
OREGON NOROVIRUS WATCH, MARCH 2016. This issue of *Oregon Norovirus Watch* includes norovirus outbreak data from the 2015–2016 norovirus season. In the month of March 2016, 23 norovirus or norovirus-like outbreaks were reported, of which 10 (43%) were in nursing homes, 4 (17%) were in schools and



5 (22%) in a restaurant. Since March 2015, 100 (56%) of 178 lab-confirmed and norovirus-like outbreaks occurred in nursing homes or assisted-living facilities (Fig. 1). Over the last year, GII.4 Sydney was identified in 38 (53%) of 72 lab-confirmed outbreaks.
