

# PrEP Grade A Recommendation FOR HIV PREVENTION



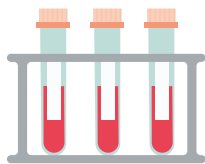
In June 2020, The United States Preventive Services Task Force (USPSTF) gave daily oral PrEP its strongest rating recommendation, a Grade A. Under the Affordable Care Act (ACA), most private health plans and all Medicaid-expansion programs must cover all USPSTF Grade A recommended services free-of-charge, without co-pays or cost-sharing to insured persons. These standards reflect CDC clinical practice guidelines and help ensure safe and effective prescribing.

As of September 17, 2021,
