2015 Legislative Session House Bill 2546 and the ICAA




Prohibits use of inhalants

Delivered into a person's respiratory system:

- Nicotine
- Cannabinoid
- Other Substances
- Herbal hookah





Nearly 9 out of 10 Oregon adults support the ICAA

Prohibits the use of cigarettes, e-cigarettes, marijuana and other inhalant delivery systems in workplaces, restaurants, bars and other indoor public places.

Believe people should be protected from breathing secondhand smoke: 91% Smoke 81% Vapor 79% Marijuana smoke or vapor

Believe secondhand exposure is harmful, outdoors

or vape

83% Smoke 59% Vape 58% Marijuana smoke

56% Exposed to secondhand smoke

restaurant or bar

7 in 10 support making outdoor seating areas at restaurants or bars smoke-free
