#### History of Oregon's ICAA

**1998-2001**: 12 Oregon communities pass smoke-free workplace laws

2001: Statewide











2007: Expansion



2011: Smoke shops



**2015:** Inhalant delivery systems





### ATTITUDES AND PERCEPTIONS IN OREGON



# Nearly 9 out of 10 Oregon adults support the ICAA

Prohibits the use of cigarettes, e-cigarettes, cannabis and other inhalant delivery systems in workplaces, restaurants, bars and other indoor public places.

Believe people should be protected from breathing secondhand smoke:

91% Smoke 83% Vapor 79% Marijuana smoke or vapor

**77%** of Oregon adults believe that all businesses should be smoke and vape free indoors



## Believe secondhand exposure is harmful, outdoors

83% Smoke
59% Vape
58% Marijuana smoke
