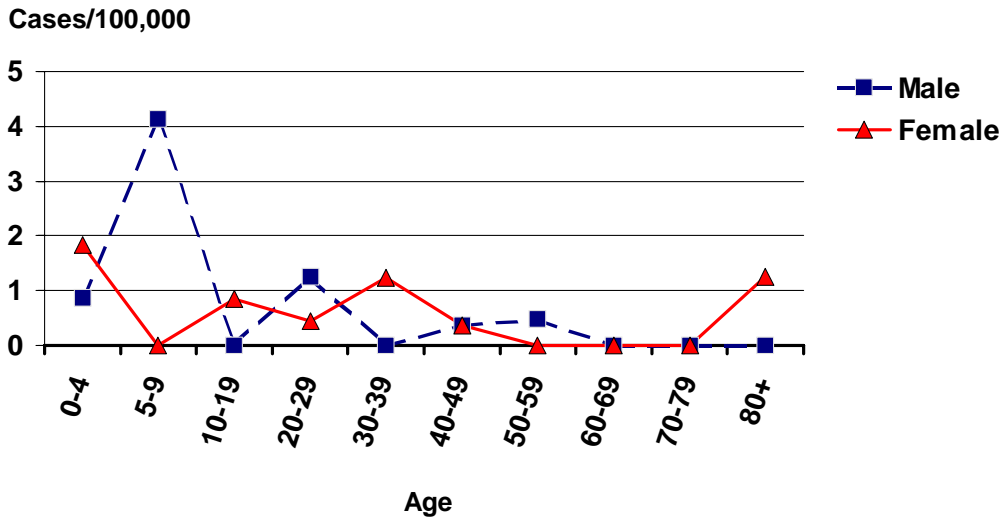
Cryptosporidiosis by Year Oregon, 1991-2000



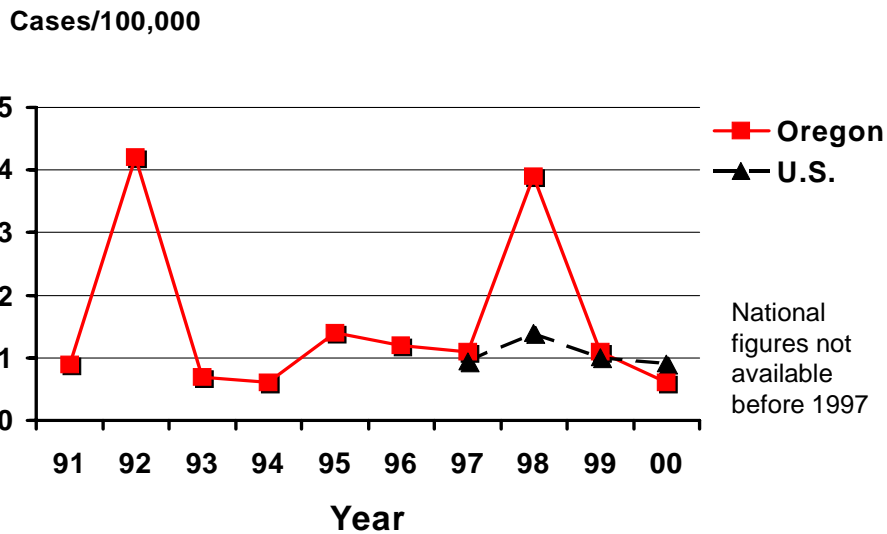
Cryptosporidiosis by Onset Month Oregon, 2000



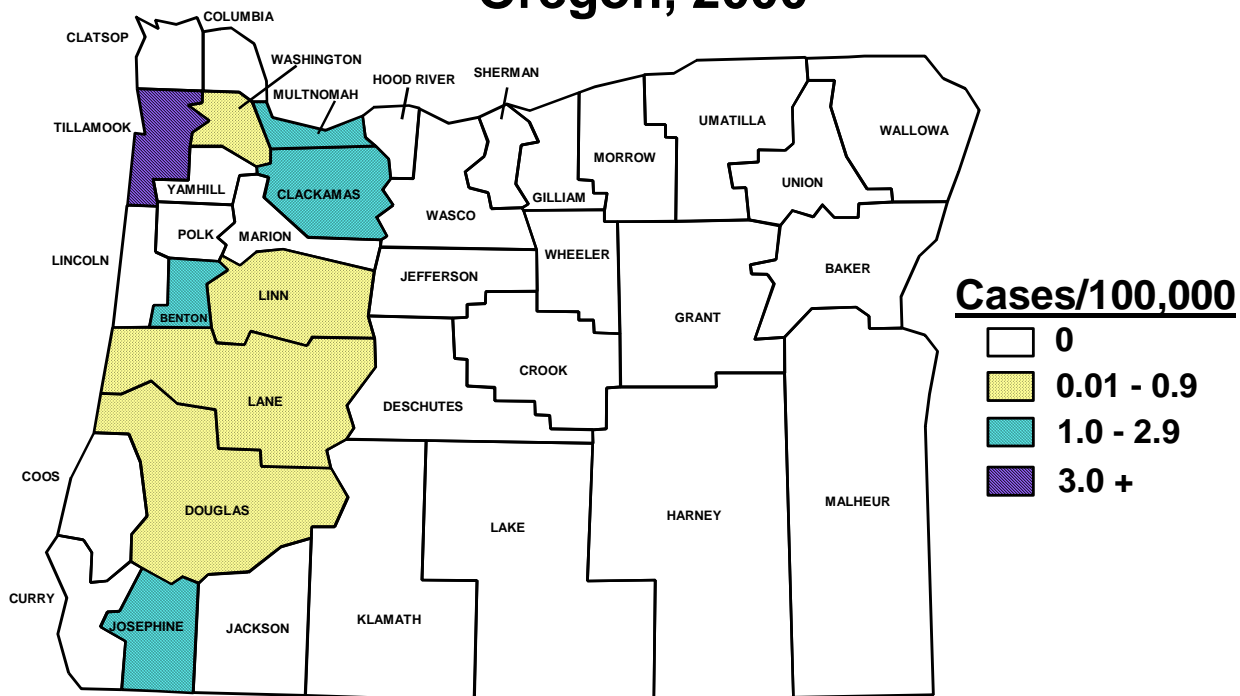
Incidence of Cryptosporidiosis by Age and Sex Oregon, 2000



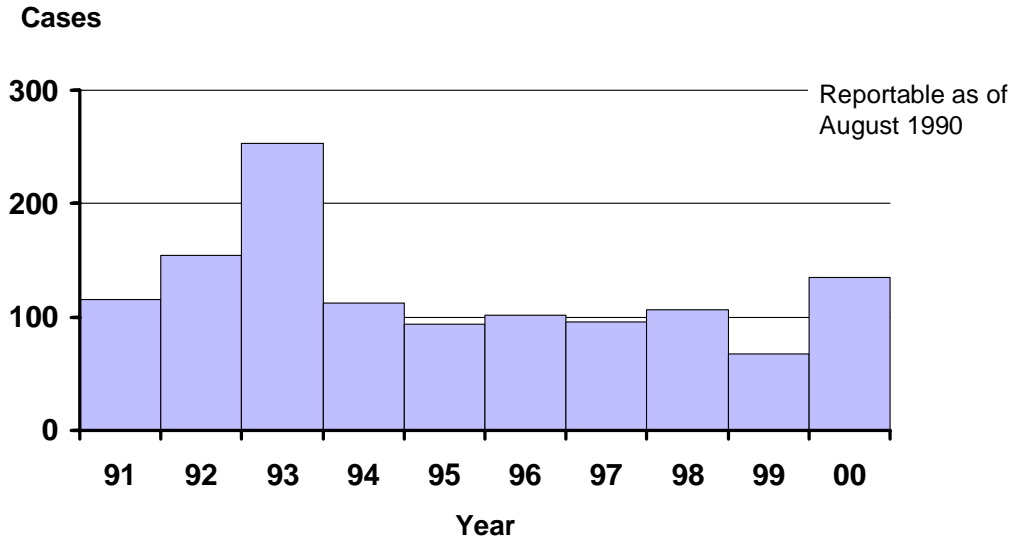
Incidence of Cryptosporidiosis Oregon vs. Nationwide 1991-2000



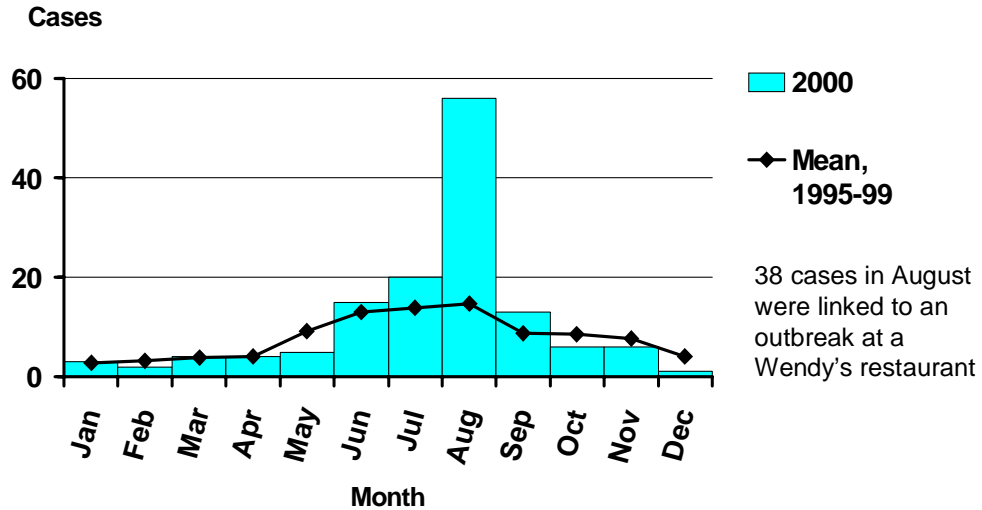
Incidence of Cryptosporidiosis by County Oregon, 2000



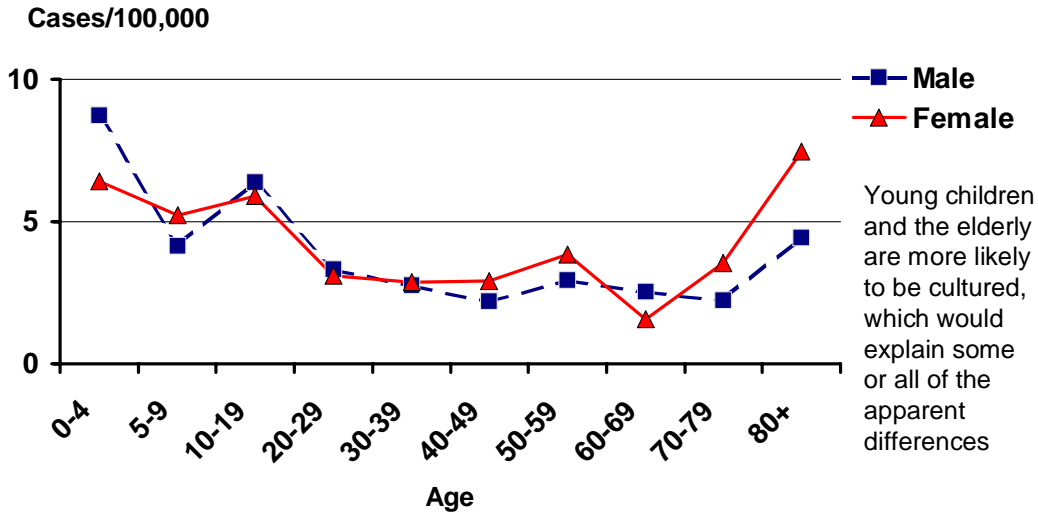
***E. coli* O157 Infection by Year Oregon, 1991-2000**



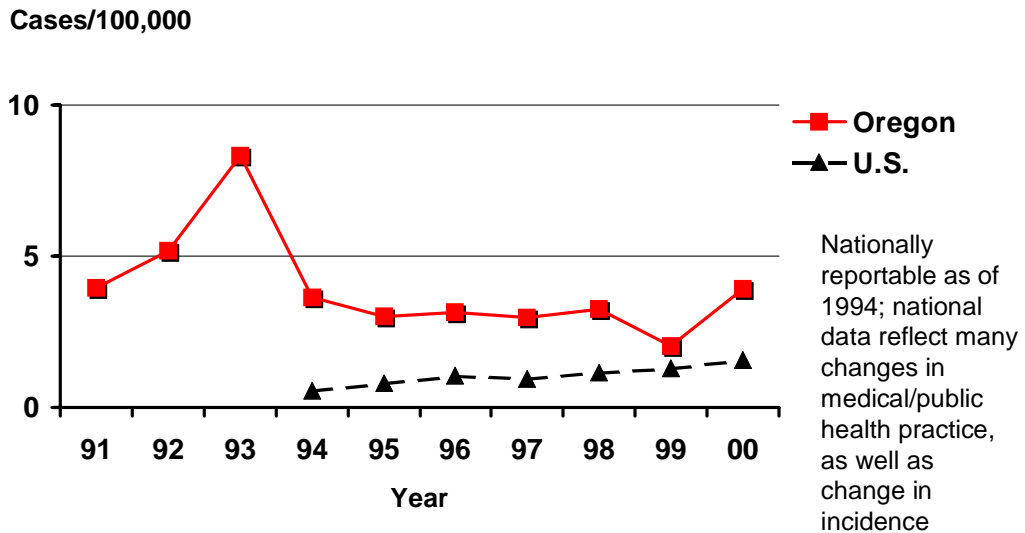
***E. coli* O157 Infection by Onset Month Oregon, 2000**



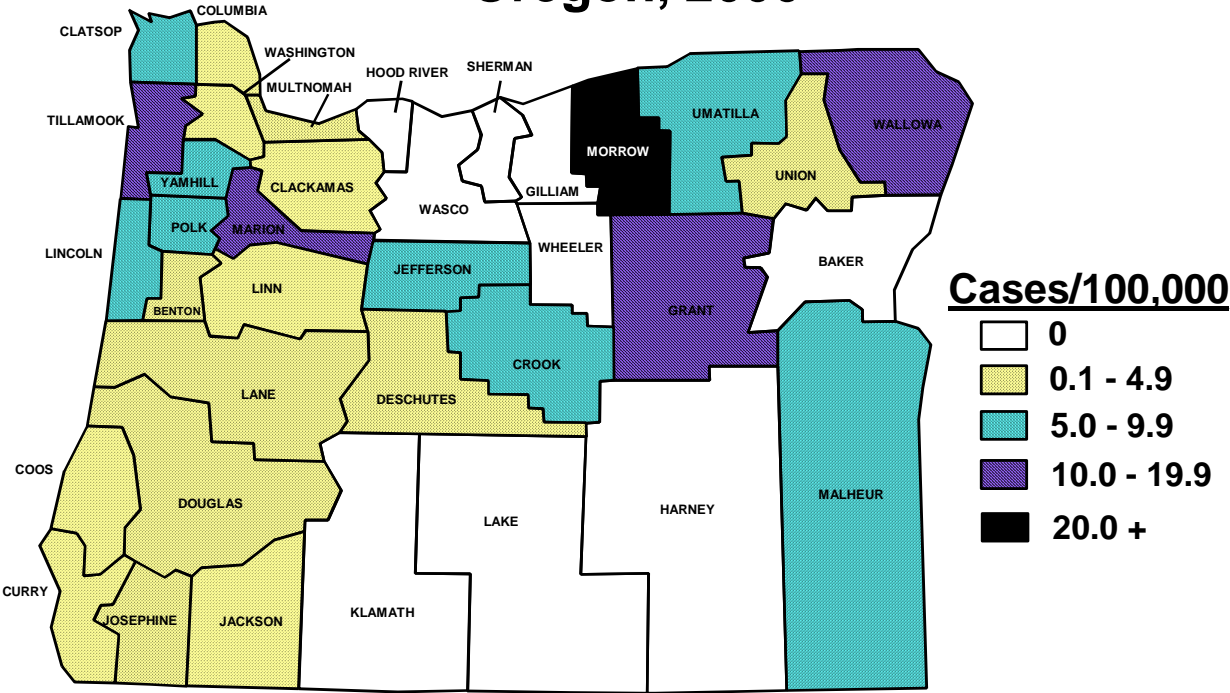
Incidence of *E. coli* O157 Infection by Age and Sex Oregon, 2000



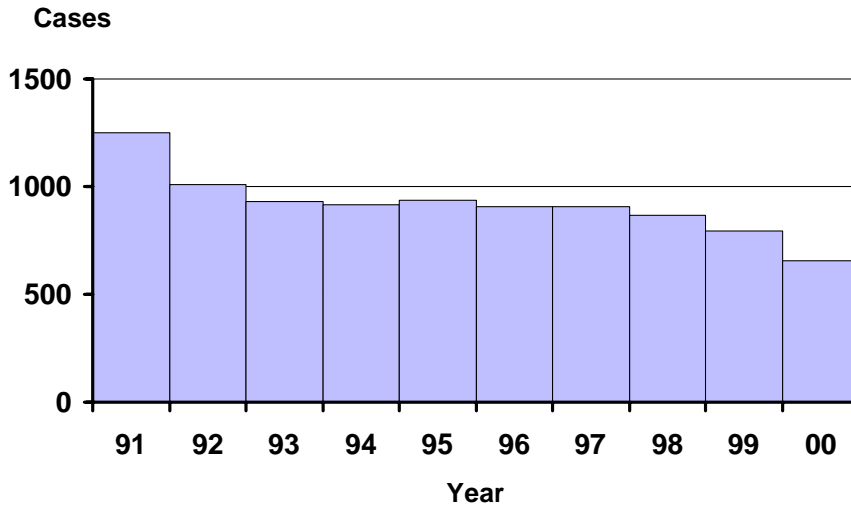
Incidence of *E. coli* O157 Infection Oregon vs. Nationwide 1991-2000

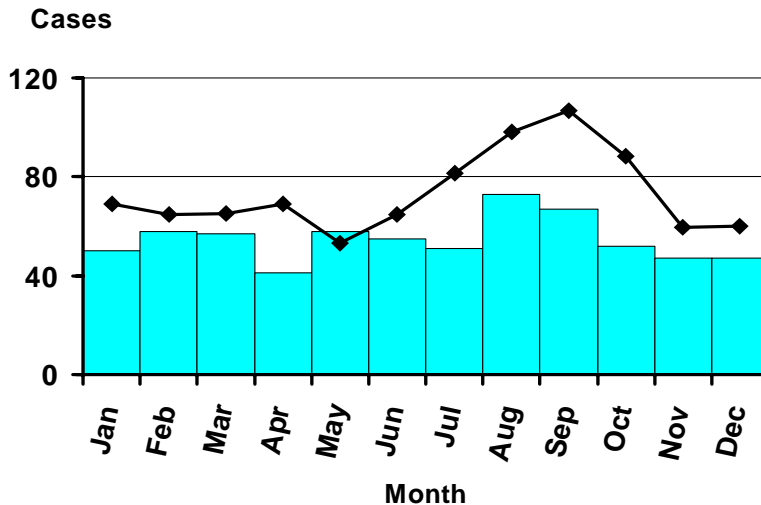


Giardiasis by Year Oregon, 1991-2000

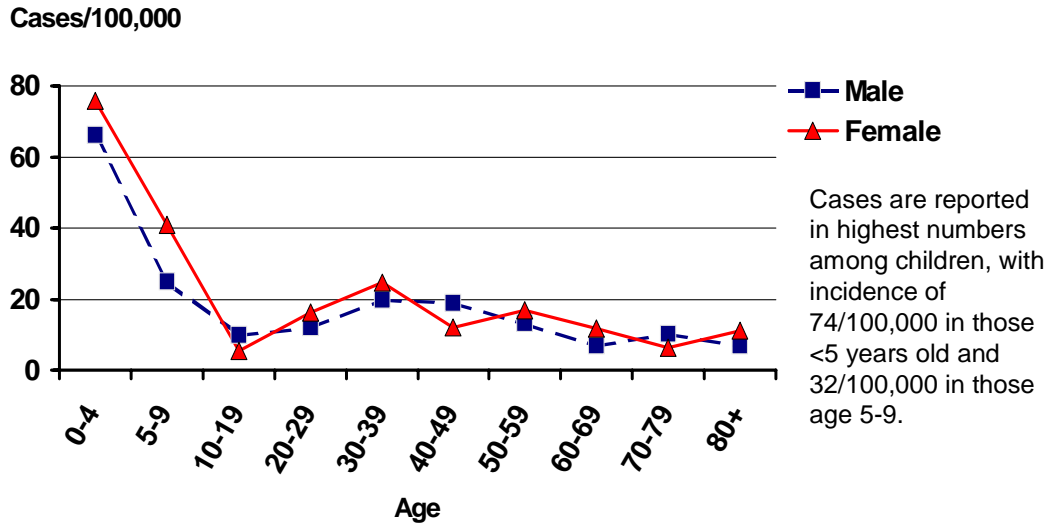

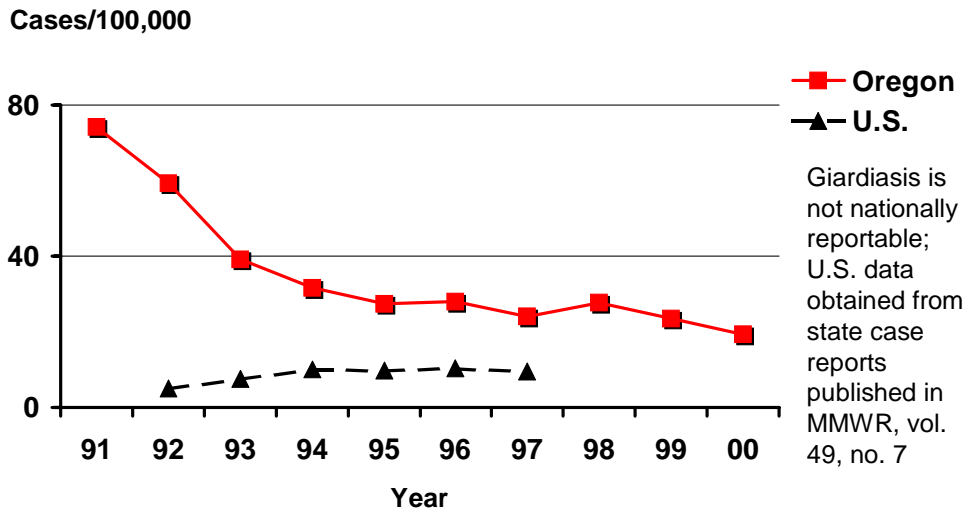

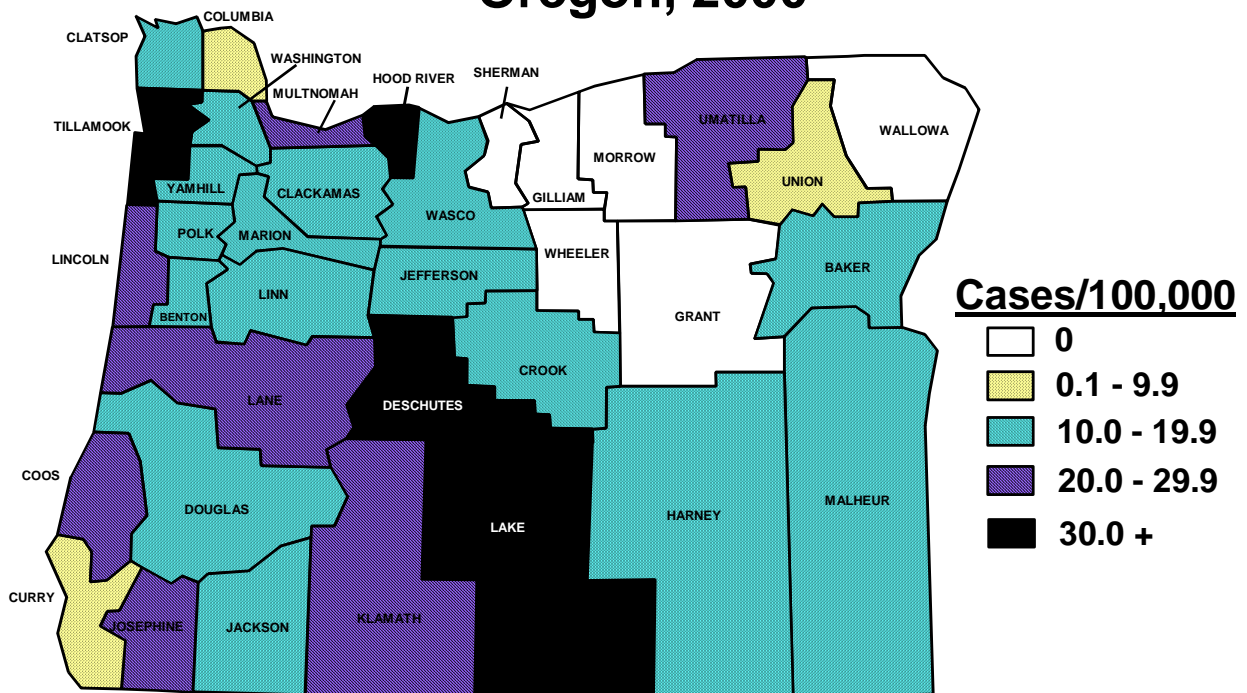
Incidence of Giardiasis by Age and Sex Oregon, 2000



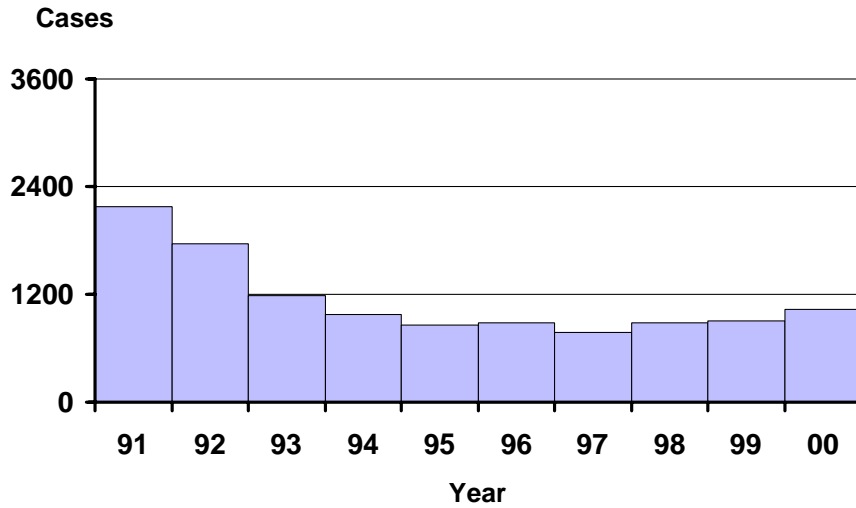
Incidence of Giardiasis Oregon vs. Nationwide 1991-2000



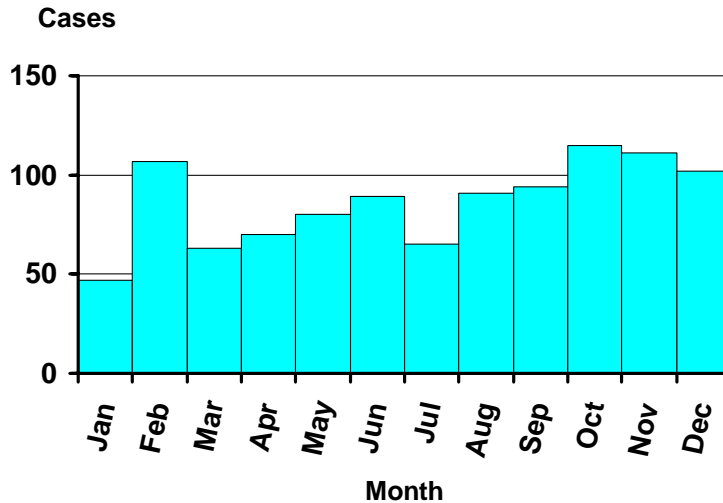
Incidence of Giardiasis by County Oregon, 2000



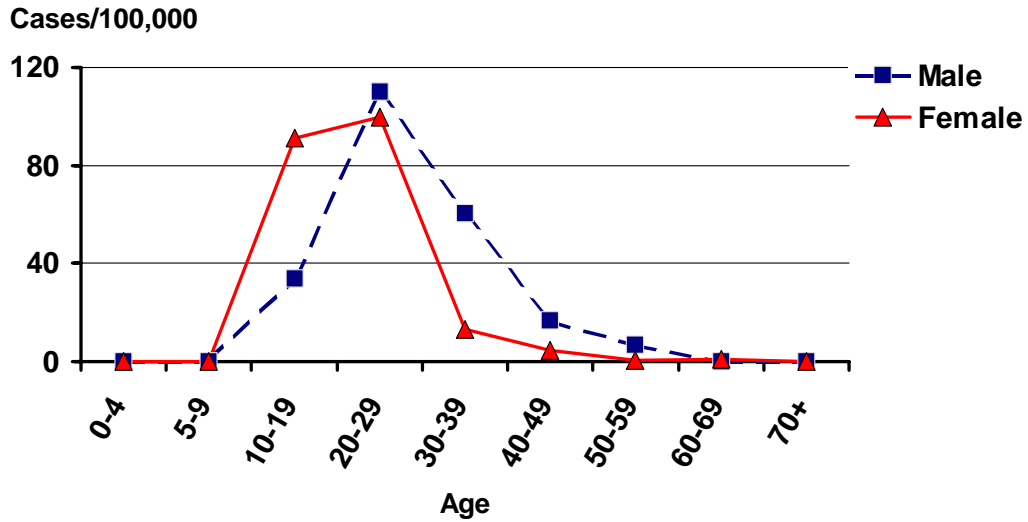
Gonorrhea by Year Oregon, 1991-2000



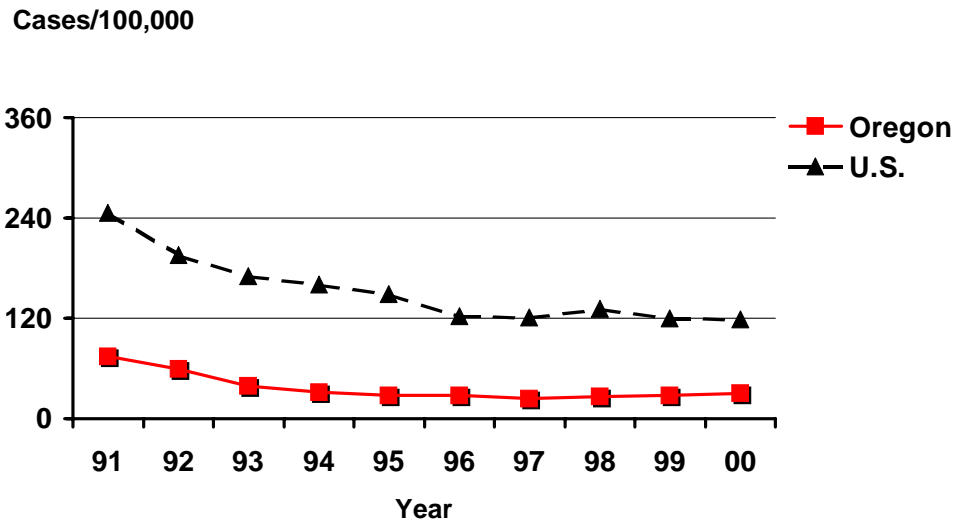
Gonorrhea by Onset Month Oregon, 2000



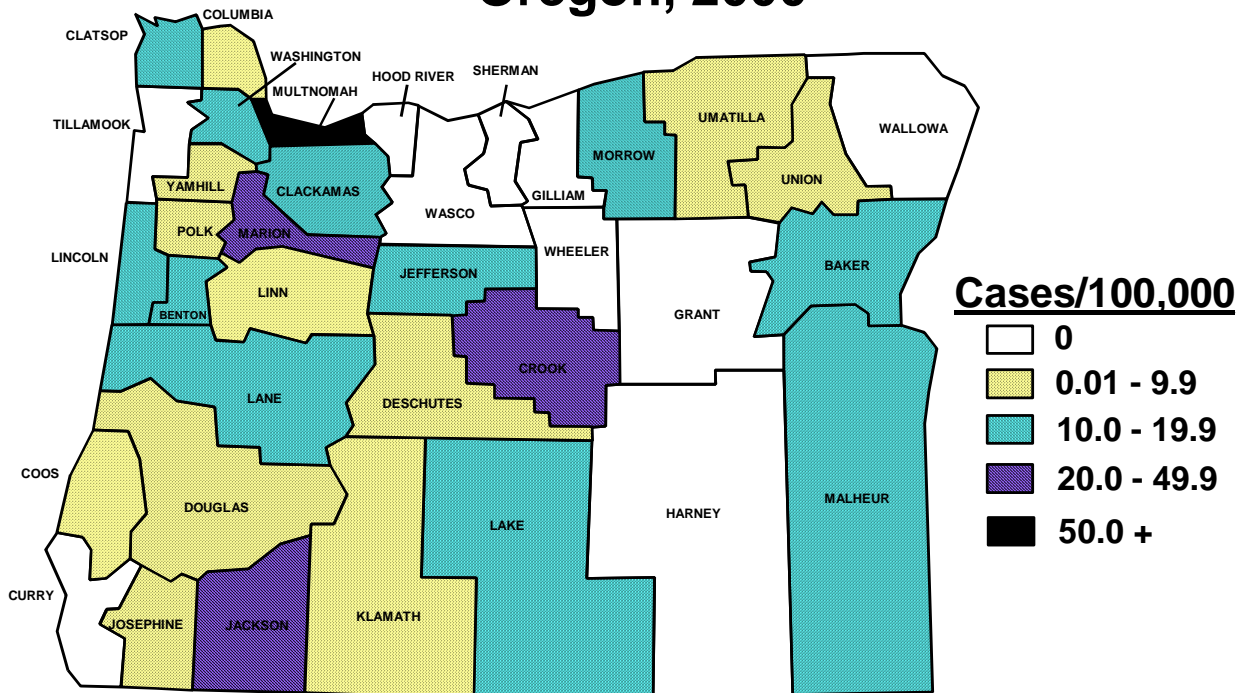
Incidence of Gonorrhea by Age and Sex Oregon, 2000



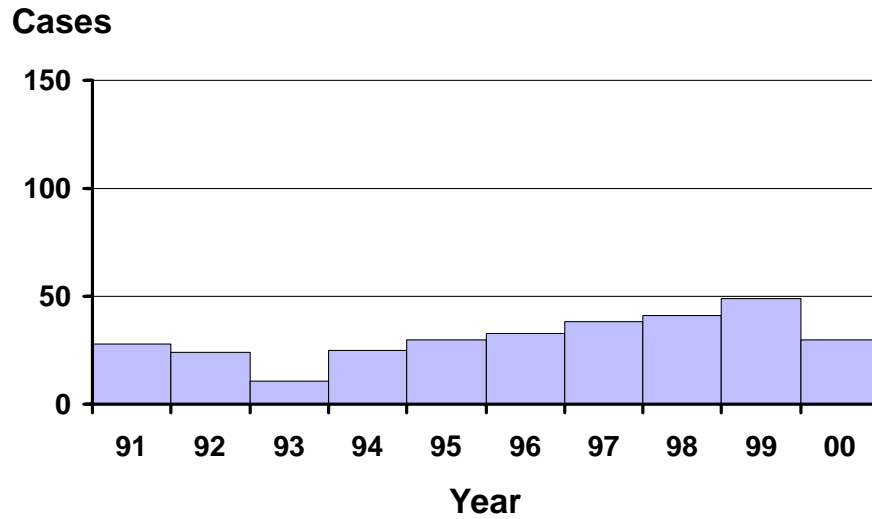
Incidence of Gonorrhea Oregon vs. Nationwide 1991-2000



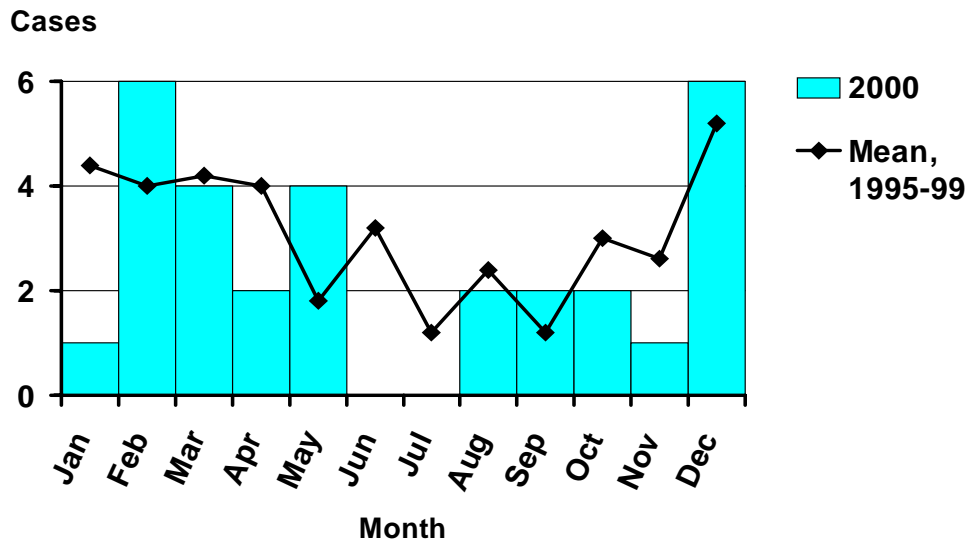
Incidence of Gonorrhea by County Oregon, 2000



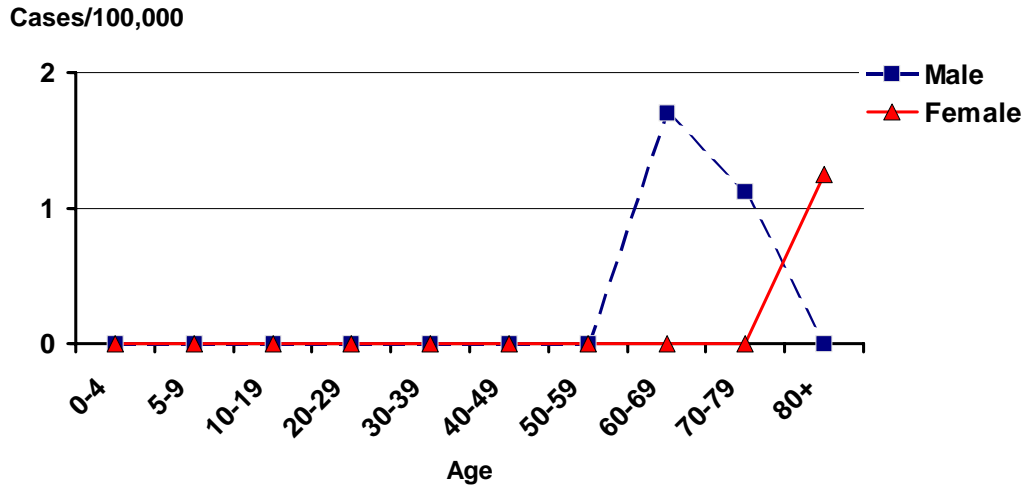
***Haemophilus influenzae* Invasive Disease by Year Oregon, 1991-2000**



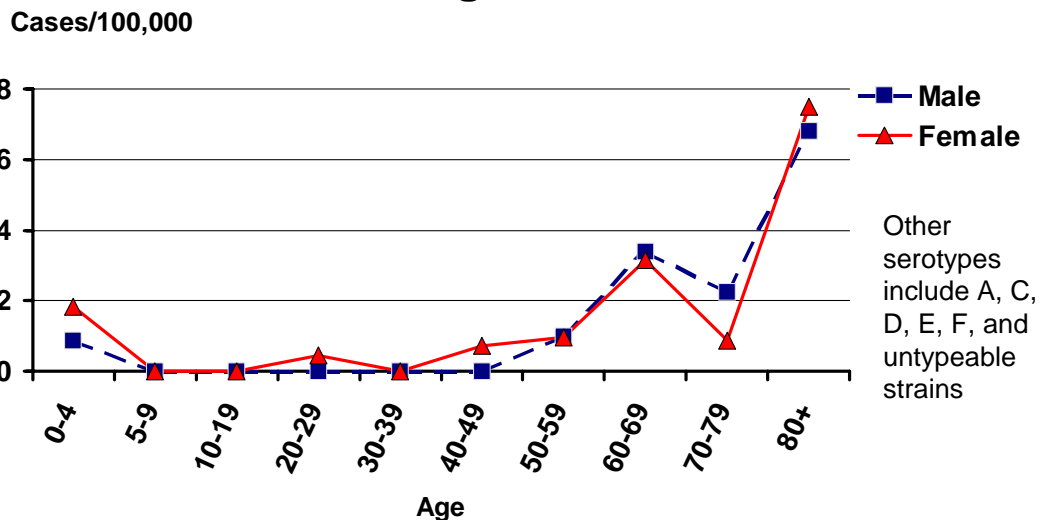
***Haemophilus influenzae* Invasive Disease by Onset Month Oregon, 2000**



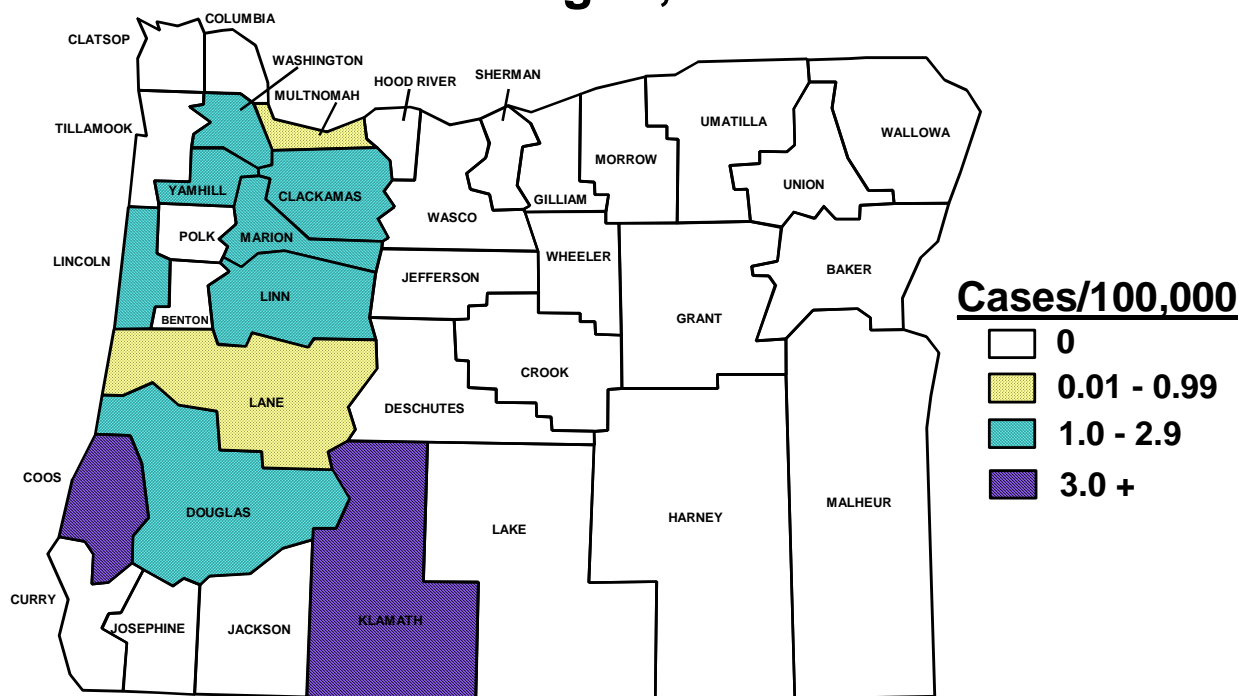
Incidence of *H. influenzae* Invasive Disease Serotype B Infection by Age and Sex Oregon, 2000



Incidence of *H. influenzae* Invasive Disease Serotypes Other Than B by Age and Sex Oregon, 2000

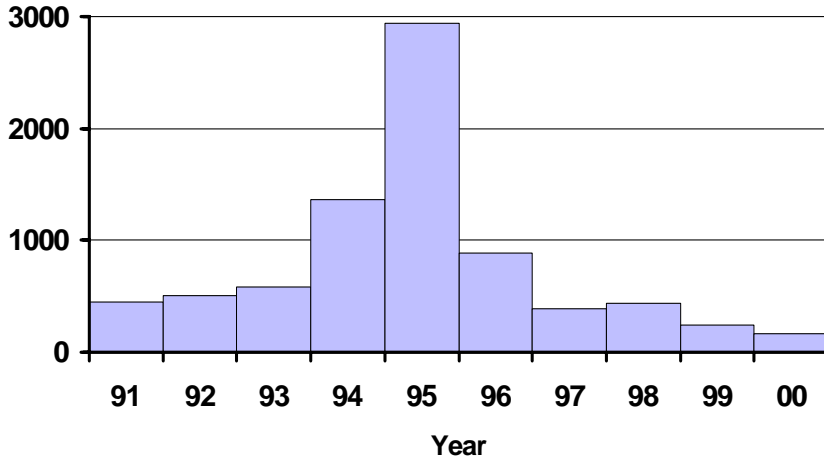


Incidence of *H. influenzae* Invasive Disease by County Oregon, 2000

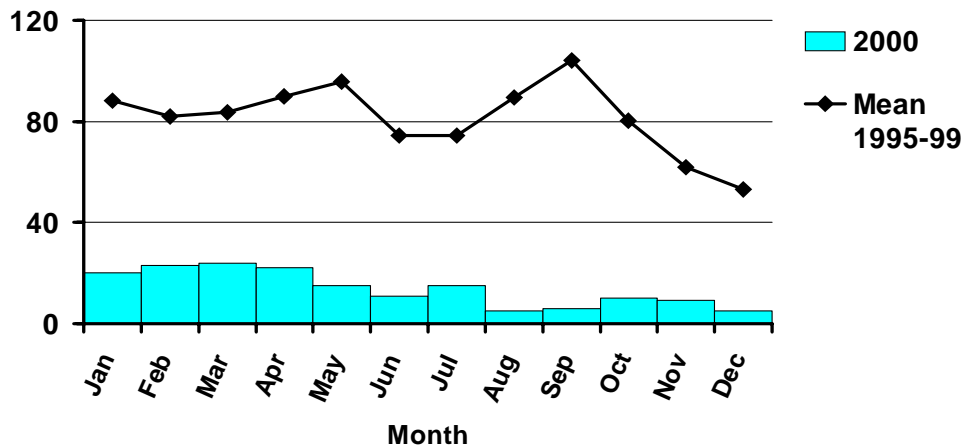

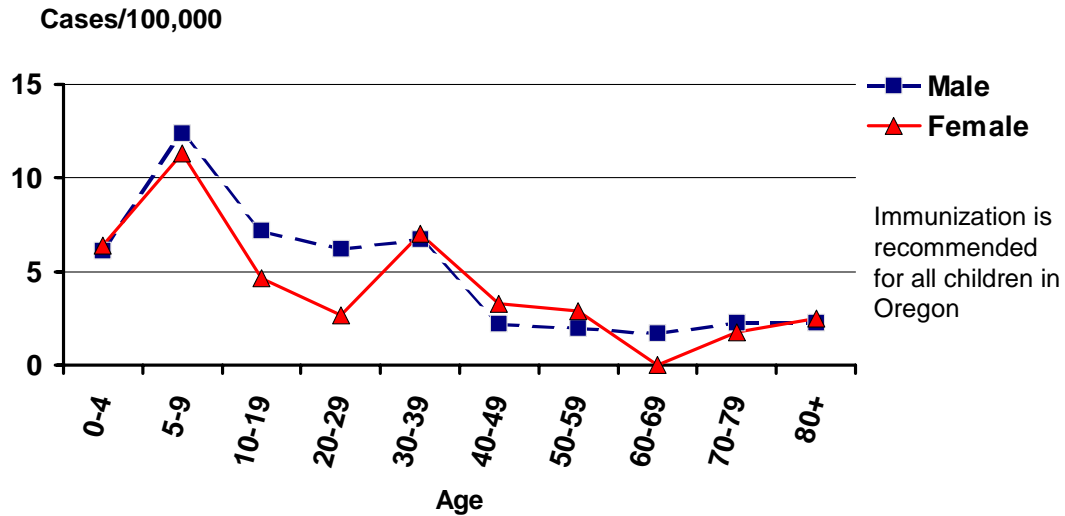
The 165 cases in 2000 occurred primarily as sporadic disease, and comprise the lowest case count recorded since 1966, when HA was first reported separately.

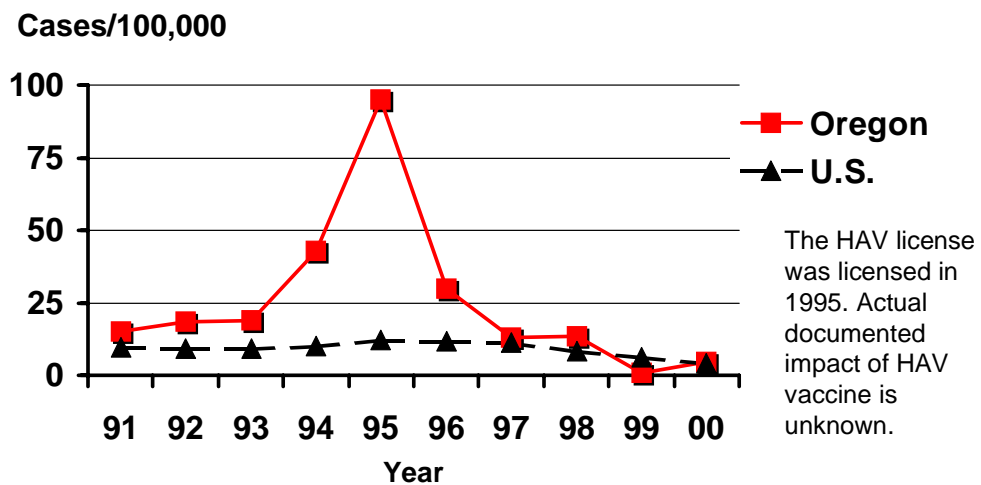

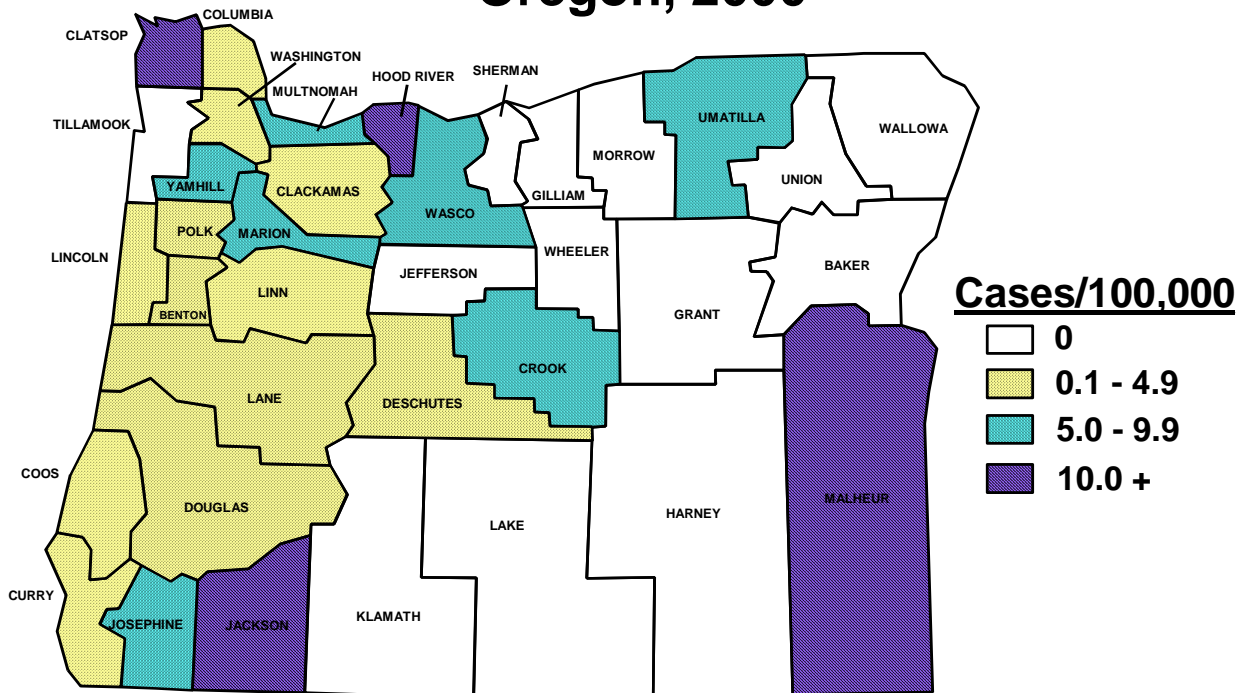
Incidence of Hepatitis A by Age and Sex Oregon, 2000



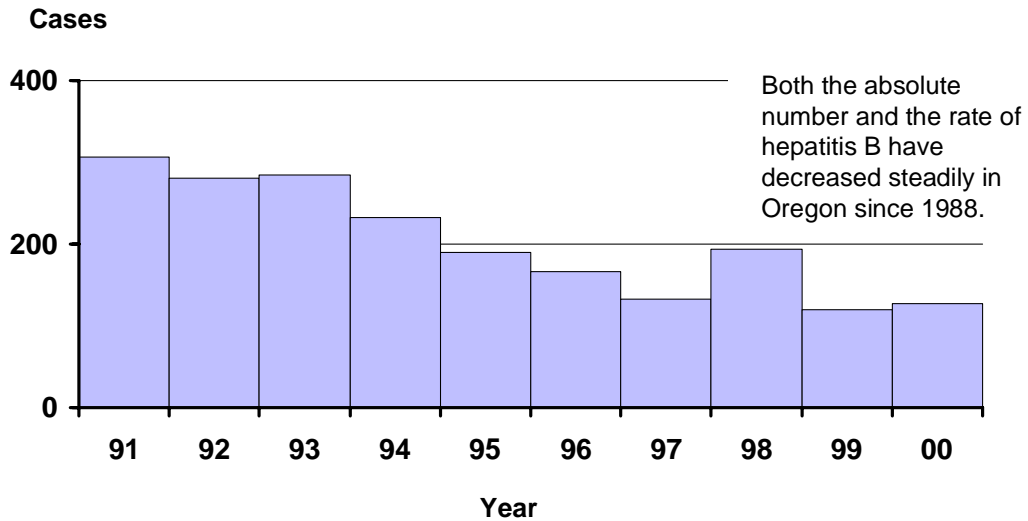
Incidence of Hepatitis A Oregon vs. Nationwide 1991-2000



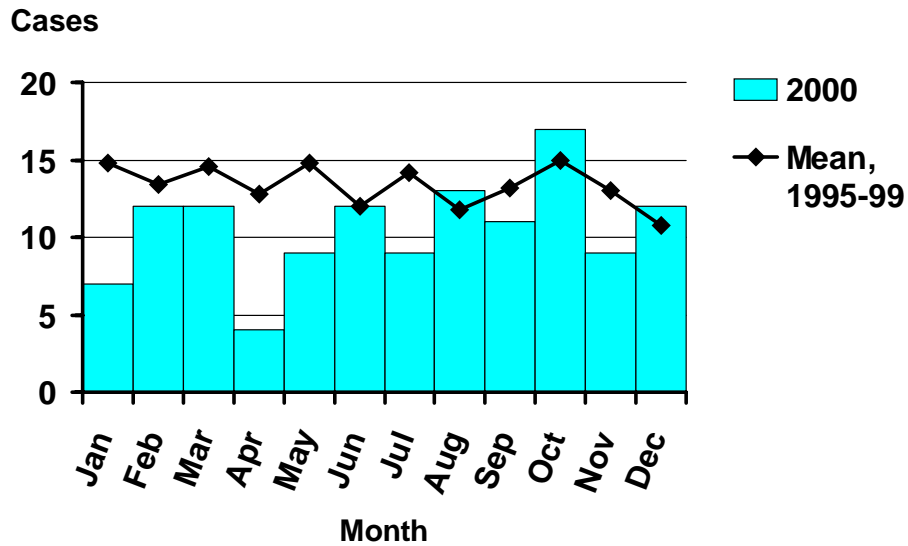
Incidence of Hepatitis A by County Oregon, 2000



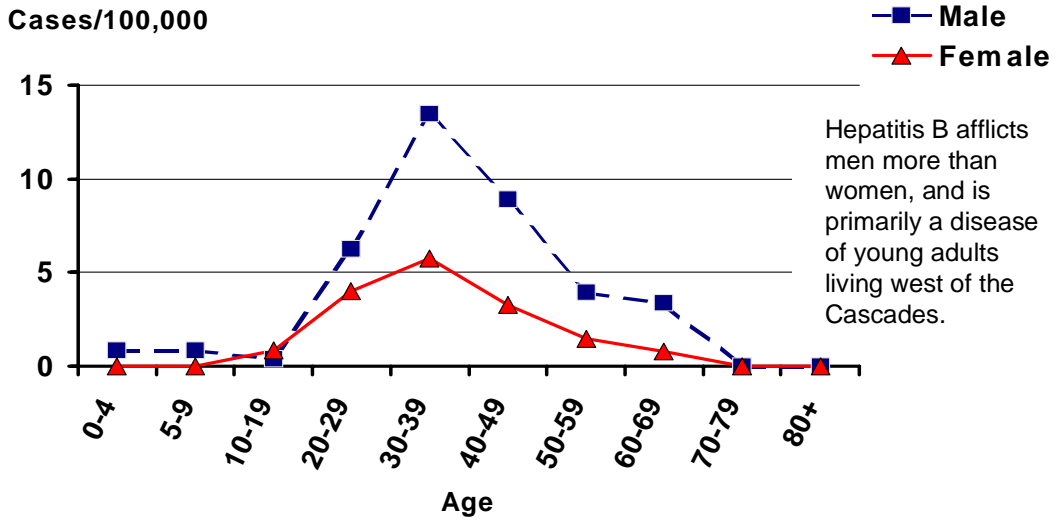

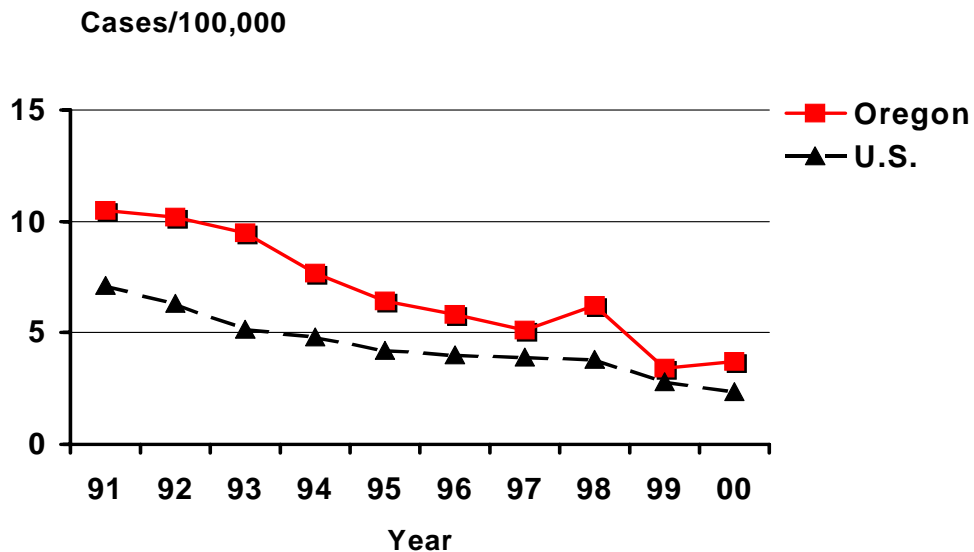

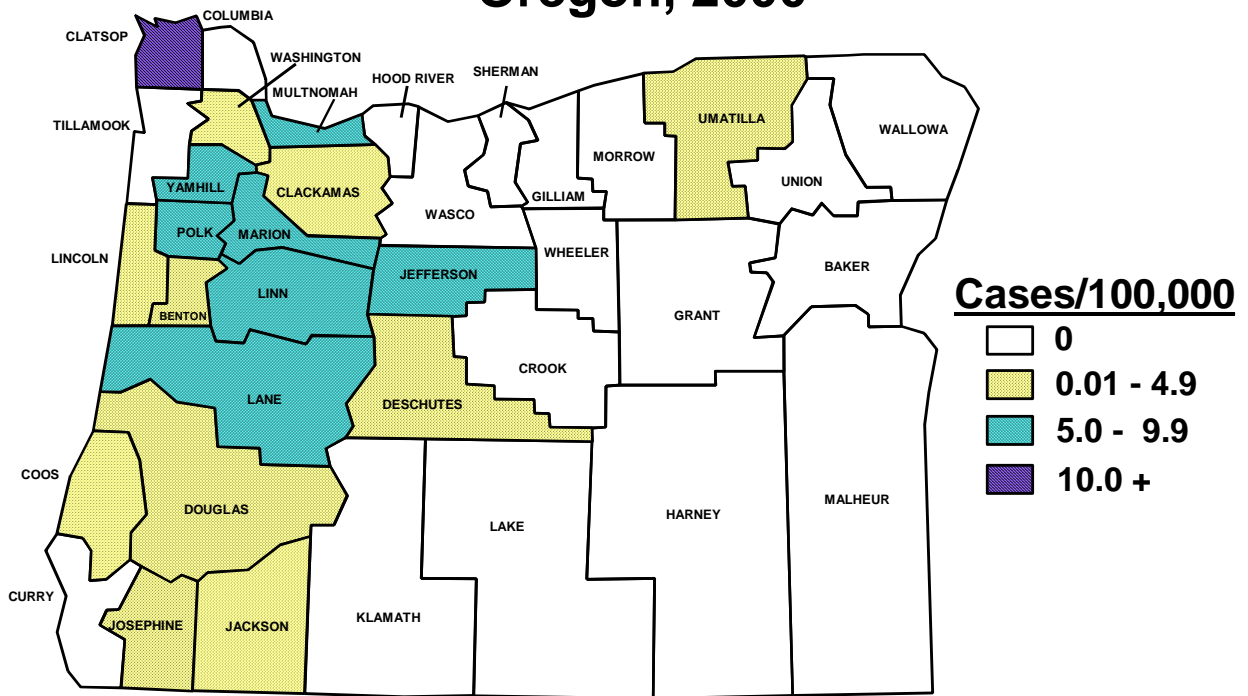
Incidence of Hepatitis B (Acute) by Age and Sex Oregon, 2000



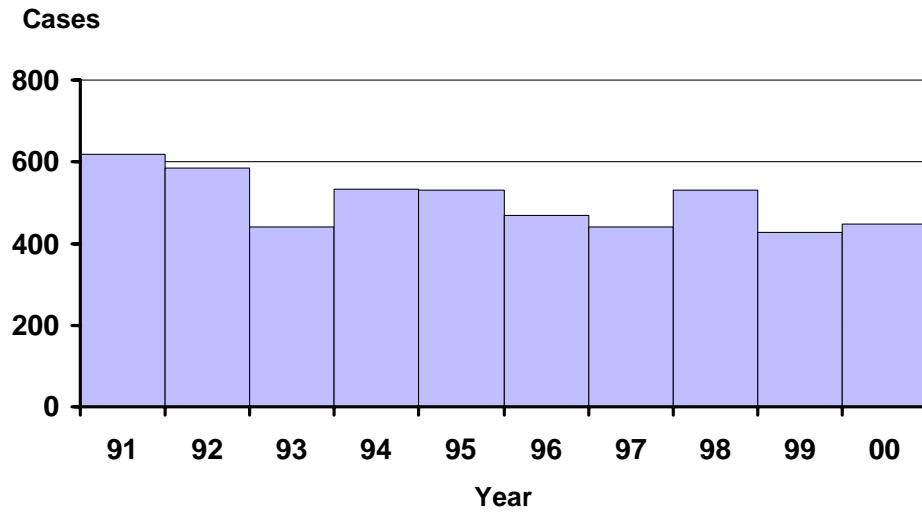
Incidence of Hepatitis B (Acute) Oregon vs. Nationwide 1991-2000



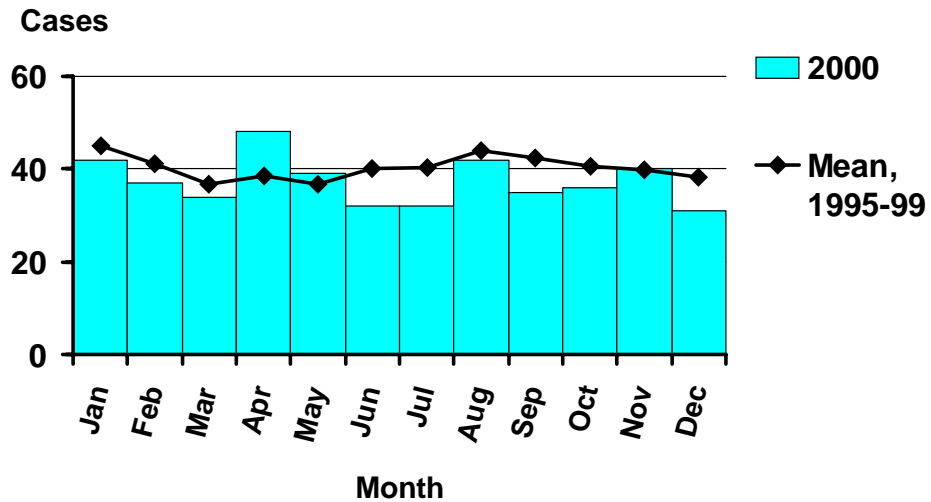
Incidence of Hepatitis B (Acute) by County Oregon, 2000



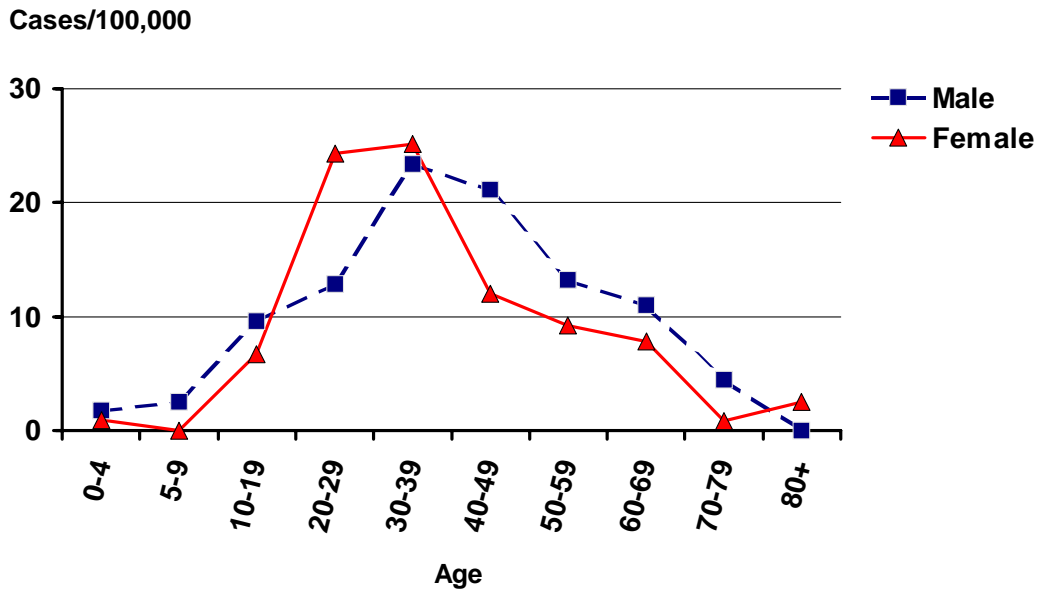
Hepatitis B (Chronic) by Year Oregon, 1991-2000



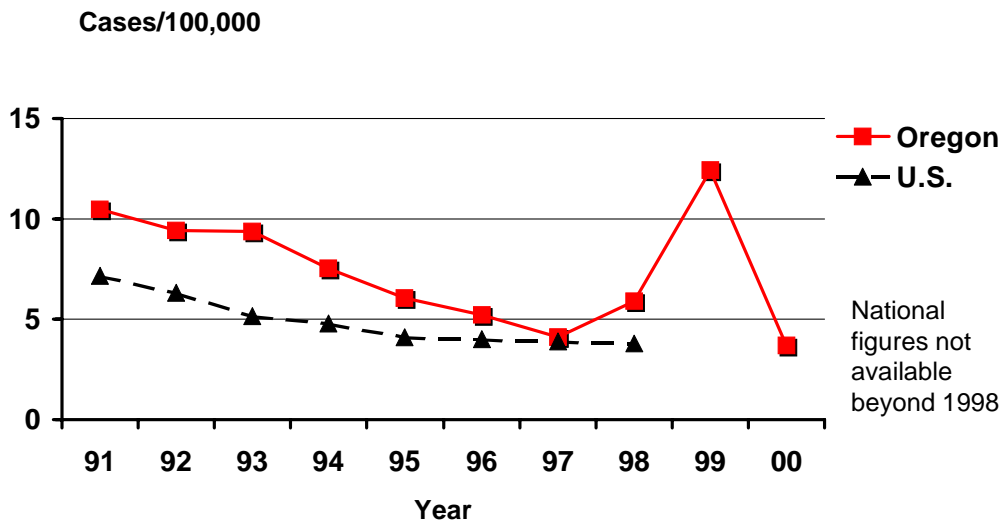
Hepatitis B (Chronic) by Onset Month Oregon, 2000



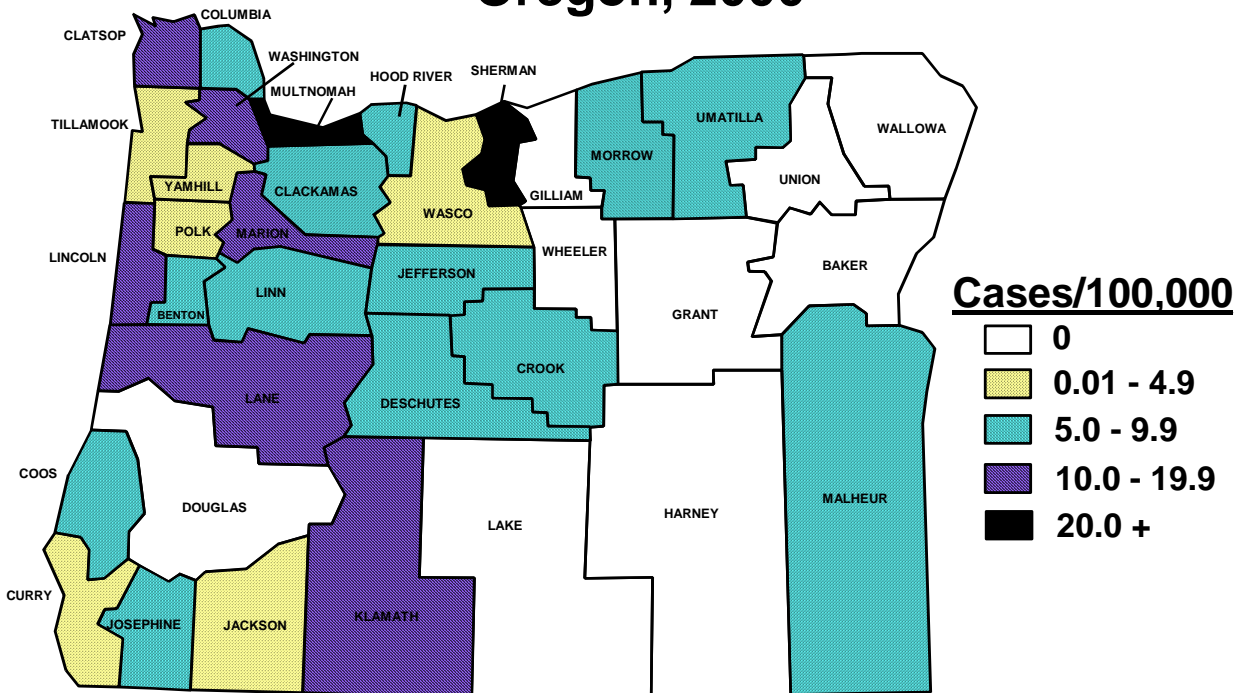
Incidence of Hepatitis B (Chronic) by Age and Sex Oregon, 2000



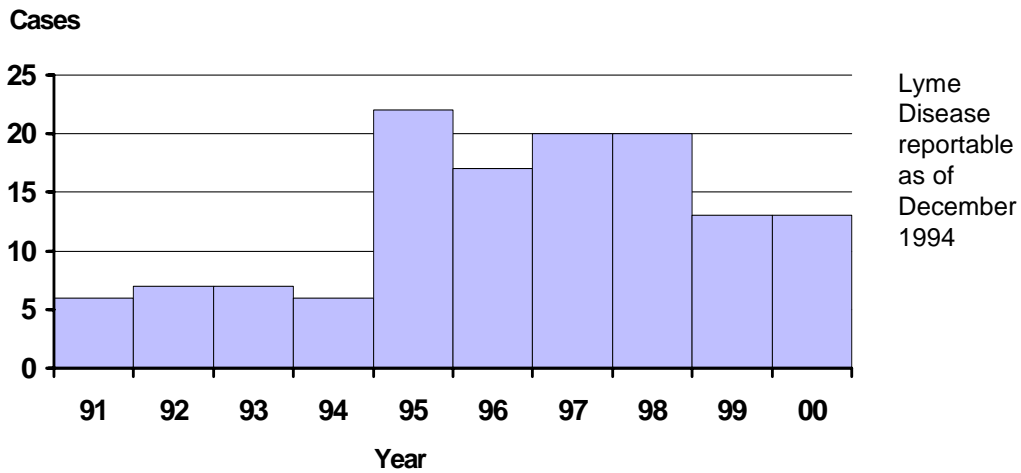
Incidence of Hepatitis B (Chronic) Oregon vs. Nationwide 1991-2000



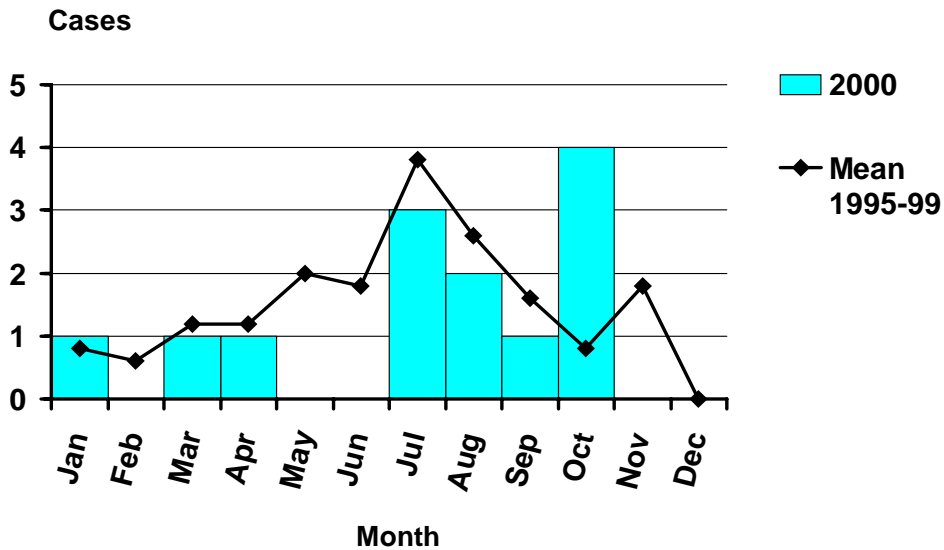

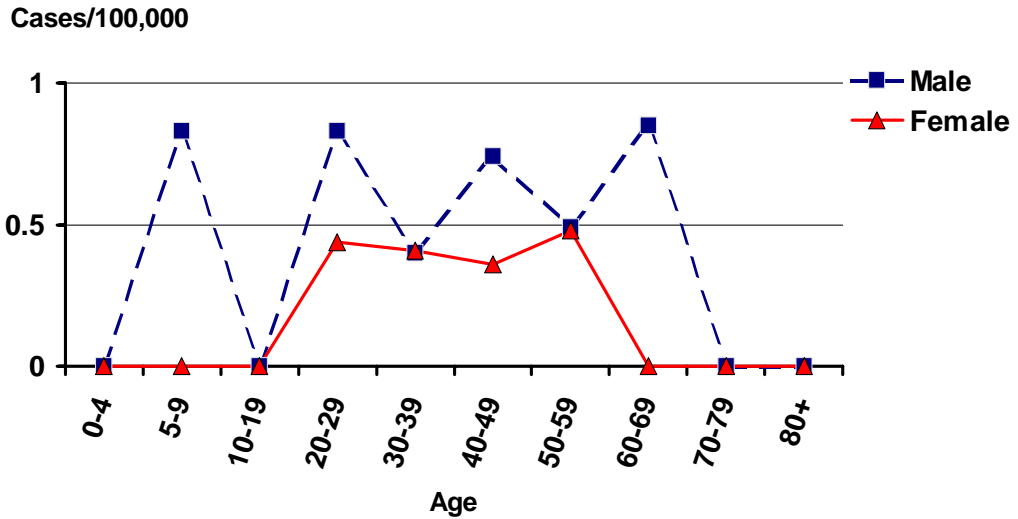

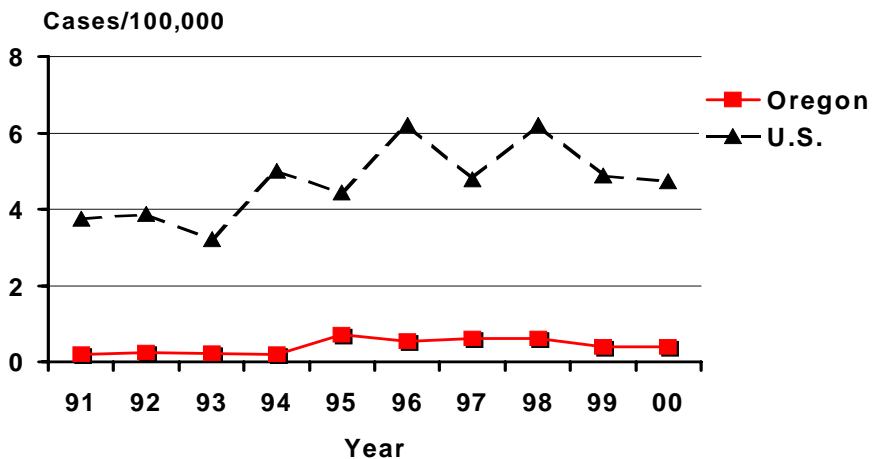

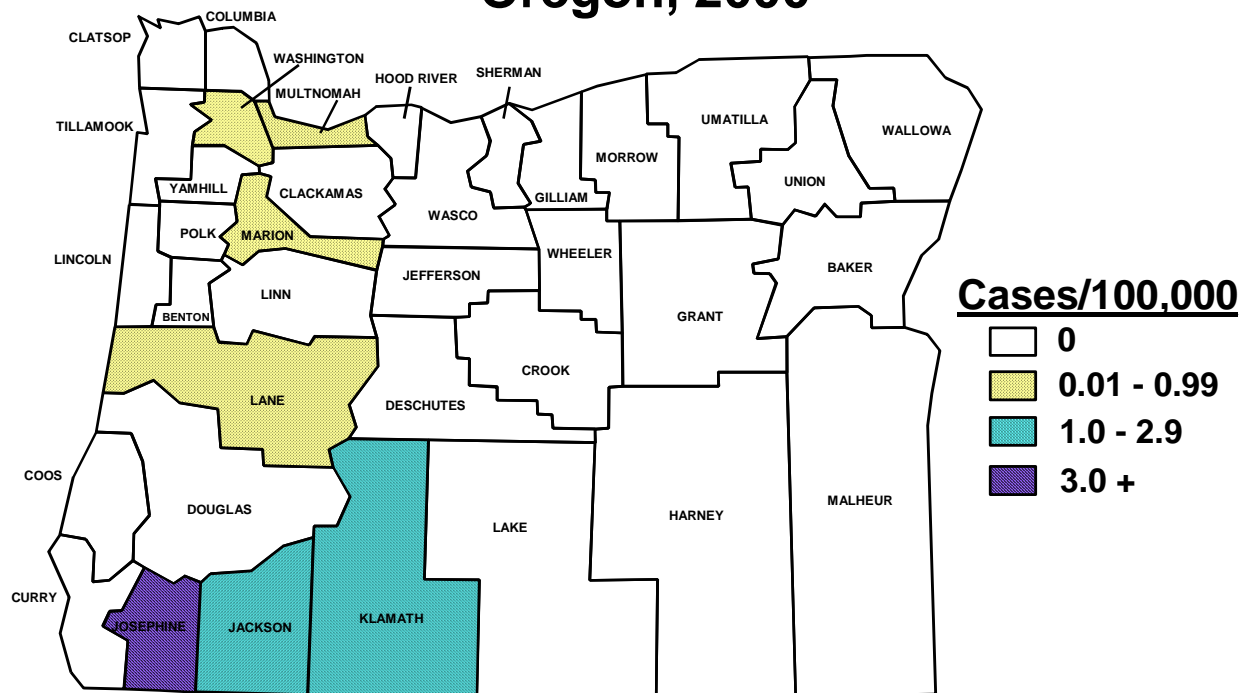
Incidence of Lyme Disease by Age and Sex Oregon, 2000



Incidence of Lyme Disease Oregon vs. Nationwide 1991-2000

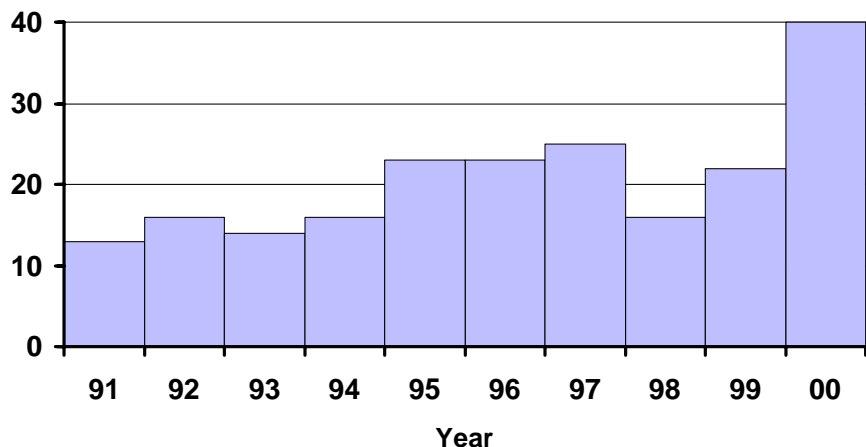


Incidence of Lyme Disease by County Oregon, 2000

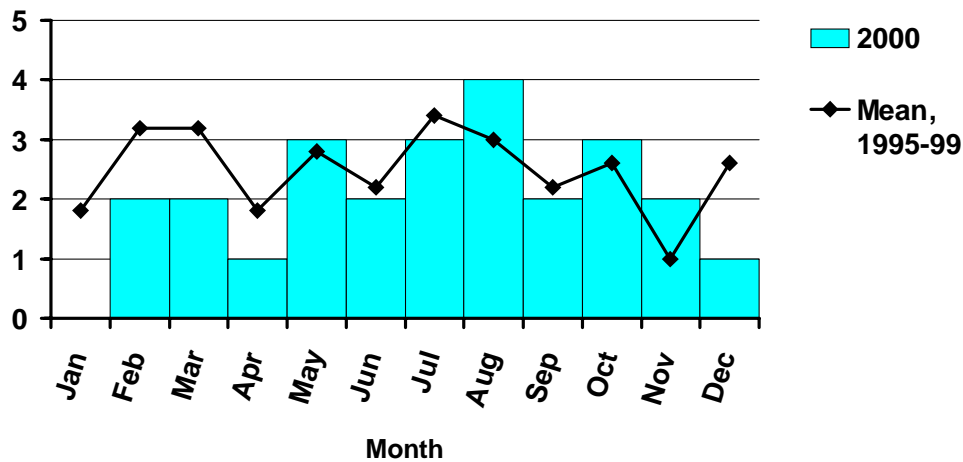

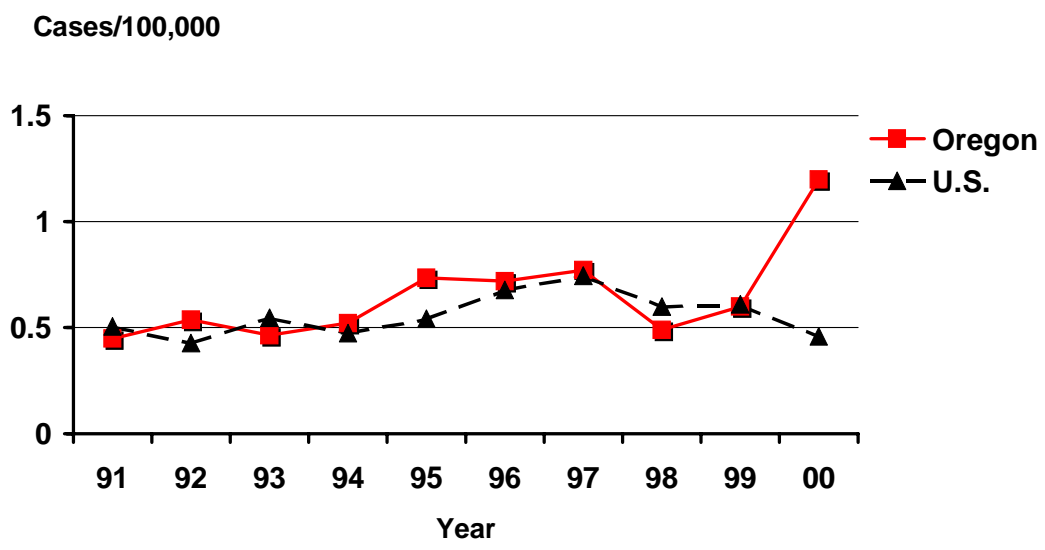

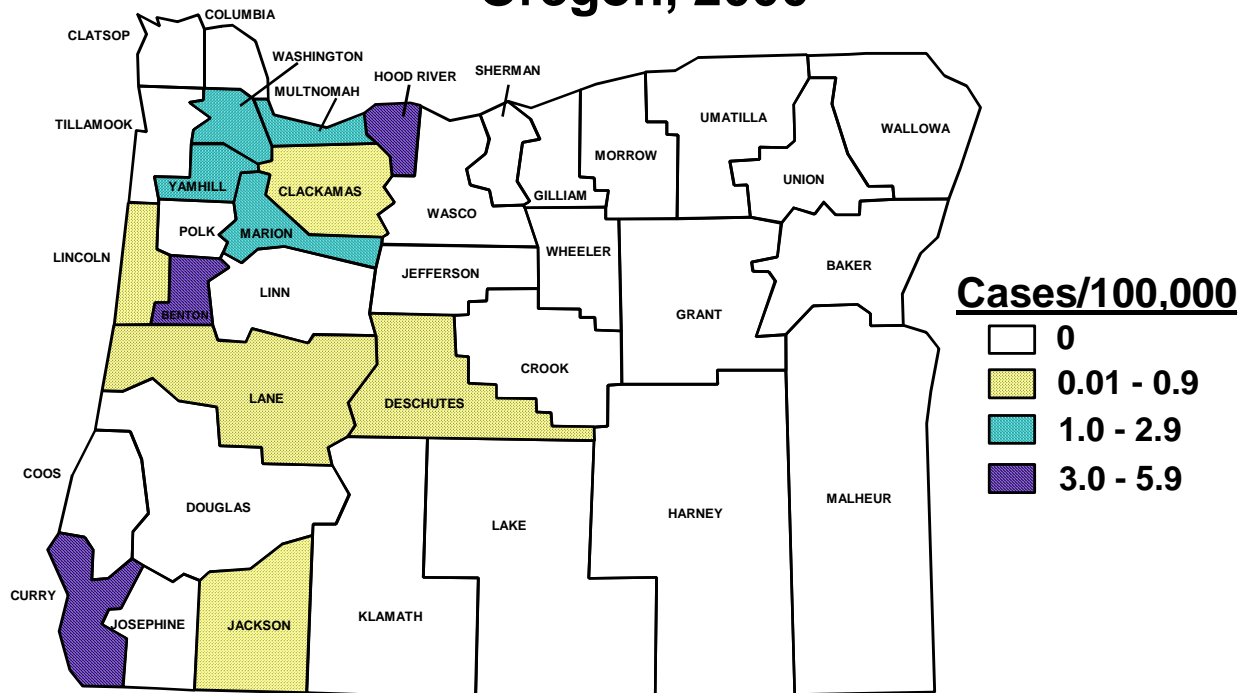
Incidence of Malaria by Age and Sex Oregon, 2000



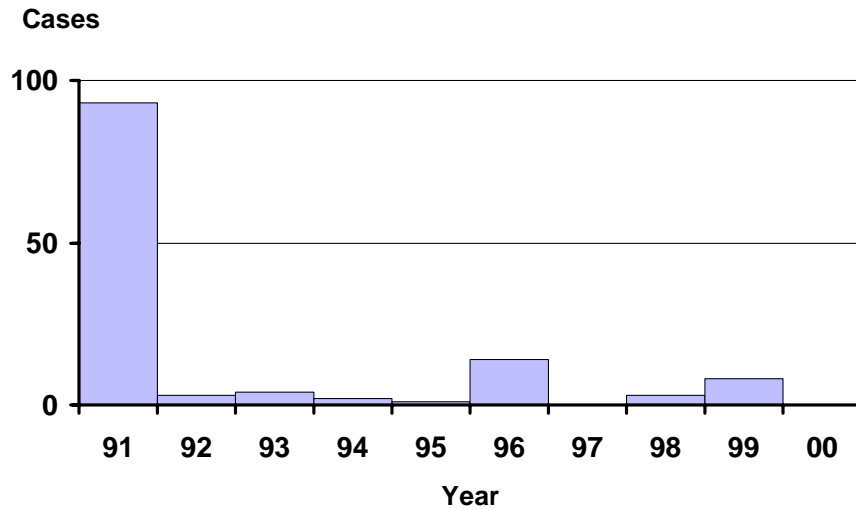
Incidence of Malaria Oregon vs. Nationwide 1991-2000



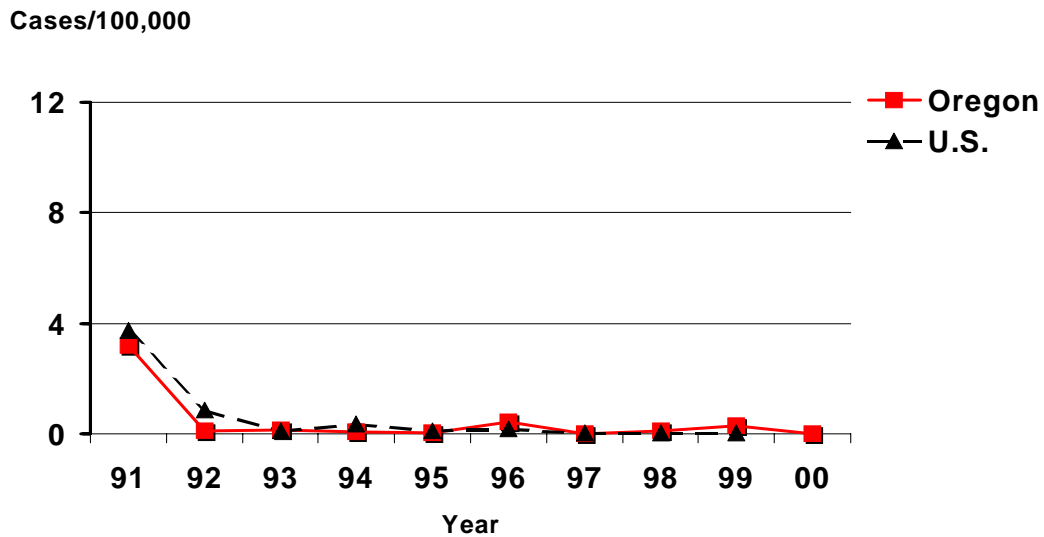
Incidence of Malaria by County Oregon, 2000



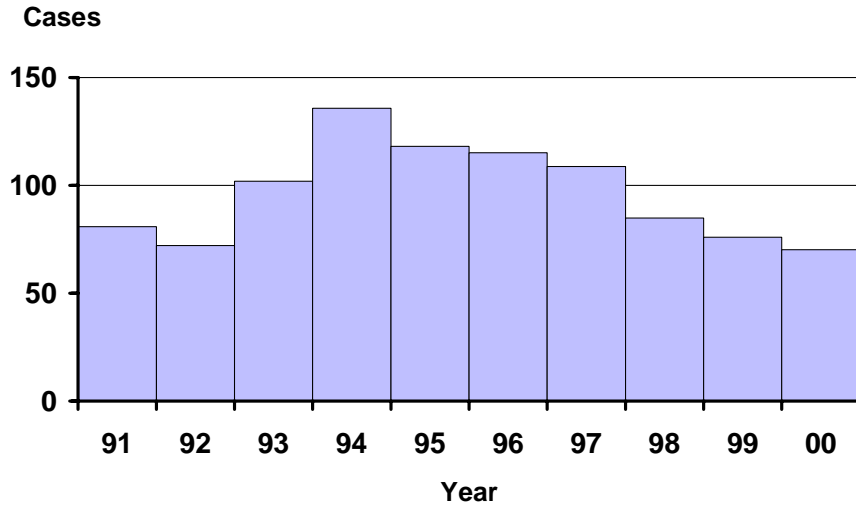

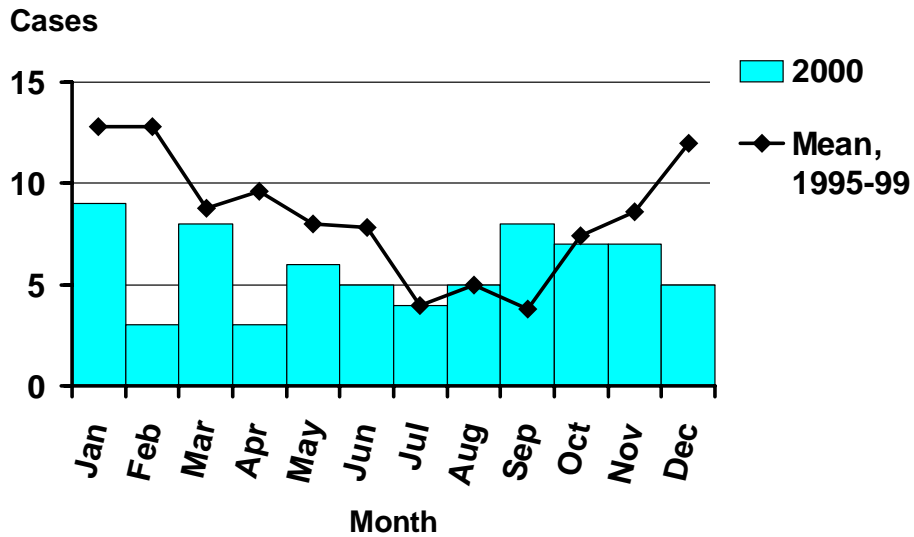
Incidence of Measles Oregon vs. Nationwide 1991-2000



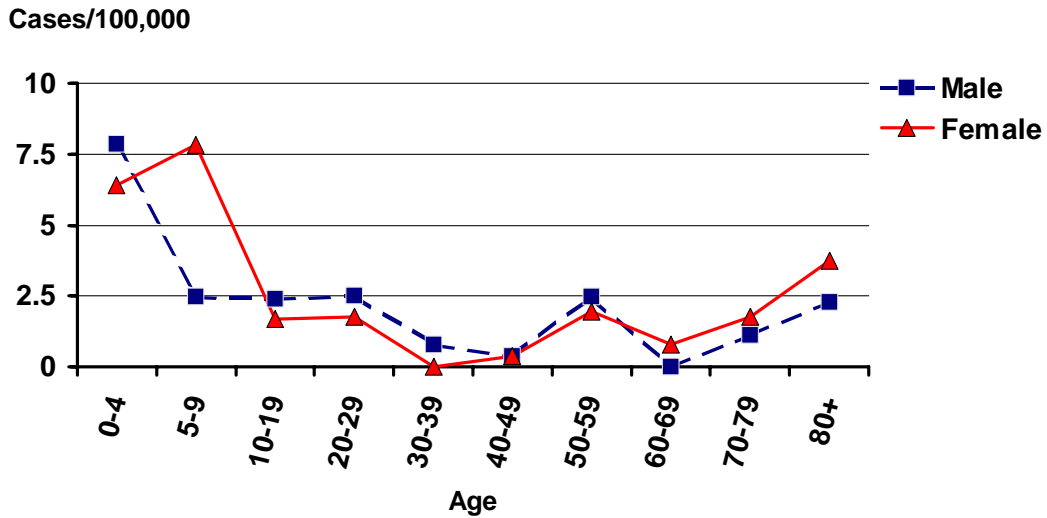
Meningococcal Disease by Year Oregon, 1991-2000



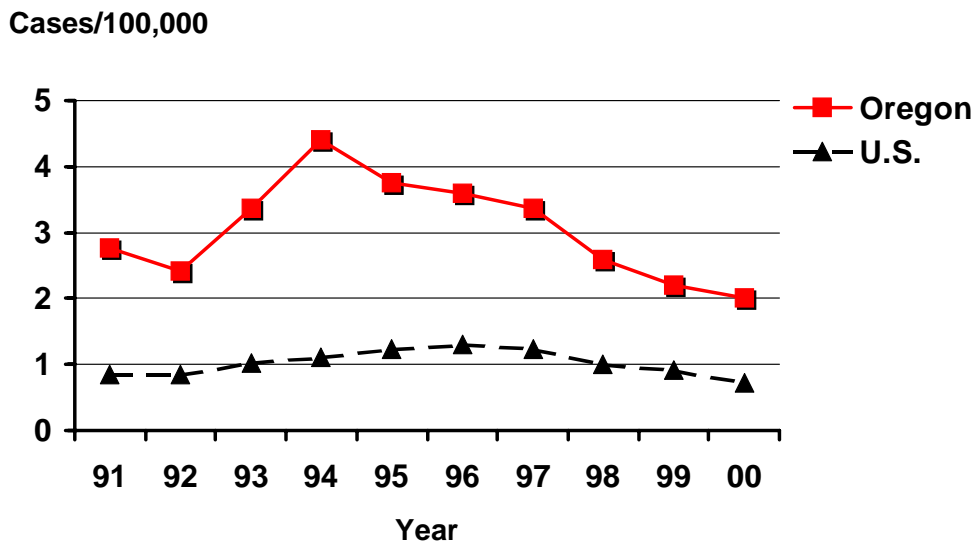
Meningococcal Disease by Onset Month Oregon, 2000



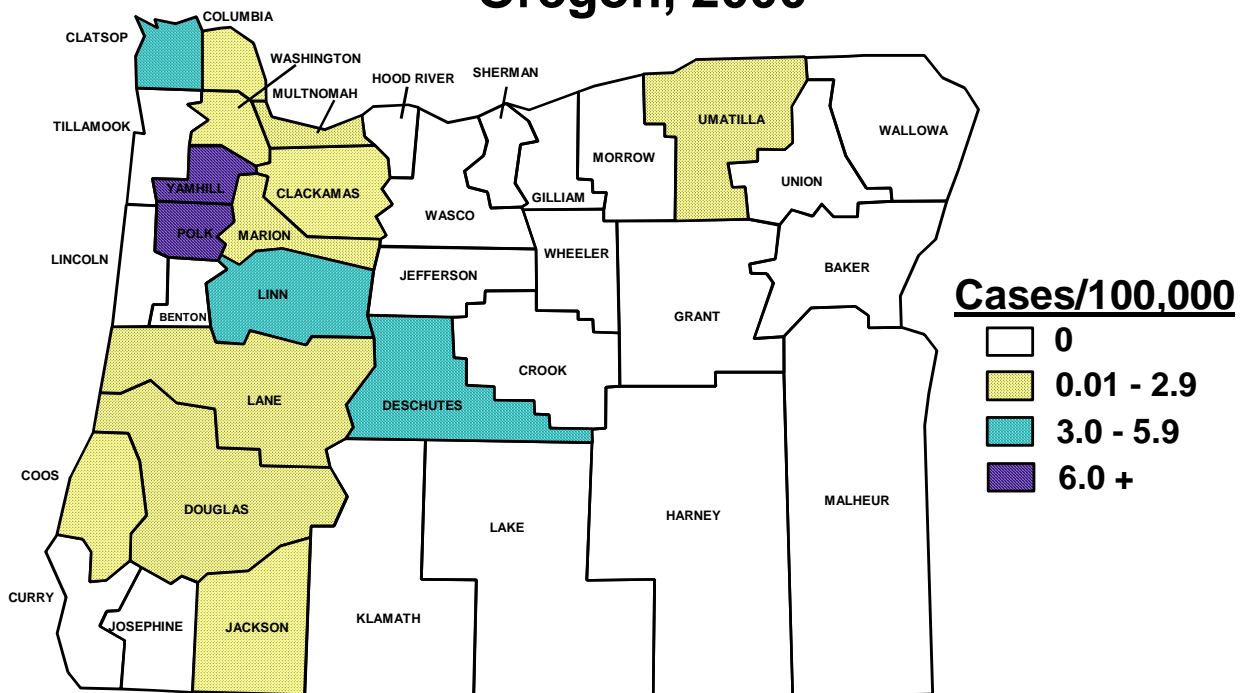
Incidence of Meningococcal Disease by Age and Sex Oregon, 2000



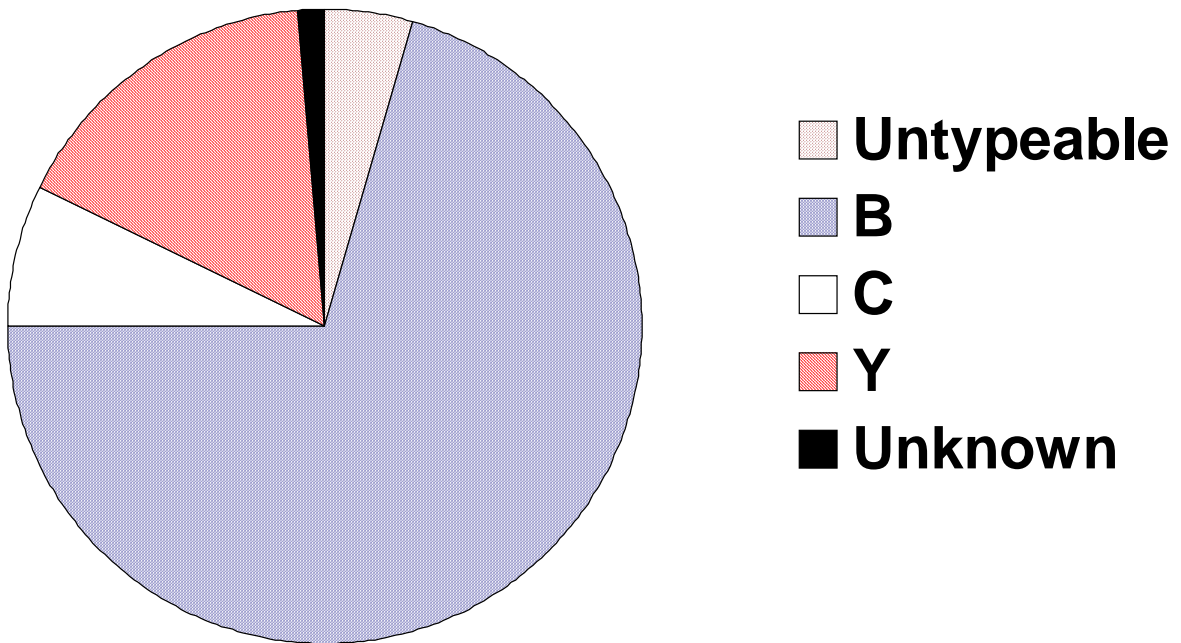
Incidence of Meningococcal Disease Oregon vs. Nationwide 1991-2000



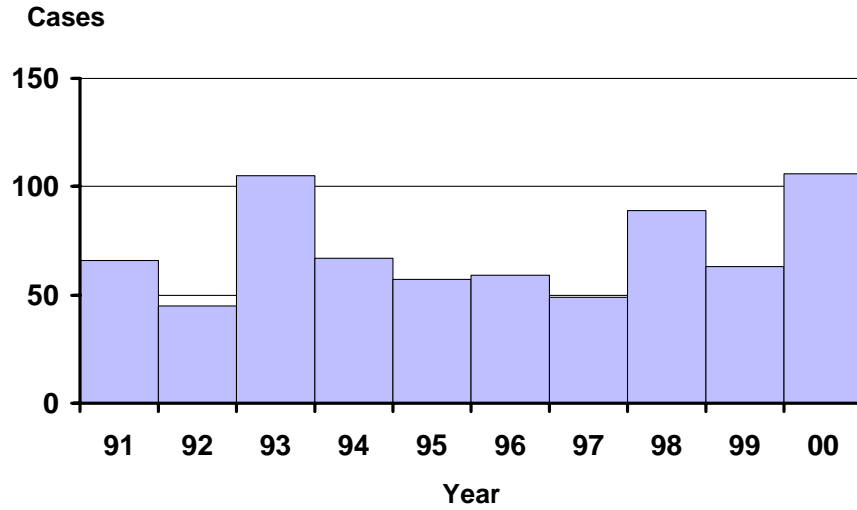
Incidence of Meningococcal Disease by County Oregon, 2000



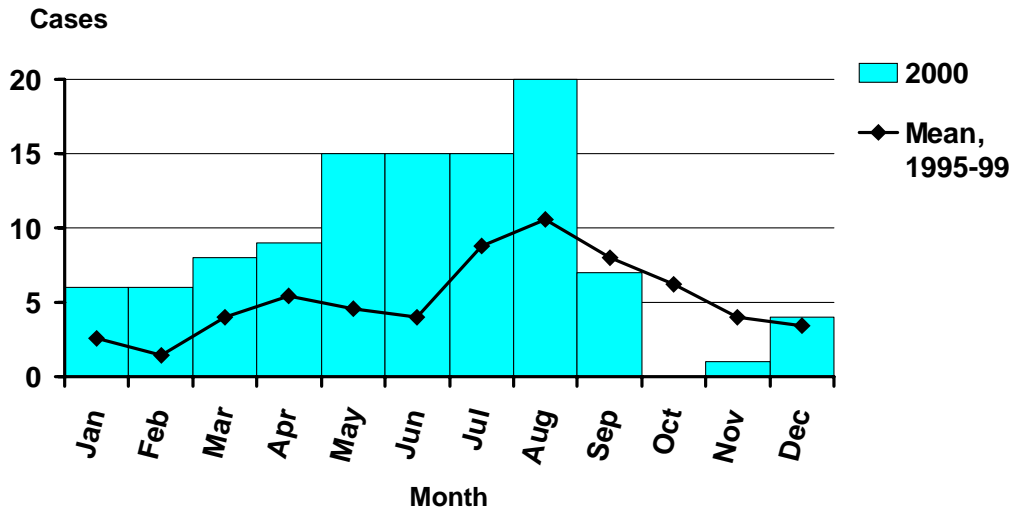
Meningococcal Disease by Serogroup Oregon, 2000



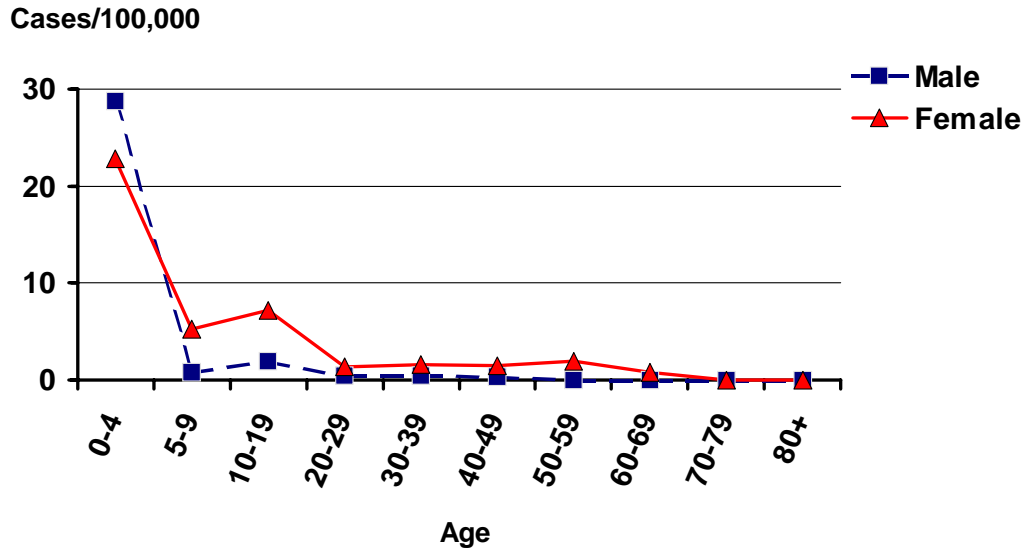

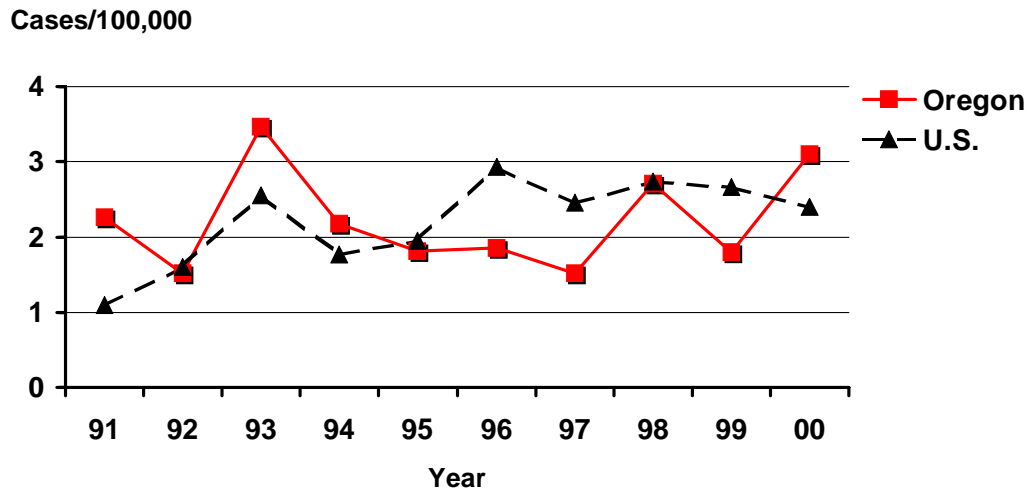

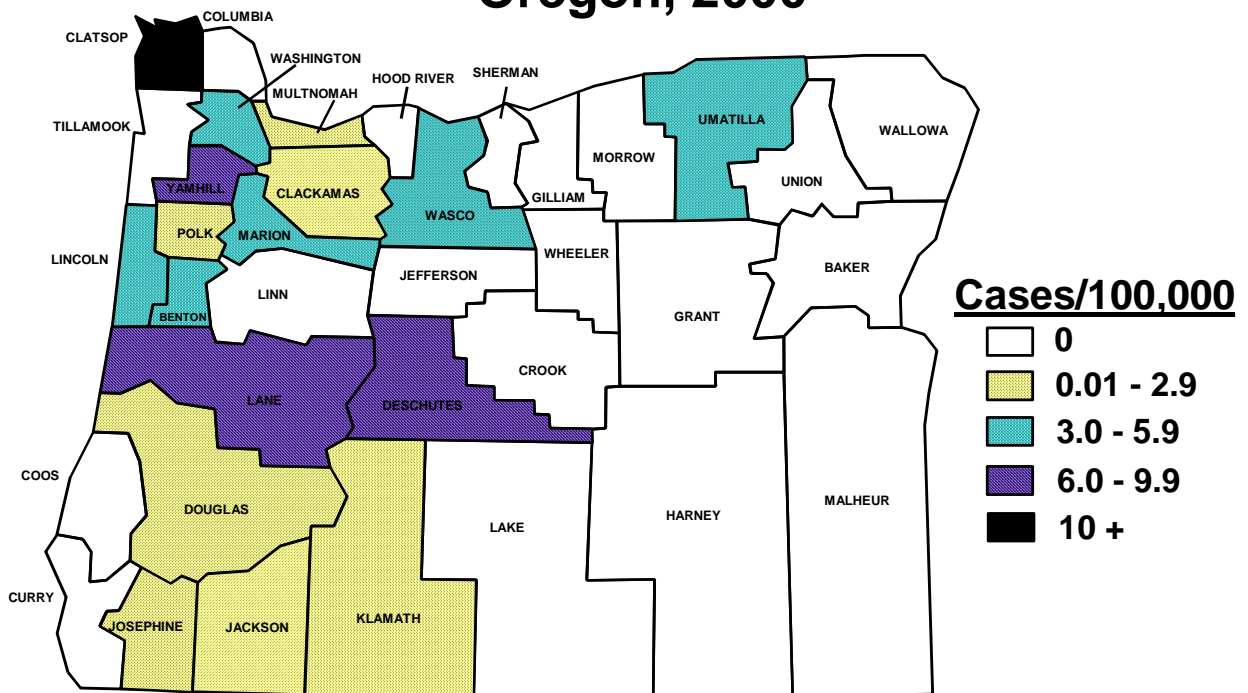
Incidence of Pertussis by Age and Sex Oregon, 2000



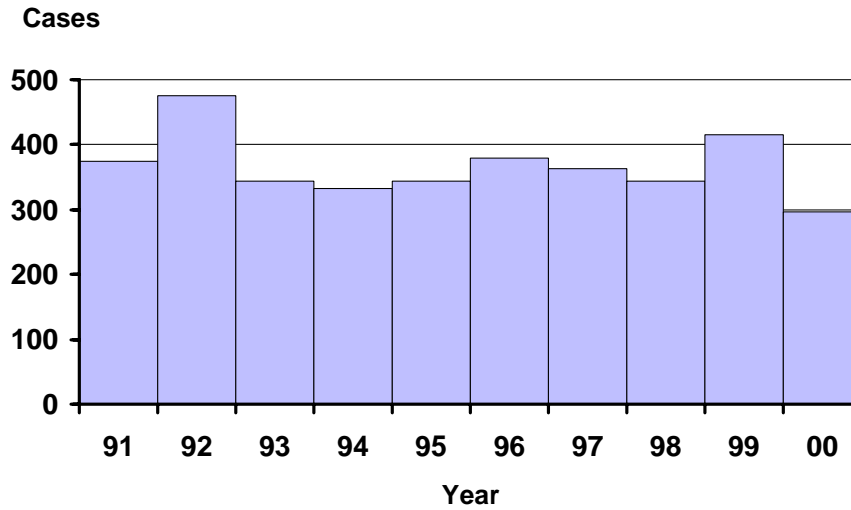
Incidence of Pertussis Oregon vs. Nationwide 1991-2000



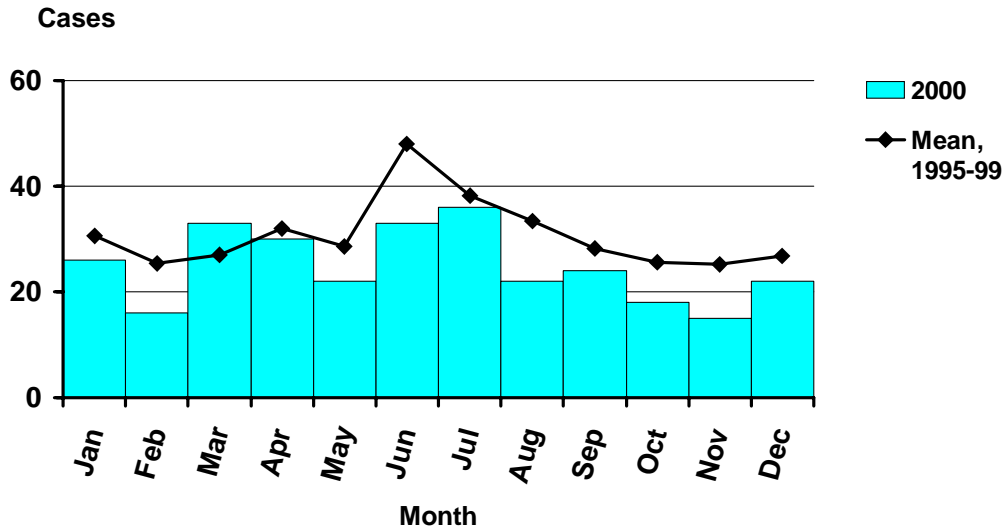

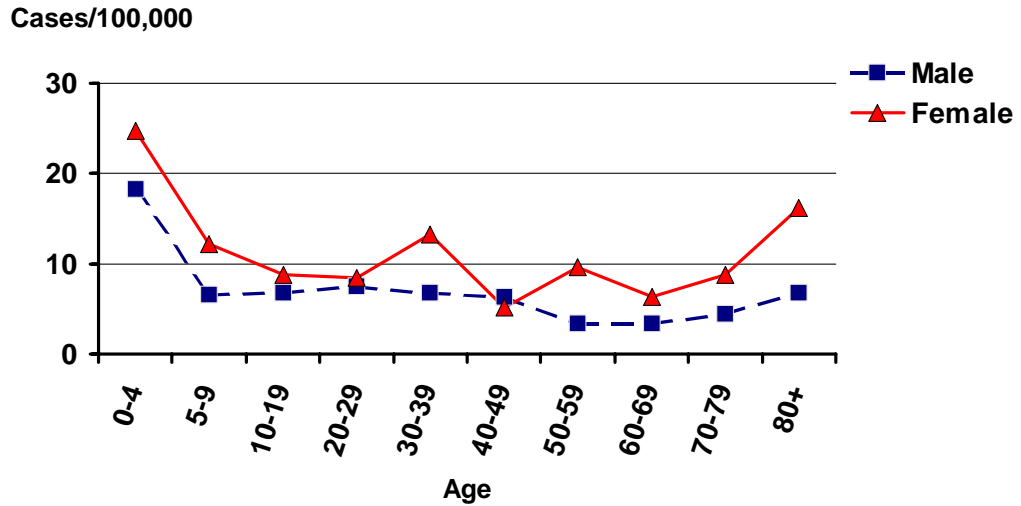
Salmonellosis by Year Oregon, 1991-2000



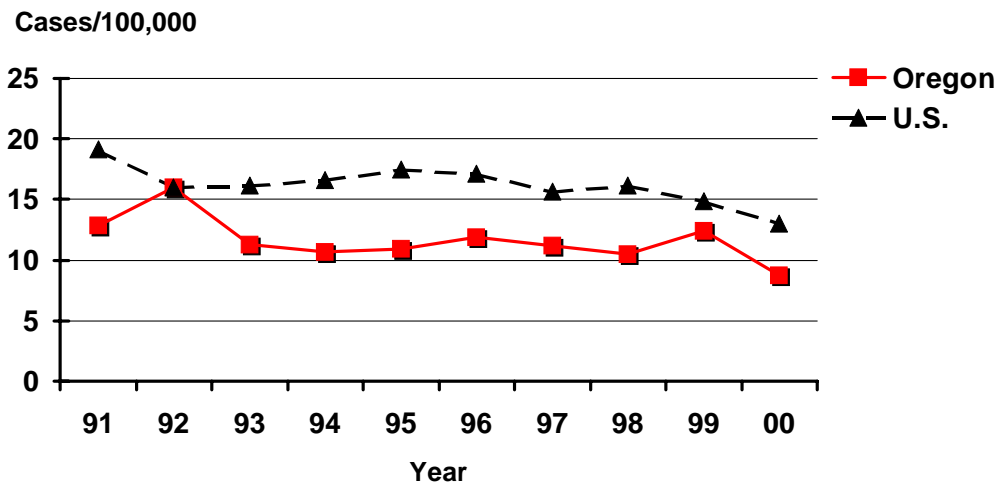
Salmonellosis by Onset Month Oregon, 2000



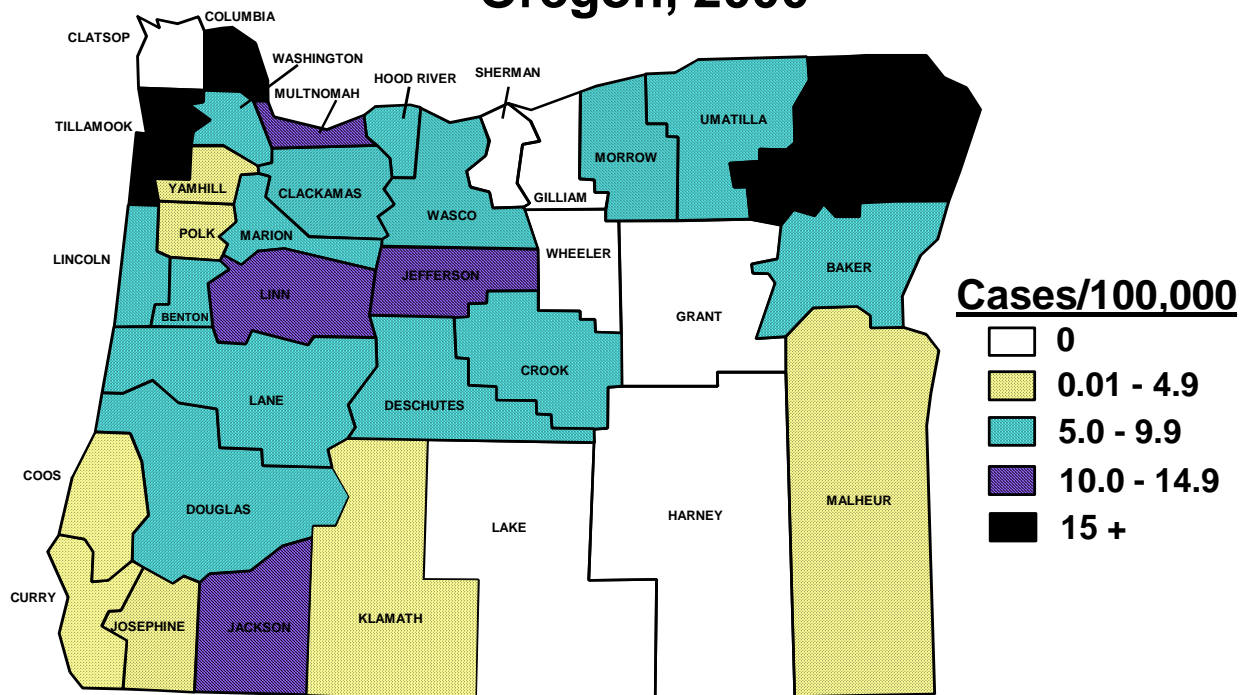
Incidence of Salmonellosis by Age and Sex Oregon, 2000

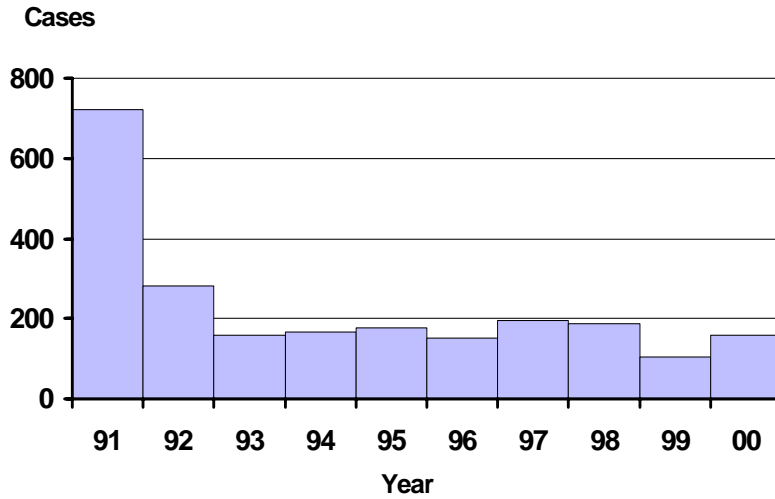

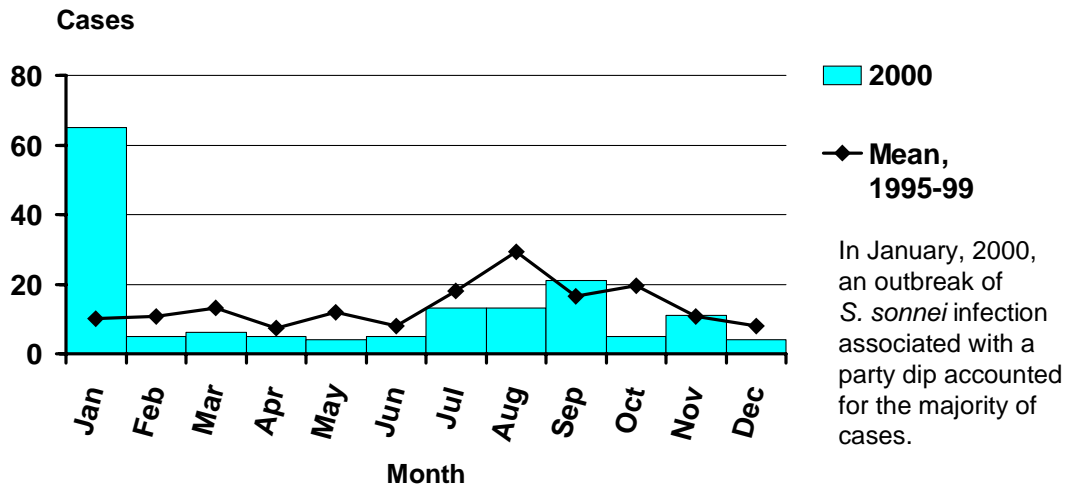

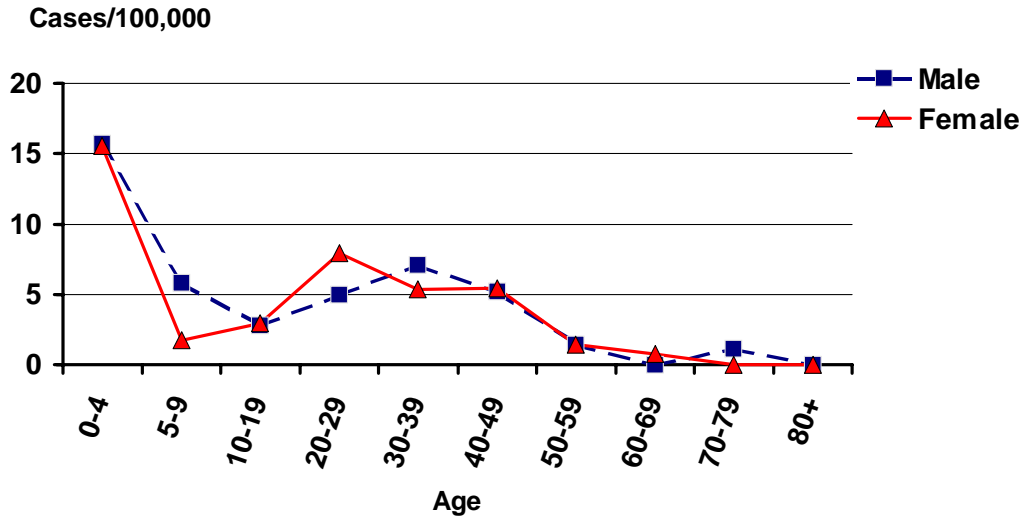
Shigellosis by Year Oregon, 1991-2000



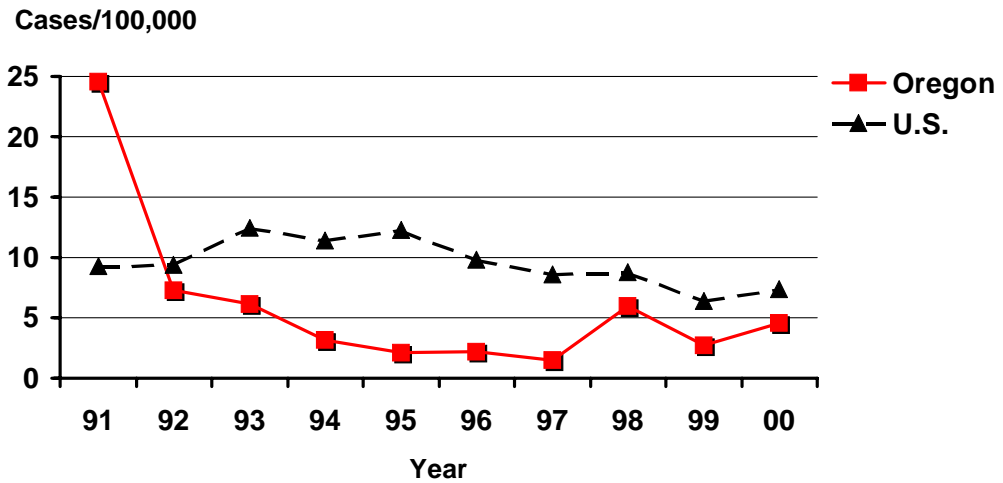
Shigellosis by Onset Month Oregon, 2000



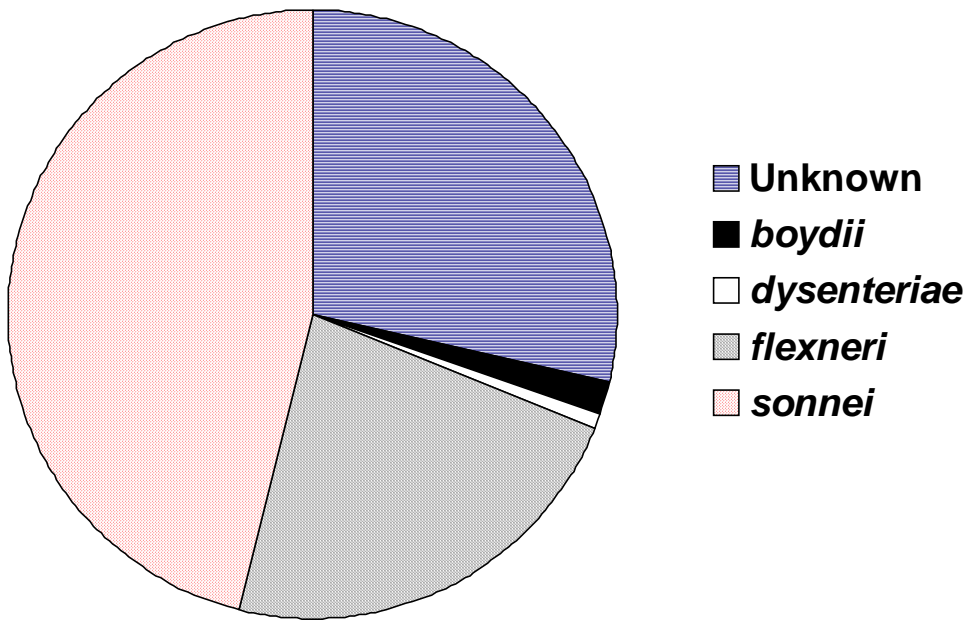
Incidence of Shigellosis by Age and Sex Oregon, 2000



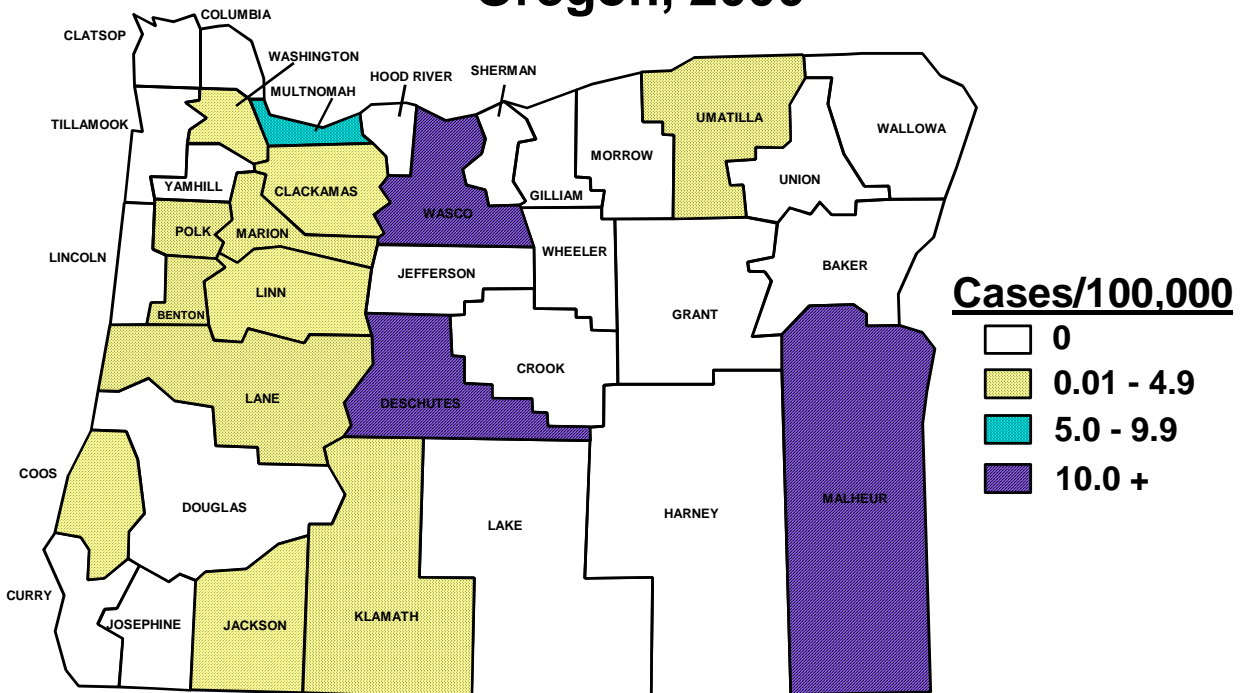
Incidence of Shigellosis Oregon vs. Nationwide 1991-2000



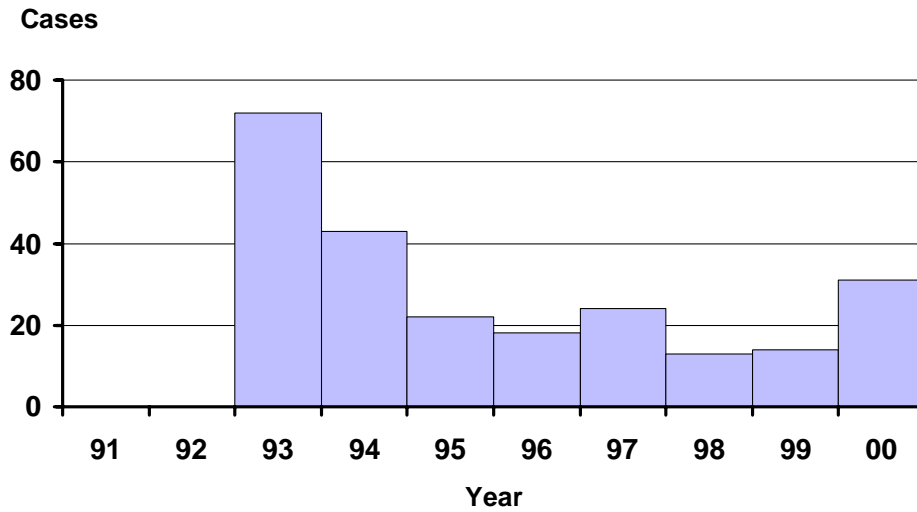

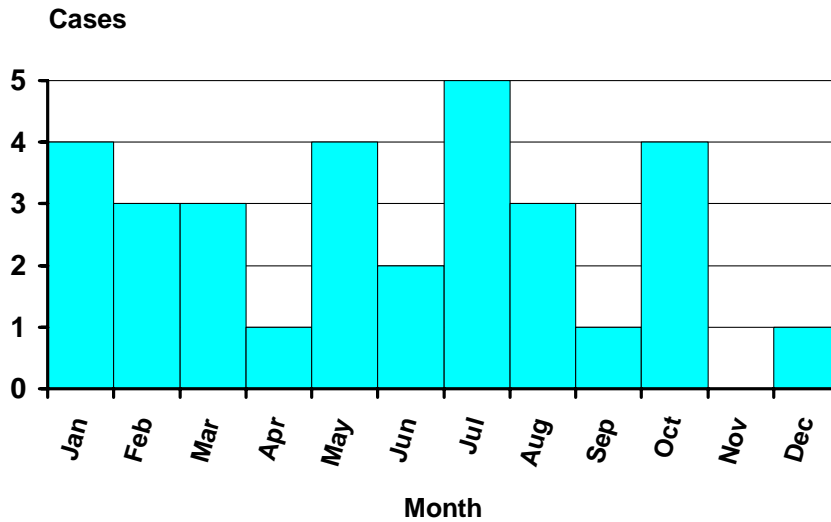
Incidence of Shigellosis by County Oregon, 2000



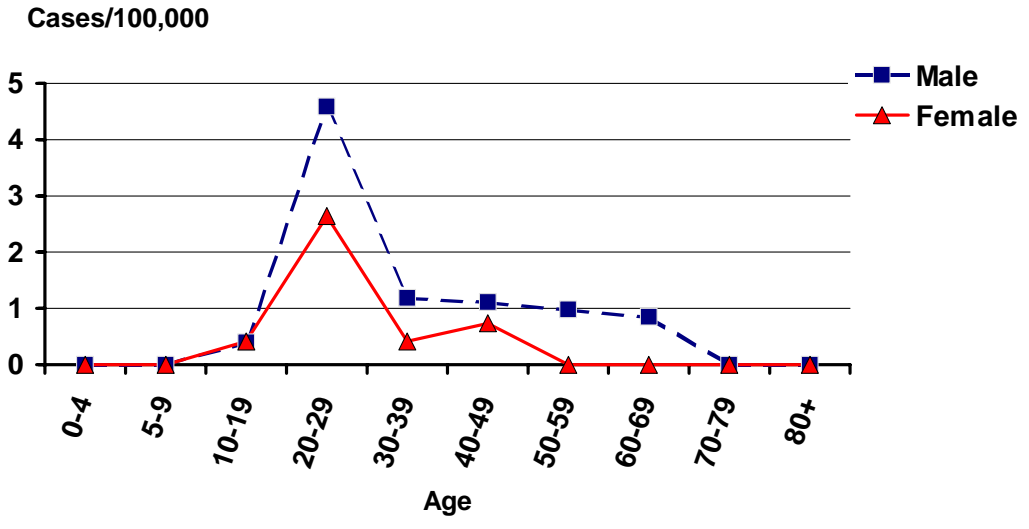
Syphilis by Year Oregon, 1991-2000



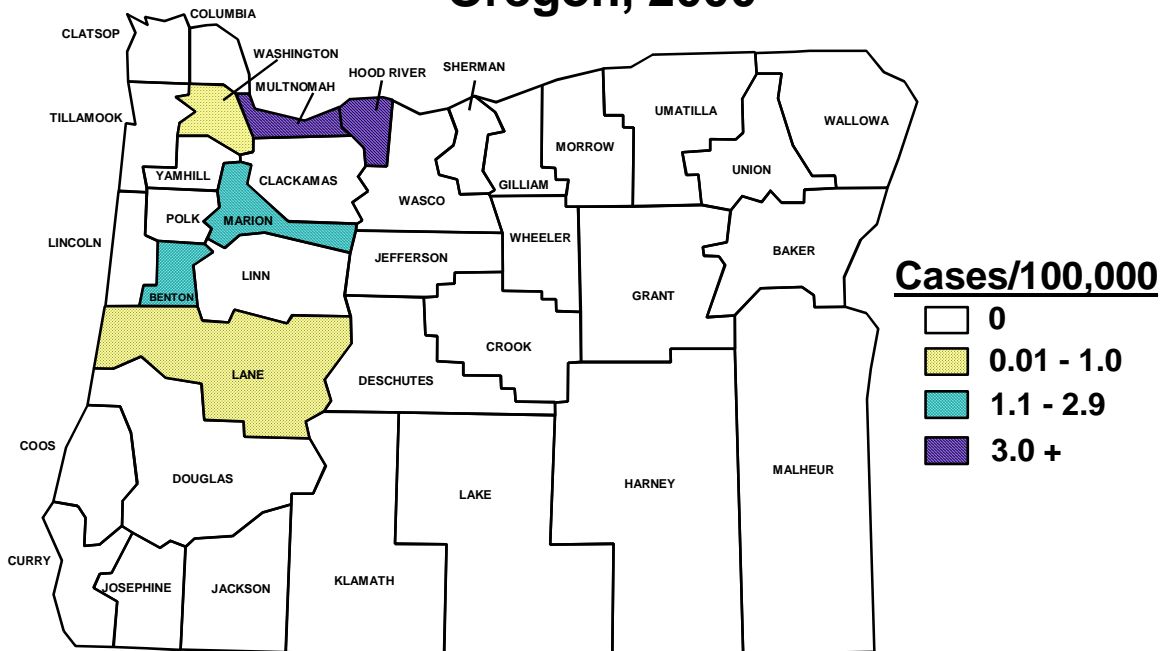
Syphilis by Onset Month Oregon, 2000



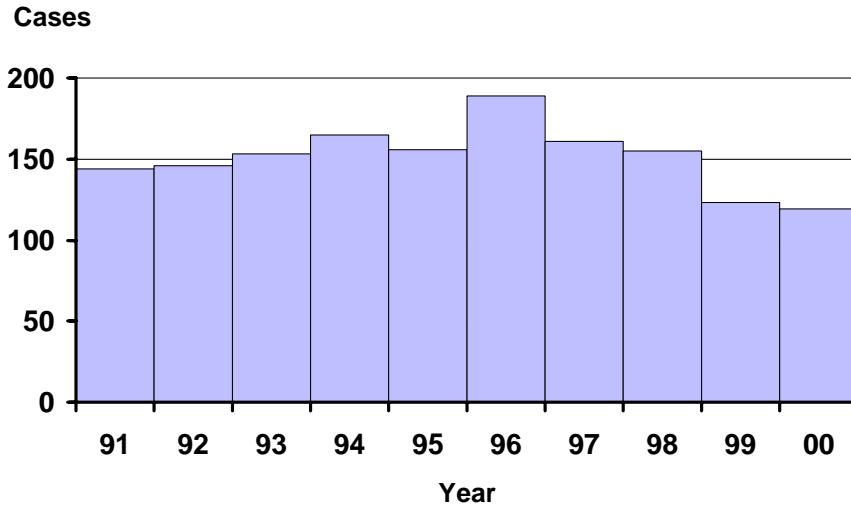
Incidence of Syphilis by Age and Sex Oregon, 2000



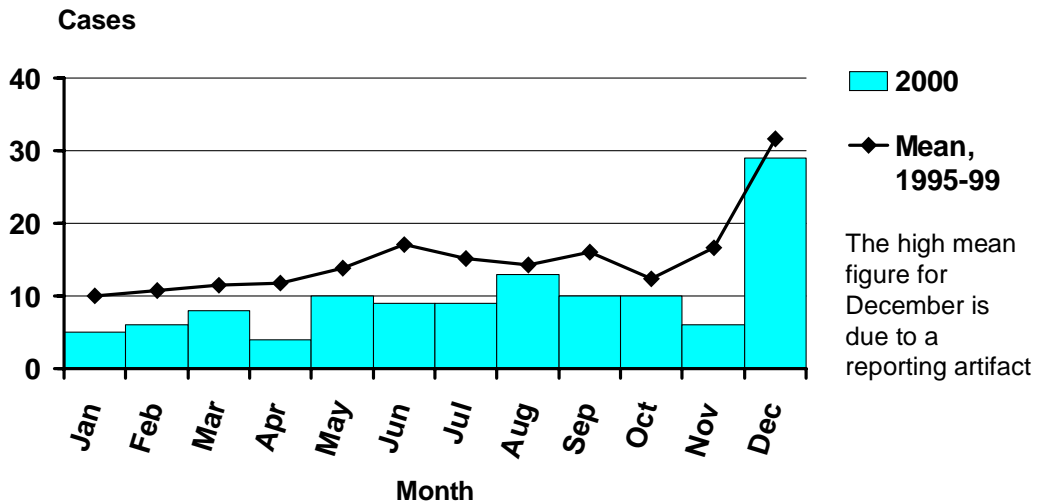

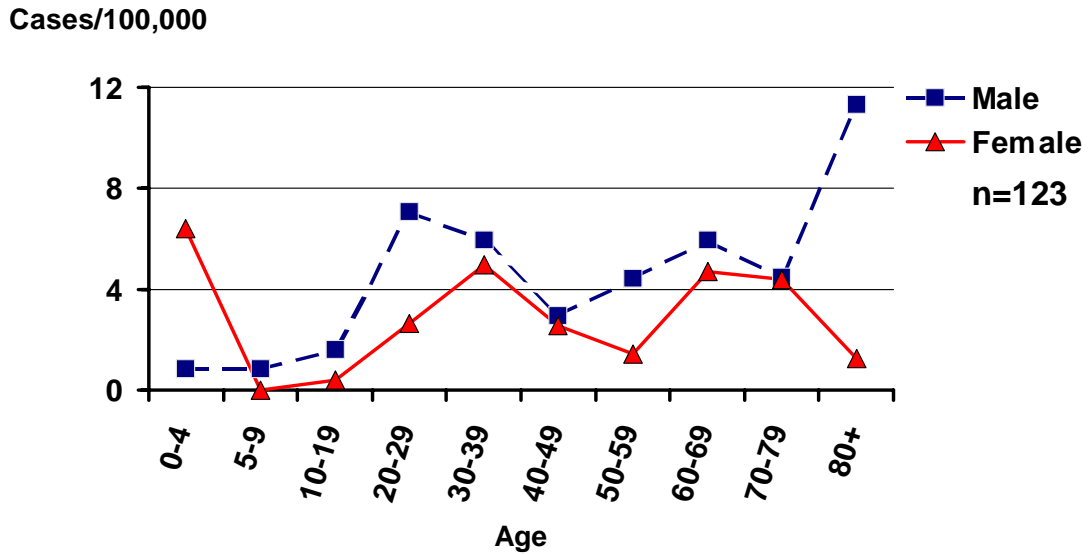
Tuberculosis by Year Oregon, 1991-2000



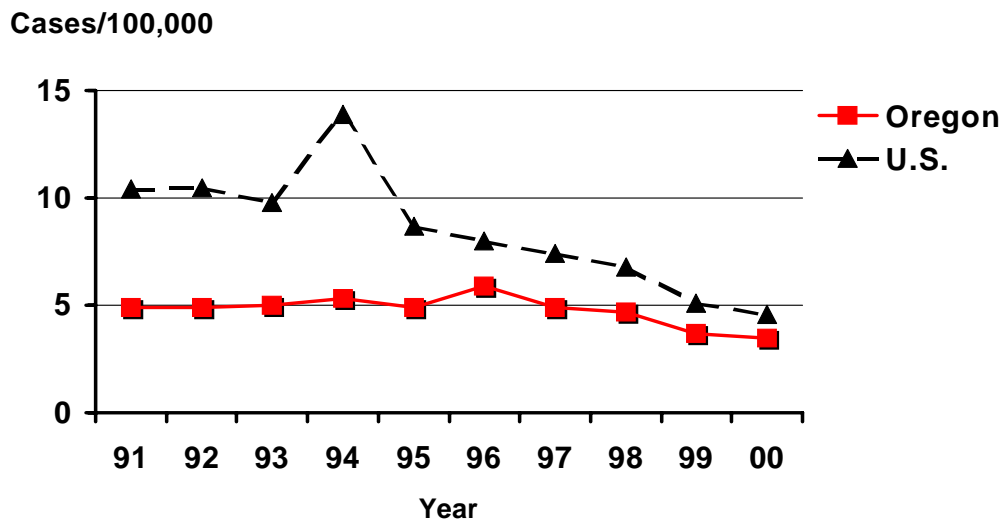

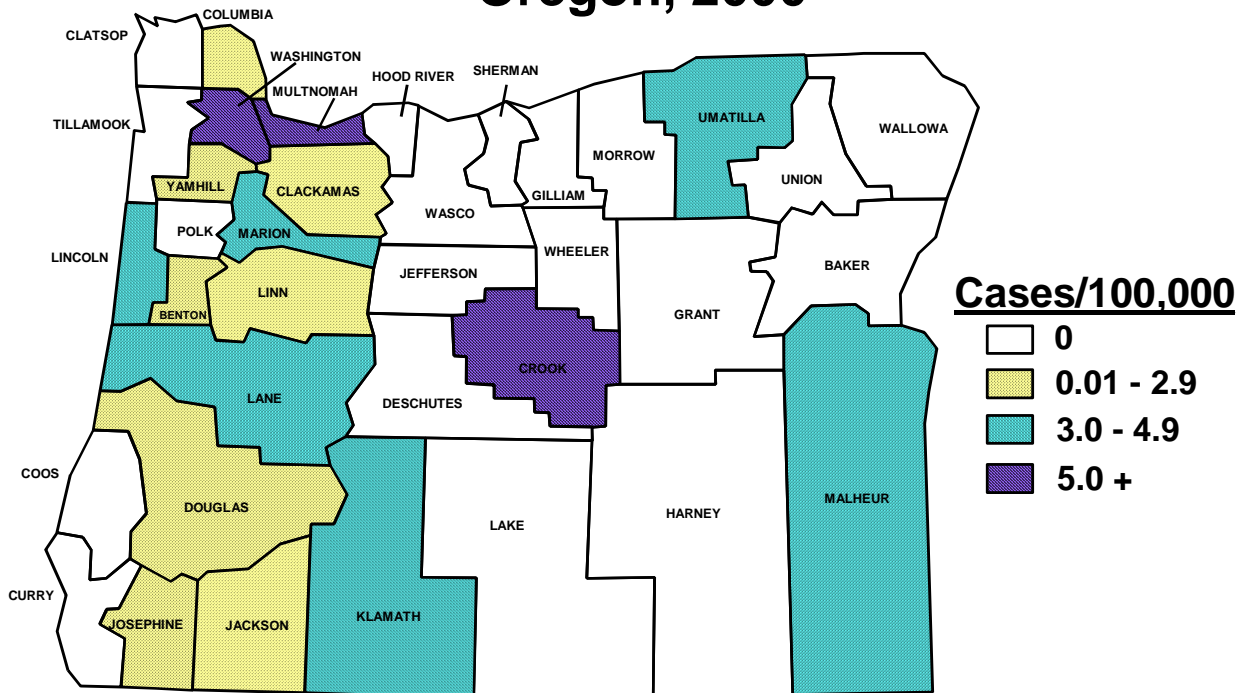
Incidence of Tuberculosis by Age and Sex Oregon, 2000



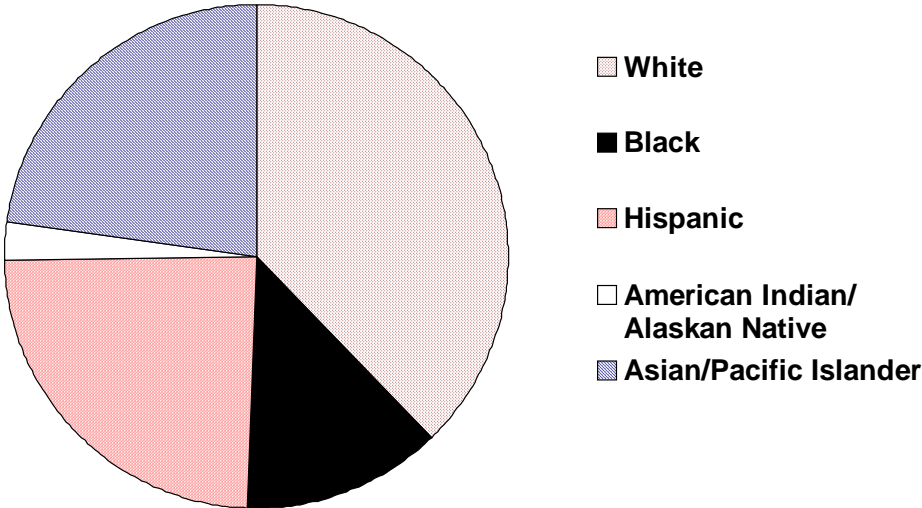
Incidence of Tuberculosis Oregon vs. Nationwide 1991-2000



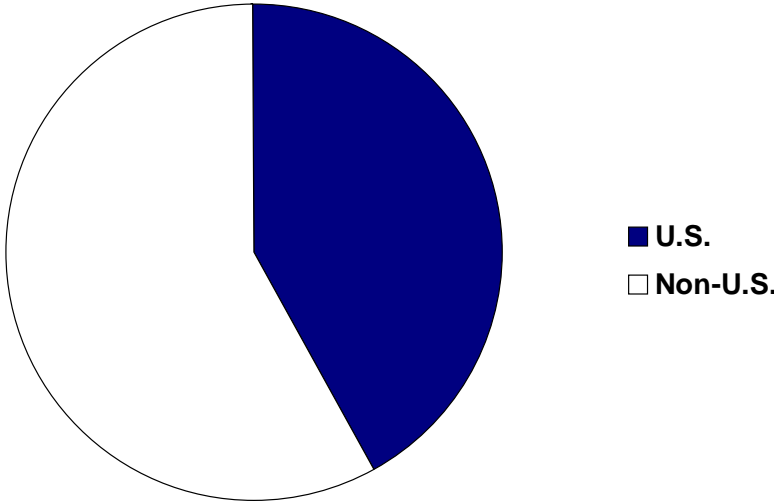

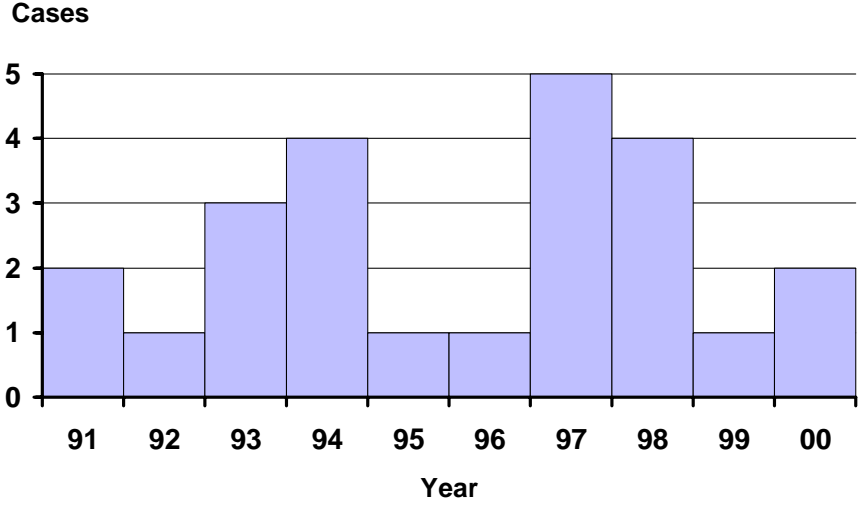
Tuberculosis by Race/Ethnicity Oregon, 2000



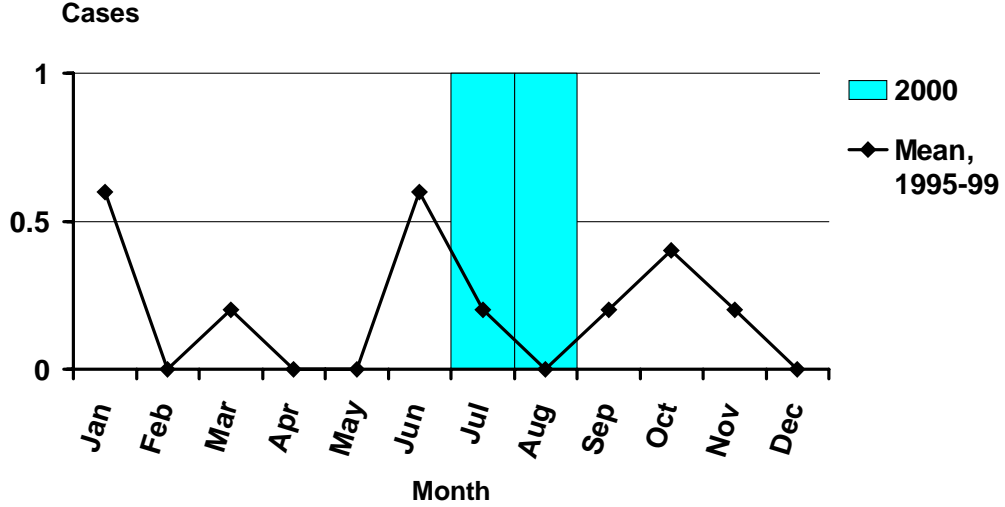

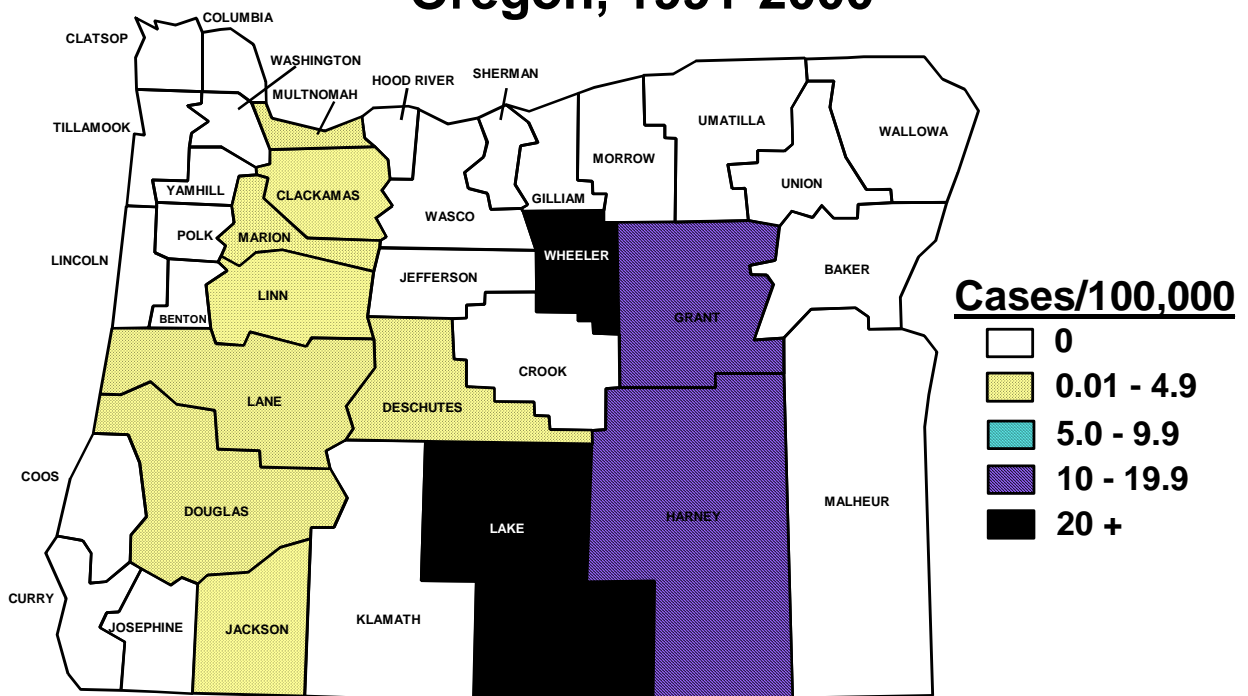
Tularemia by Year Oregon, 1991-2000

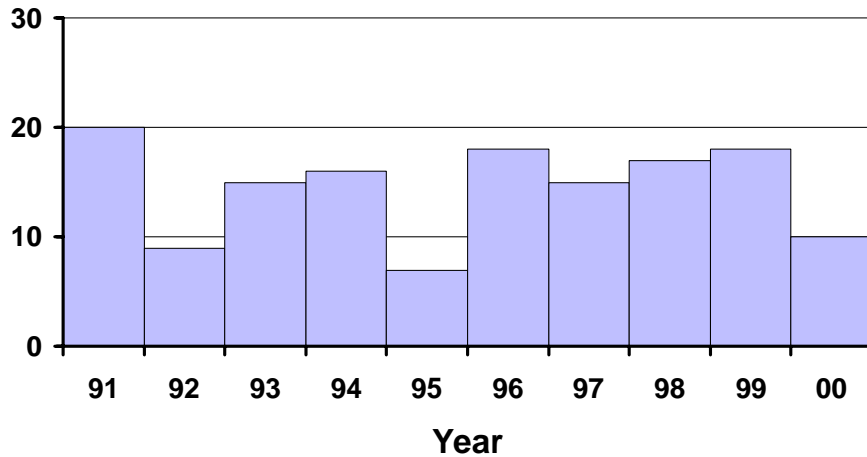


Incidence of Tularemia by County Oregon, 1991-2000

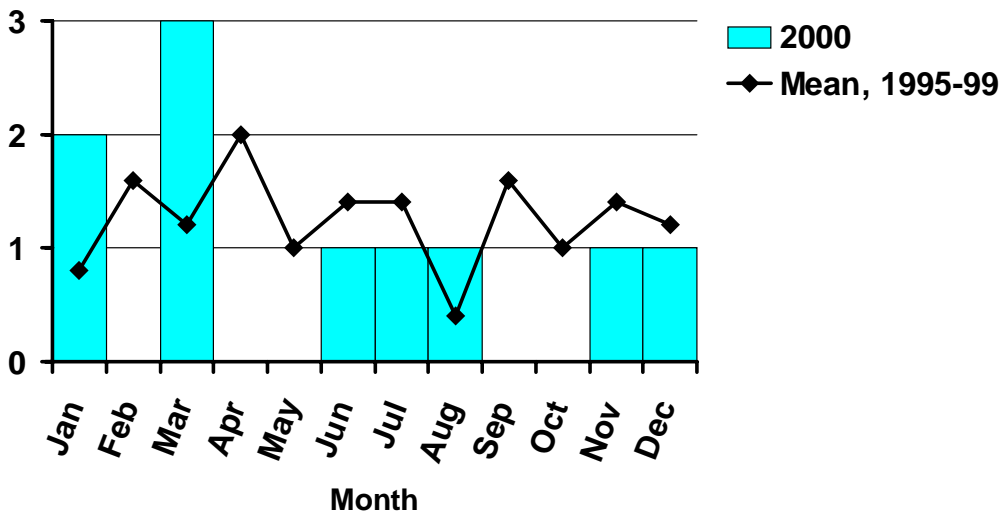

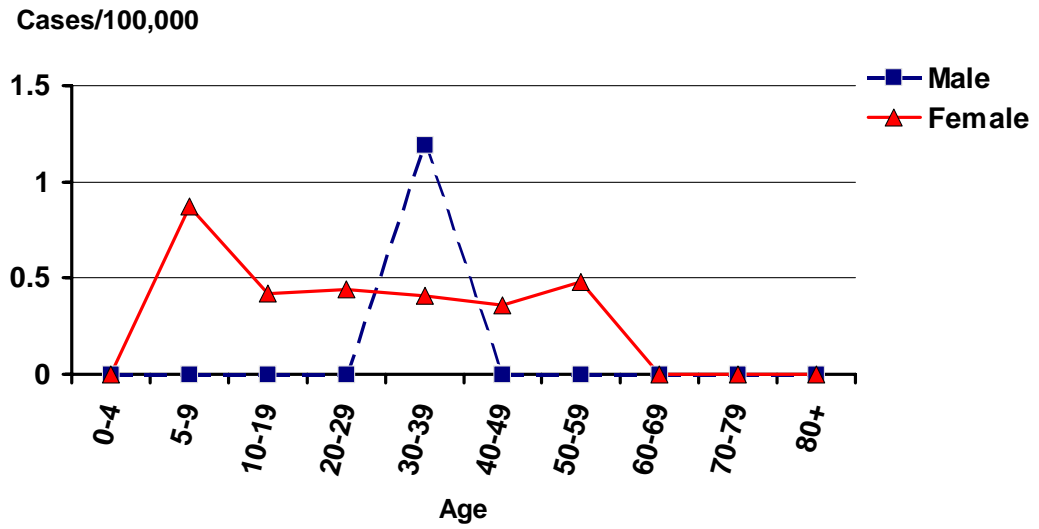

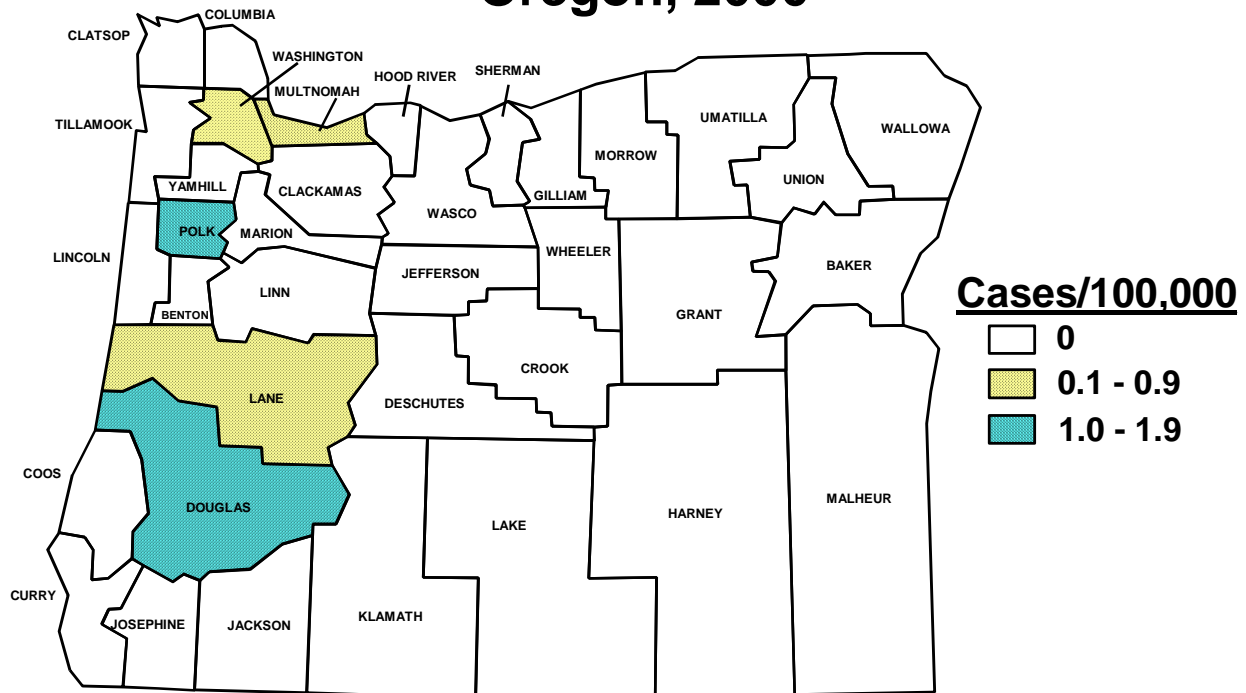


Incidence of Yersiniosis by Age and Sex Oregon, 2000
