SURVEY AND EVALUATION OVERVIEW

Project background

In September 2015, a survey of nutrition education materials was mailed to each local WIC agency, including samples of all the materials offered by the state agency, in print, online and in Spanish. Fifty-nine materials were grouped into five categories, based on audience/WIC category: Infants (Birth to 12 months); Toddlers & Children (1-5 years); the Whole Family; Pregnant & Postpartum Women; and Breastfeeding Promotion (see Appendix A). A guidance document—based on health literacy principles—was provided to facilitate the assessment, and agencies were asked to use group consensus decision making to complete the survey (see Appendix B).

The goal of the survey was to gather input from local agencies to help determine which materials to keep providing, which need to be revised or discontinued, and what new materials are available for potential use in the future. The survey solicited feedback on whether local staff were familiar with the materials provided, if the materials were useful for working with participants, and on the appropriateness of the format and content of the materials for the target audience. Additionally, local agencies were asked to identify gaps in nutrition topic areas, suggest alternate languages or formats, and provide materials they've created themselves or obtained from sources other than the state (see Appendix C for full Survey).

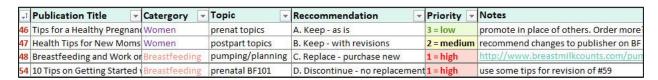
Survey Response

One-hundred and sixty-seven (167) local staff from 24 agencies contributed feedback to the survey. Over 100 locally developed or purchased nutrition education materials were also returned. The participating agencies were: Baker, Benton, Clackamas, Clatsop, Columbia, Curry, Deschutes, Douglas, Harney, Jackson, Jefferson, Josephine, Klamath, Lane, Lincoln, Linn, Malheur, Marion, Multnomah, North Central, Salud, Union, Warm Springs, and Washington.

Evaluation Methods

Survey responses for each of the 59 state provided items were compiled electronically, with individual agency identifiers removed. Responses were tallied to capture awareness and usefulness, content and format ratings, and local agency recommendations to keep or discontinue each item. Comments were also compiled for each item, along with responses to open-ended questions for each category.

Small groups of 2-3 state staff subject matter experts (SMEs) were convened for each of the five categories of materials. SME groups reviewed quantitative results and qualitative responses, as well as assessed the materials returned by the local agencies. The goal of the SME groups was to identify the primary nutrition education topic(s) for each state provided material (ex: Iron/Anemia), provide a recommendation based on an assessment of the returned survey data, and prioritize any recommended actions. Priority was based on policy requisites, frequency of use, and immediacy of need. Topic gaps were also identified, and recommendations for new materials were given.



Recommendations were by Oregon WIC leadership, and budgetary allowances were considered. Below are the final outcomes, including timelines for rolling out the changes.

OUTCOMES

 - To be phased out by fall 2016. Recommend using *Tips for Healthy Pregnancy*, <u>My</u>
 <u>Pregnancy Plate</u> (OHSU), or purchasing <u>Healthy Eating from Head to Toe for Expecting</u>

 <u>Moms</u> (Childbirth Graphics) using end-of-year funds.

Filling gaps with new resources

The survey analysis also identified gaps between some nutrition education topics and the availability of resources provided by the state. Appropriate print resources or links to online resources will be located or developed moving forward.

ADDITIONAL RECOMMENDATIONS

Another finding from the survey was that some local agency staff were not aware of the many nutrition education materials offered by the state, both in print or online. This has been a recurring finding from previous surveys. The Nutrition Education WIC Support (NEWS) Group recommended the following to increase awareness of the breadth of materials offered by the state, as well as how to organize them to make ordering and printing them easier:

- 1) Develop a separate order form just for printed nutrition education materials. The current Publications Order Form includes all the materials for outreach, training, vendor, shopper notification, clinic forms and online only materials.
- 2) Reorganize the nutrition education section of the state WIC website to have the nutrition education materials on a single web page to make them more easily accessible.

- 3) Organize the materials on the order form and online listing by WIC category (Infant, Child, Women, etc.), as on the Survey.
- 4) Include thumbnail images of the materials, both on the order form and online listing. This would aid recognition of the item, facilitate the ordering and printing process, decrease errors, and help staff learn when updated versions are available.
- 5) Move to an online ordering system if feasible. An online system would remove the extra step of having to print/fax, or scan/e-mail the order form.

Appendix B

WIC Nutrition Education Materials Assessment Guidance

Consider each item in the survey based on:

- **Content** (the nutrition education message)
 - o Is the item participant centered? Or does it contain language such as 'you should' or 'you need to'? What suggestions do you have to improve the language?
 - o Is the item easy to read and understand? Does it use common, everyday language?
- **Format** (layout, color, images, overall design)
 - O Does it use elements such as bullets to break up chunks of information into a few key points? Or does it provide "information overload"?
 - o Does the item facilitate interaction with participants?

If y	you want to dig deeper in your assessment, you might use this Plain Language Checklist.
	Written for the intended audience Who is your average reader? Write to that person; not to the experts.
	Uses pictures to convey a message A picture is worth a thousand words. Graphics should aid comprehension, not confuse the audience.
	Organized to serve the reader's needs Put the most important material first, less important last. This helps readers find what they're looking for
	Uses simple, everyday words Big words confuse readers. Define (and limit!) abbreviations.
	Omits extra words Challenge every worddo you need it?
	Uses short sections separated by headings Readers get lost in long dense text with few headings. Chunking your material into sections also inserts white space, making it easier to read and less overwhelming.
	Uses lists and tables Lists and tables help shorten and clarify complex material.
	Uses active voice and present tense "Children should eat fruit every day" (active voice) vs. "Fruit should be eaten by children every day" (passive). "We recommend breastfeeding to all our mothers" (present tense) vs. "We will recommend breastfeeding to all our mothers" (future).
