Basics of Oregon School Immunization Requirements

- Help protect almost 650,000 children against 11 vaccine-preventable diseases.
- Help build community immunity.
- Make sure kids can be brought up-to-date on vaccines at least once a year.





Back to School

Child's record must show at least one dose of each required vaccine or exemption



Fall

Schools work with families to get records for any missing vaccines



3rd Wednesday in February

Exclusion Day



Spring

Data collected from all schools, verified, and released

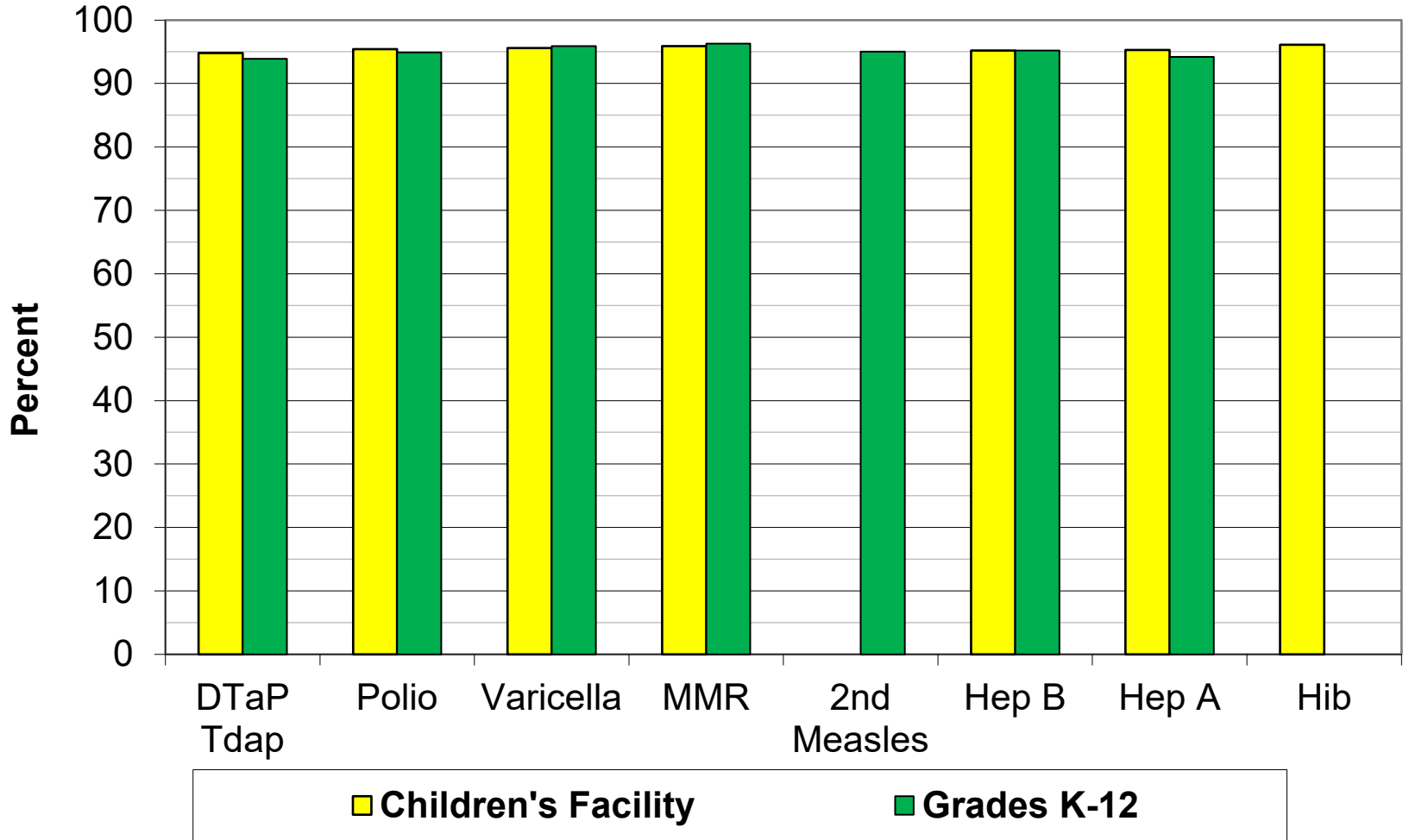

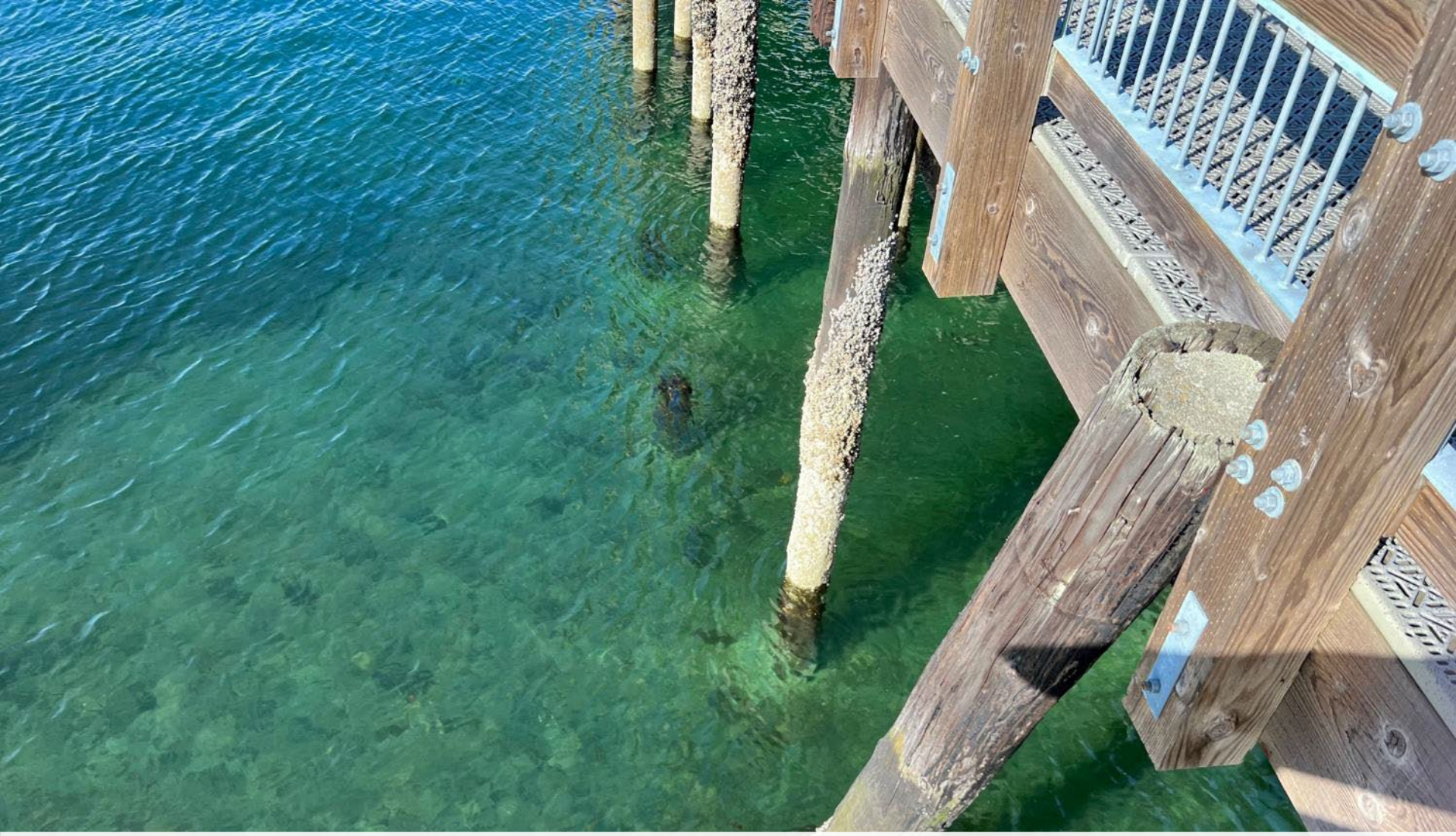

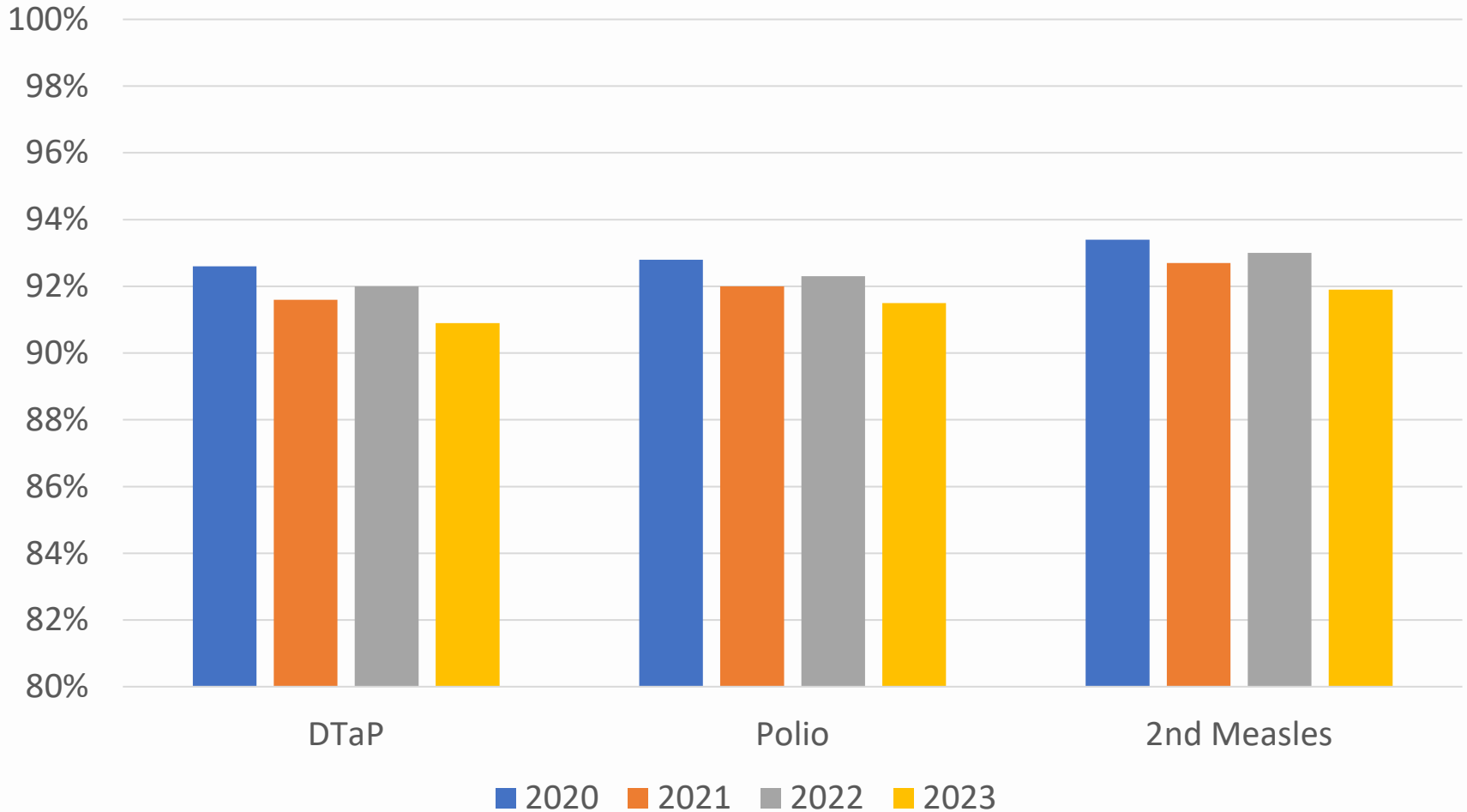
Percent of Children with School/Children's Facility Required Vaccines, 2023



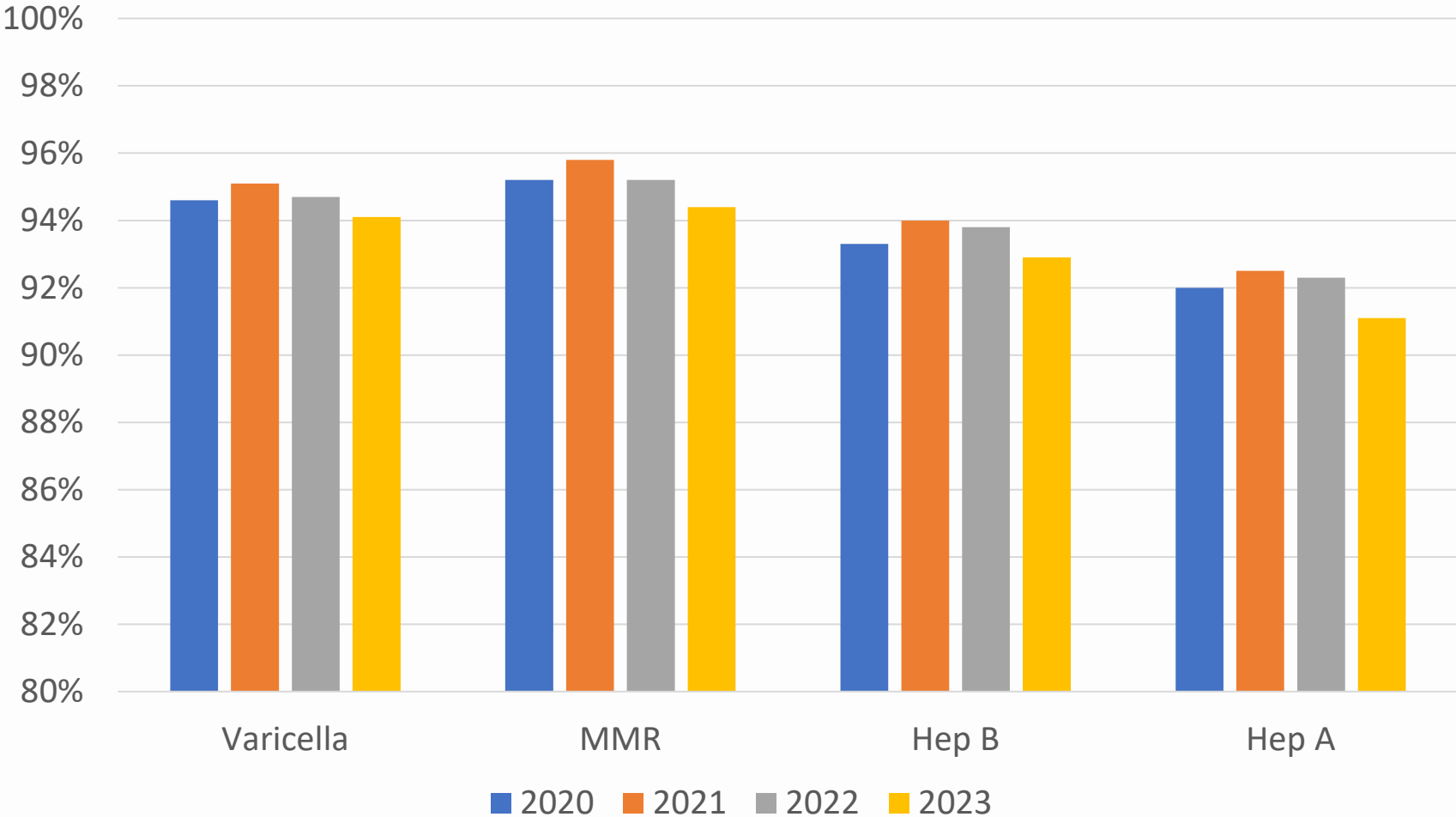

Oregon kindergarten rates, 2019-2023: Vaccines given at kindergarten entry



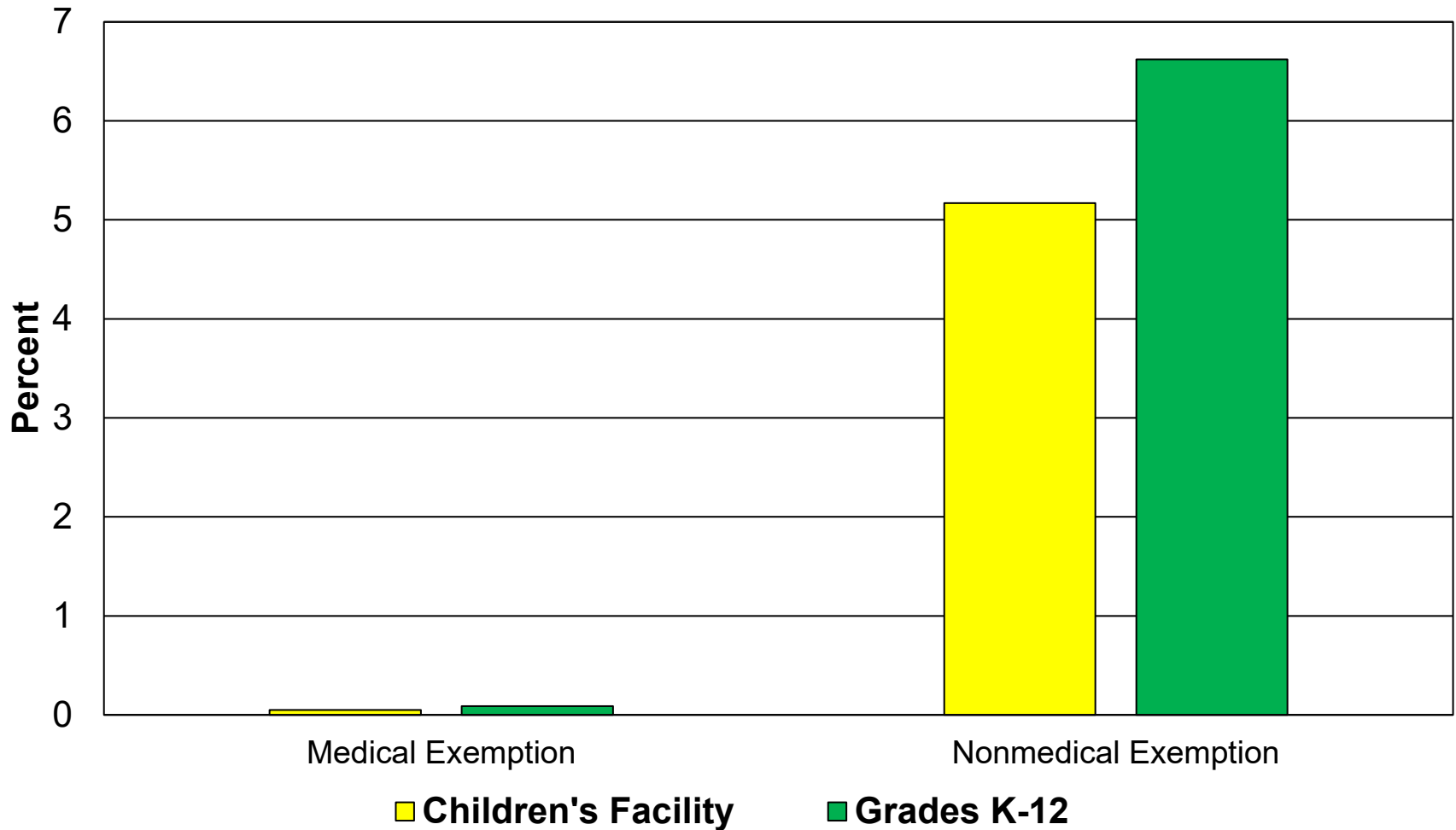
Oregon kindergarten rates, 2019-2023: Vaccines given to infants/toddlers



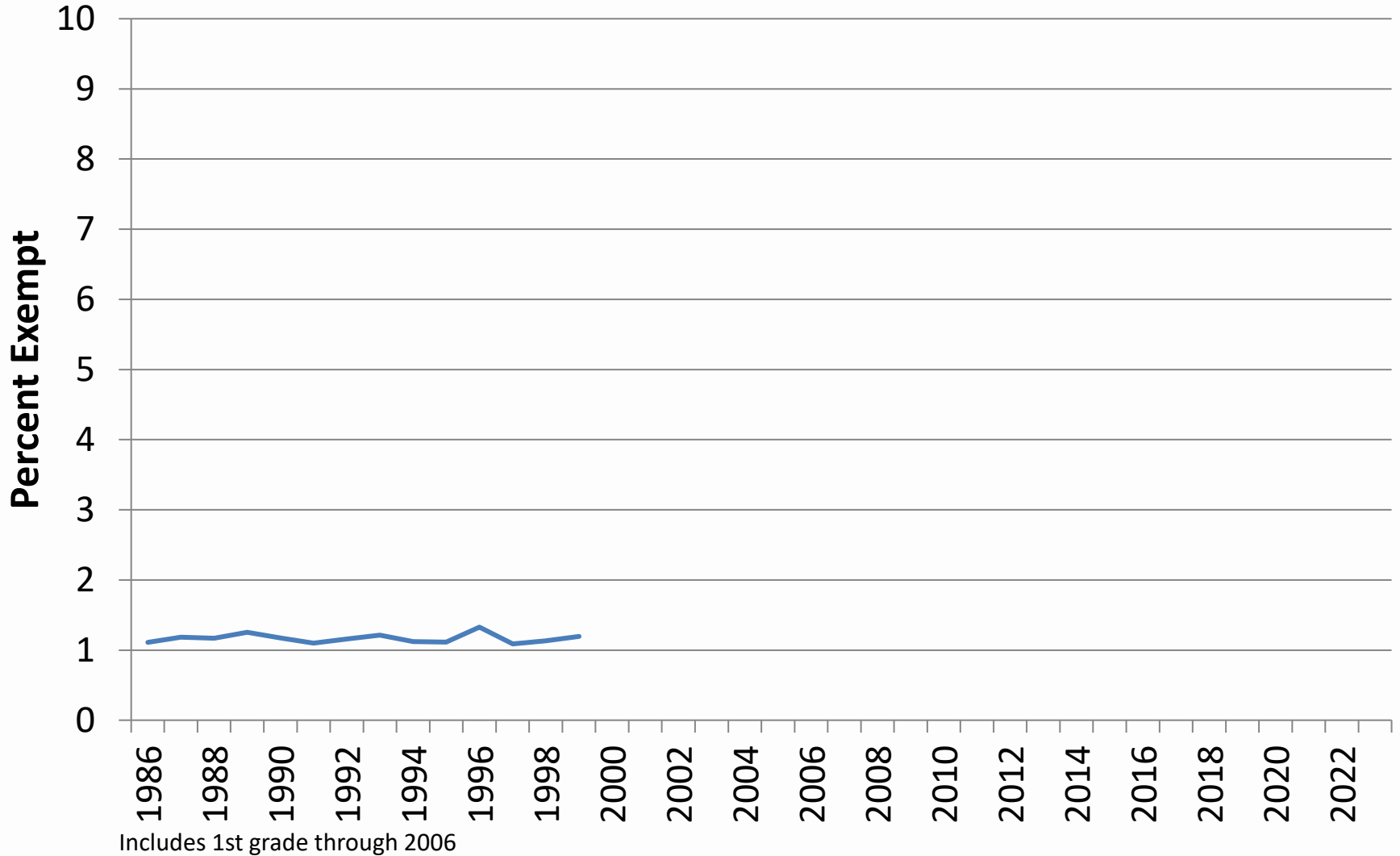

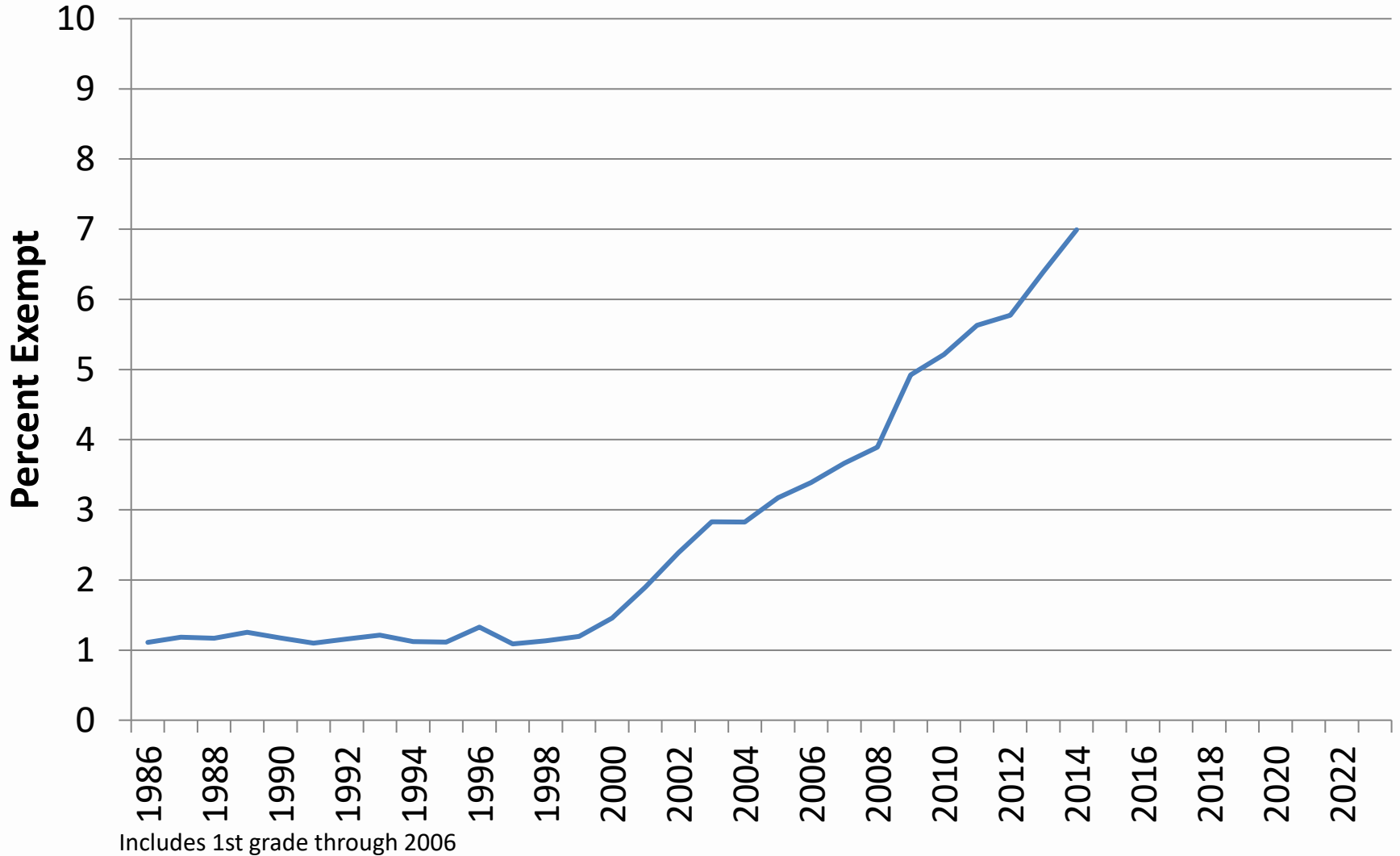
Percent of Children with Exemptions to School Required Vaccines, 2023

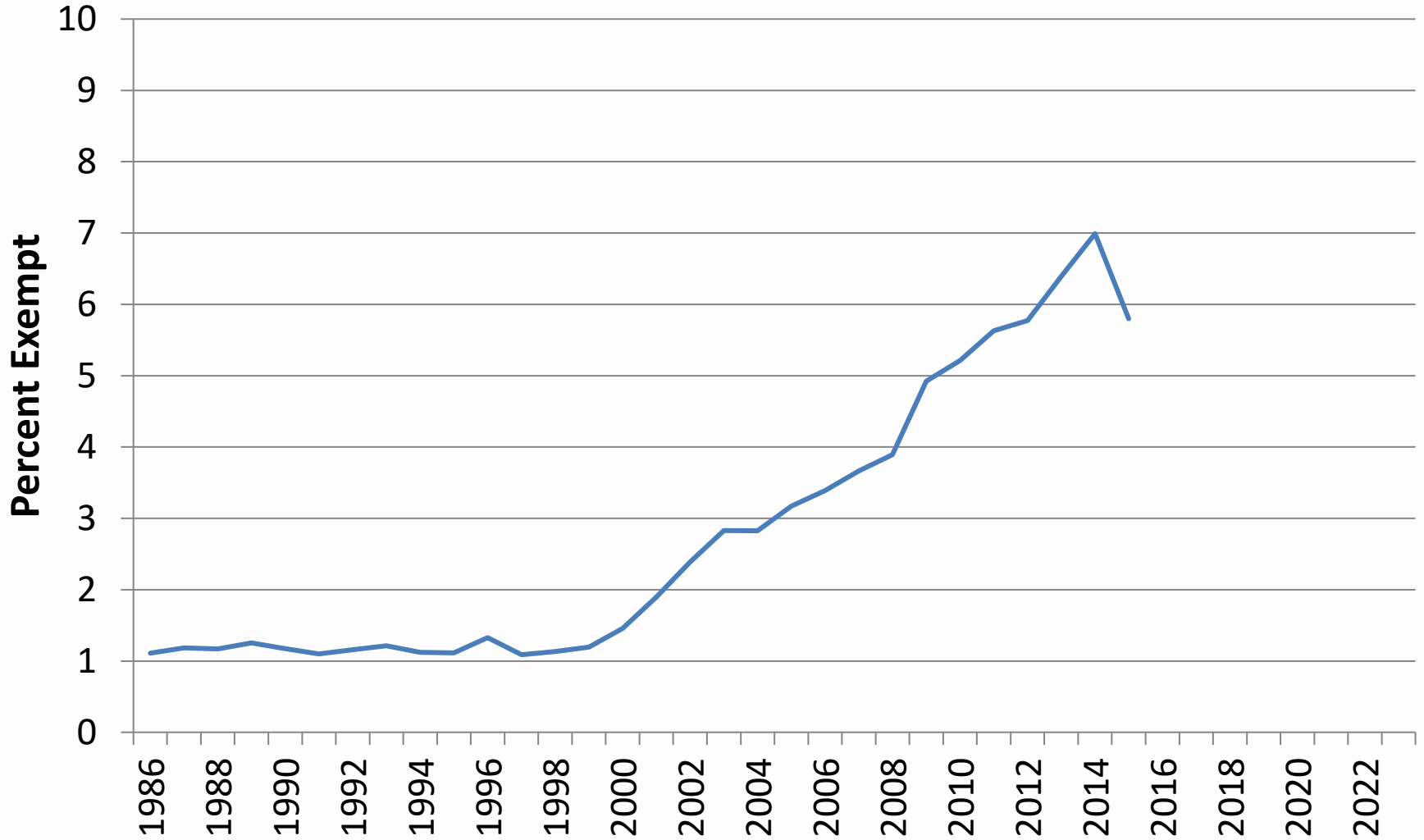

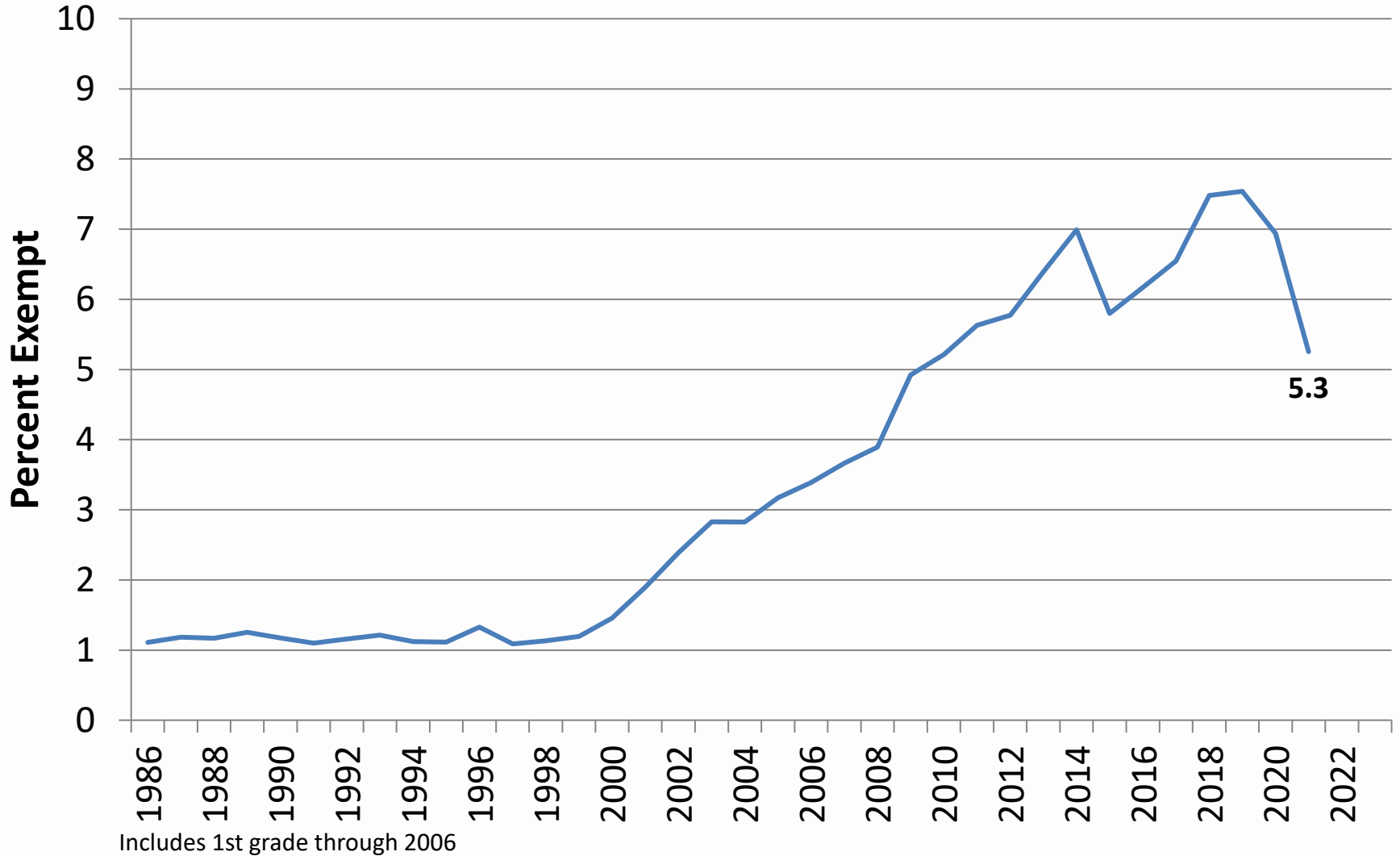

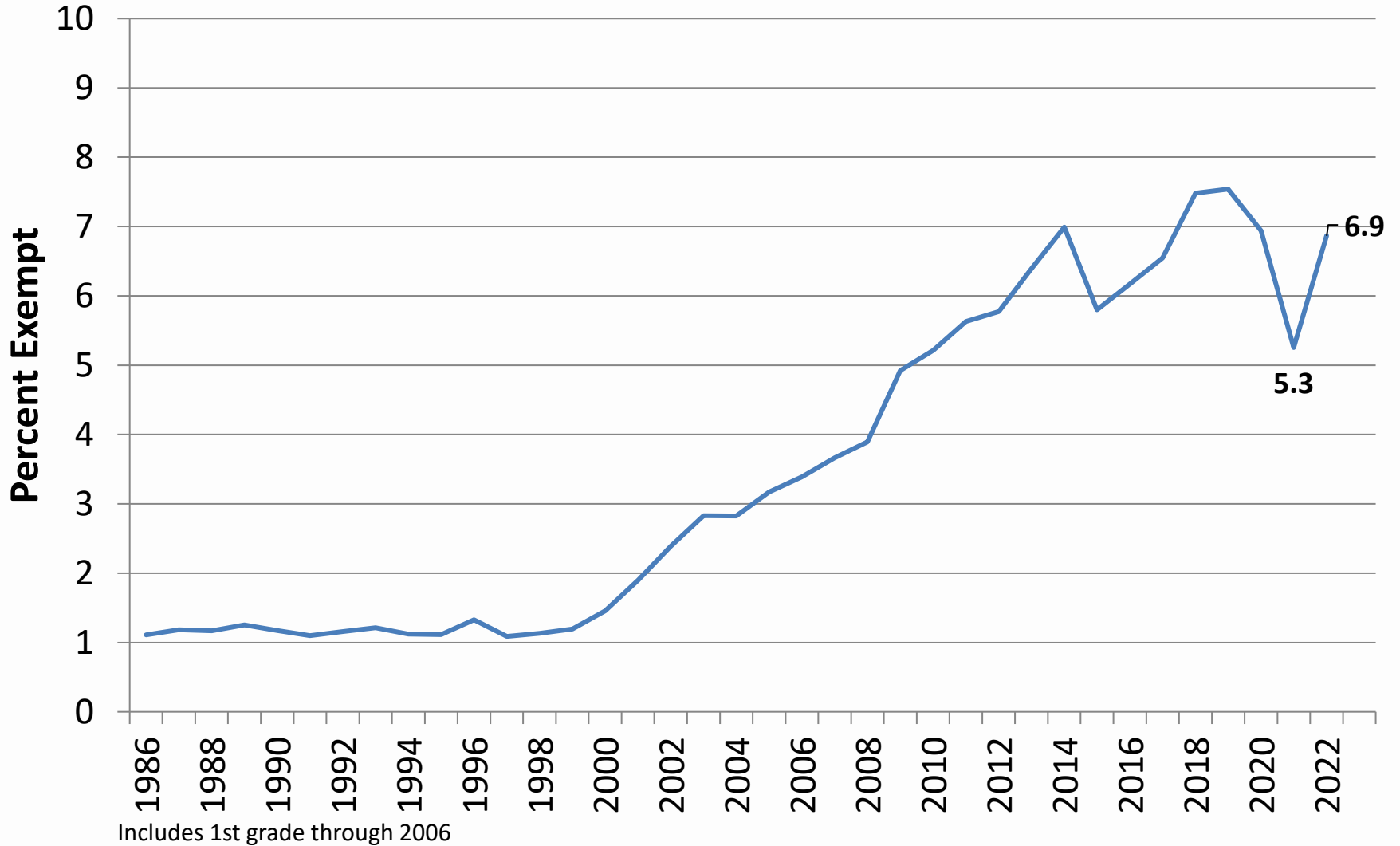

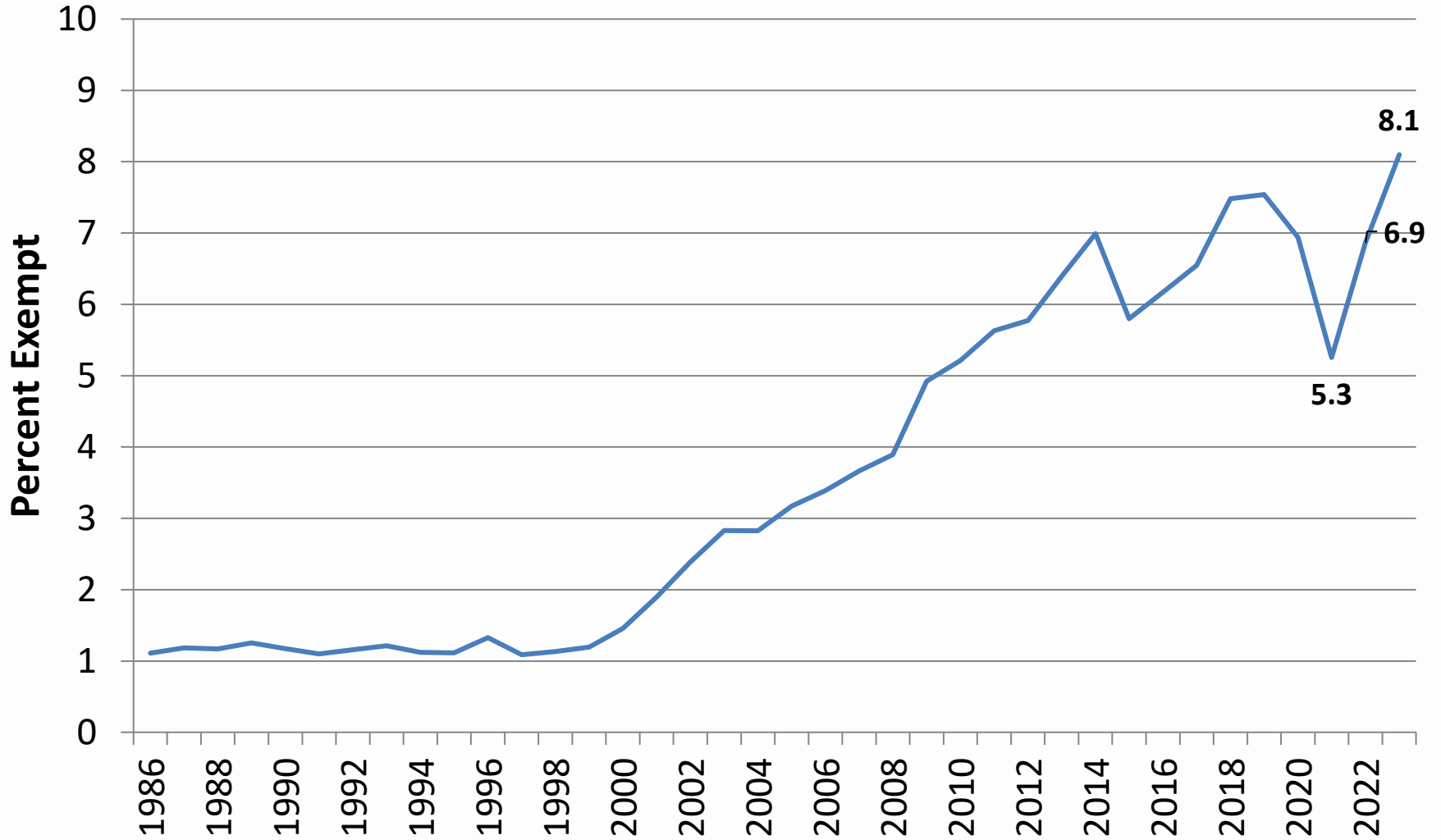

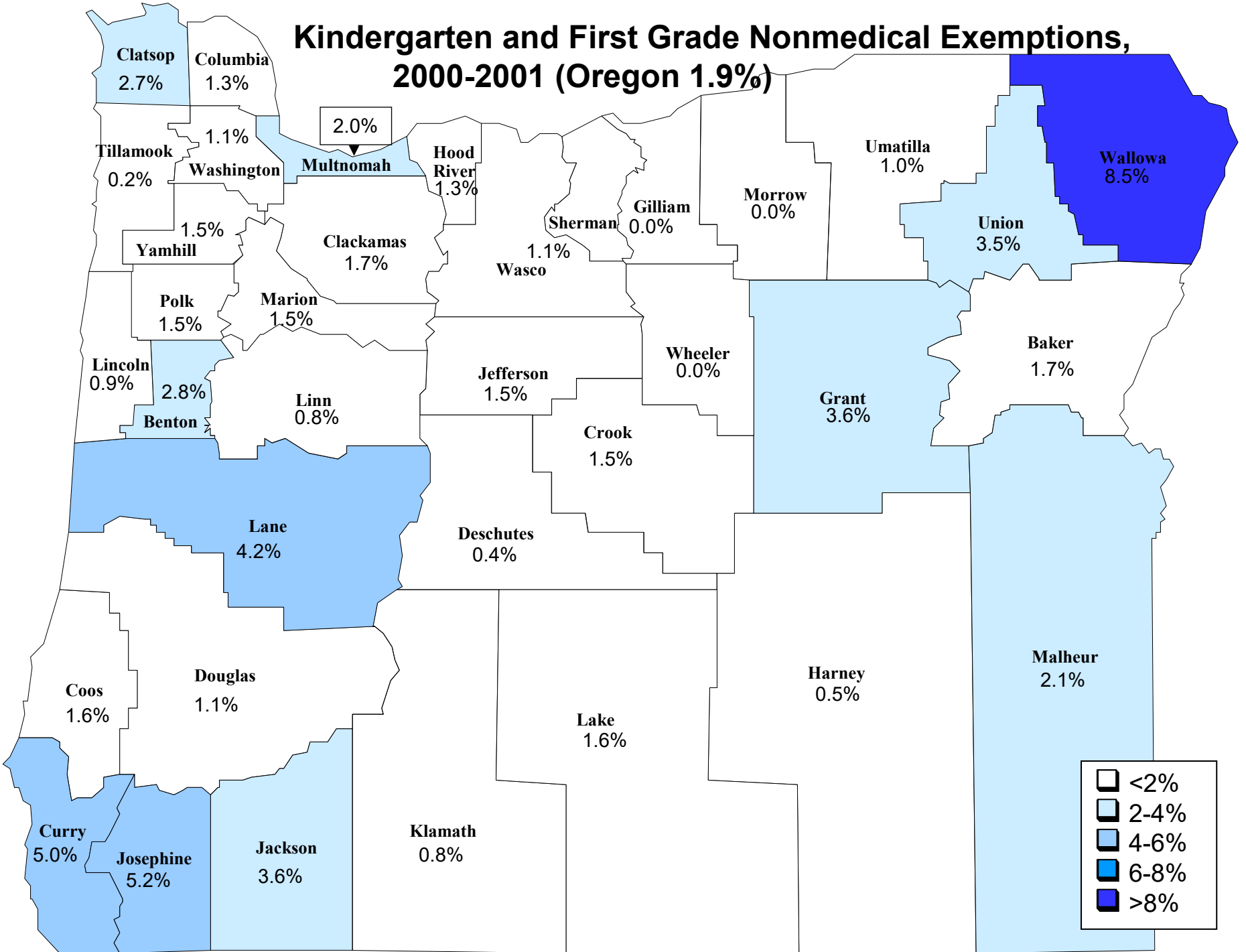

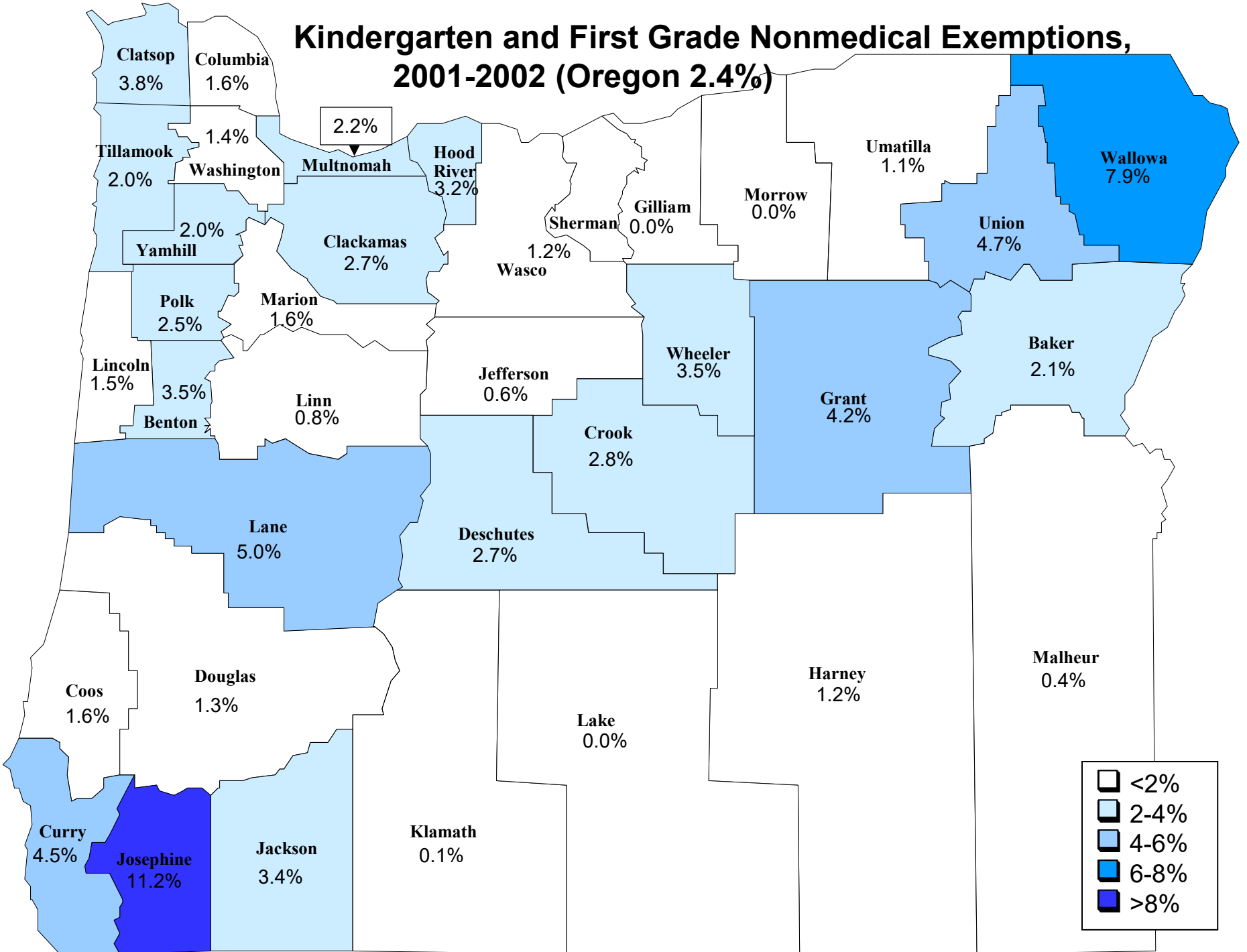

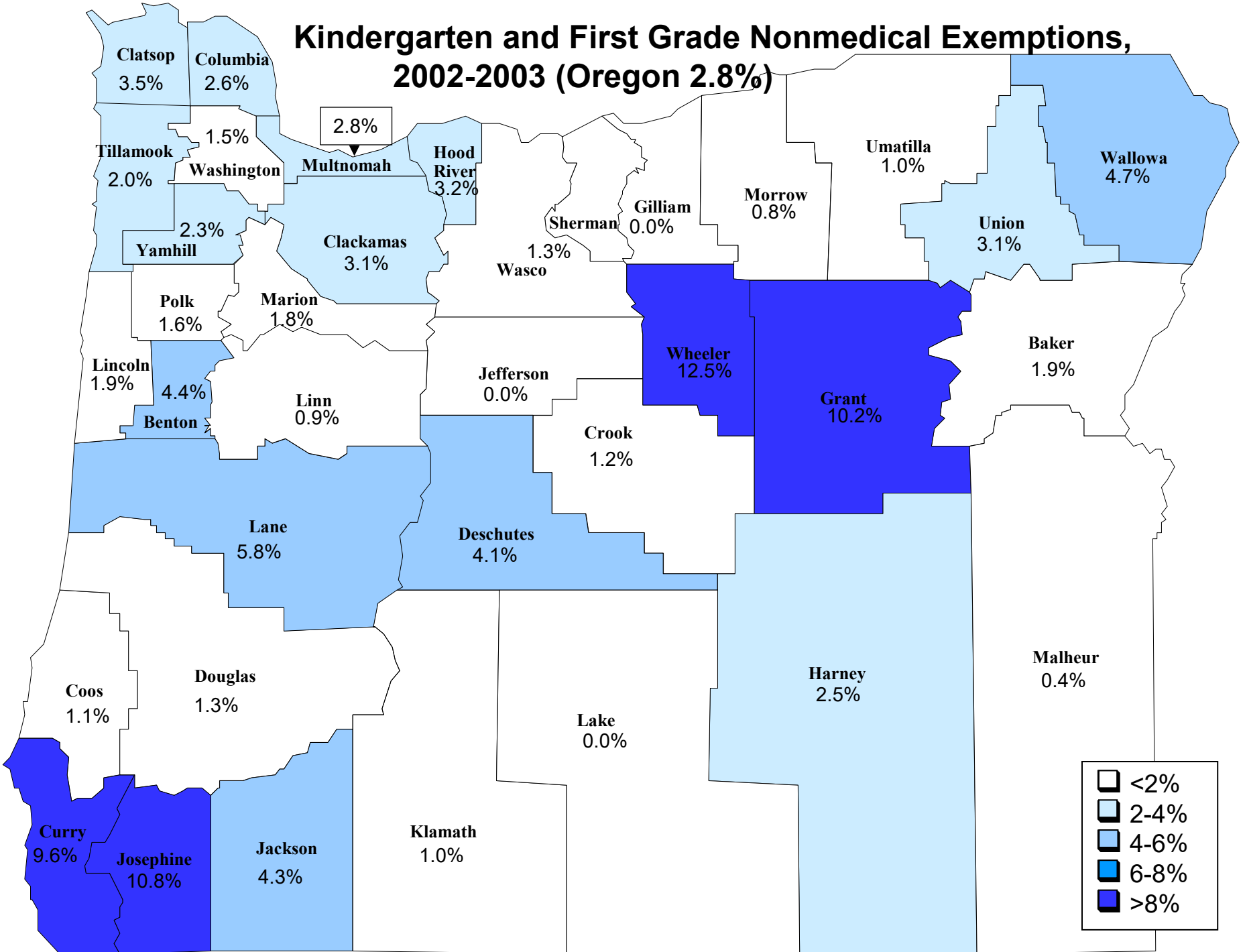
Kindergarten and First Grade Nonmedical Exemptions, 2000-2001 (Oregon 1.9%)



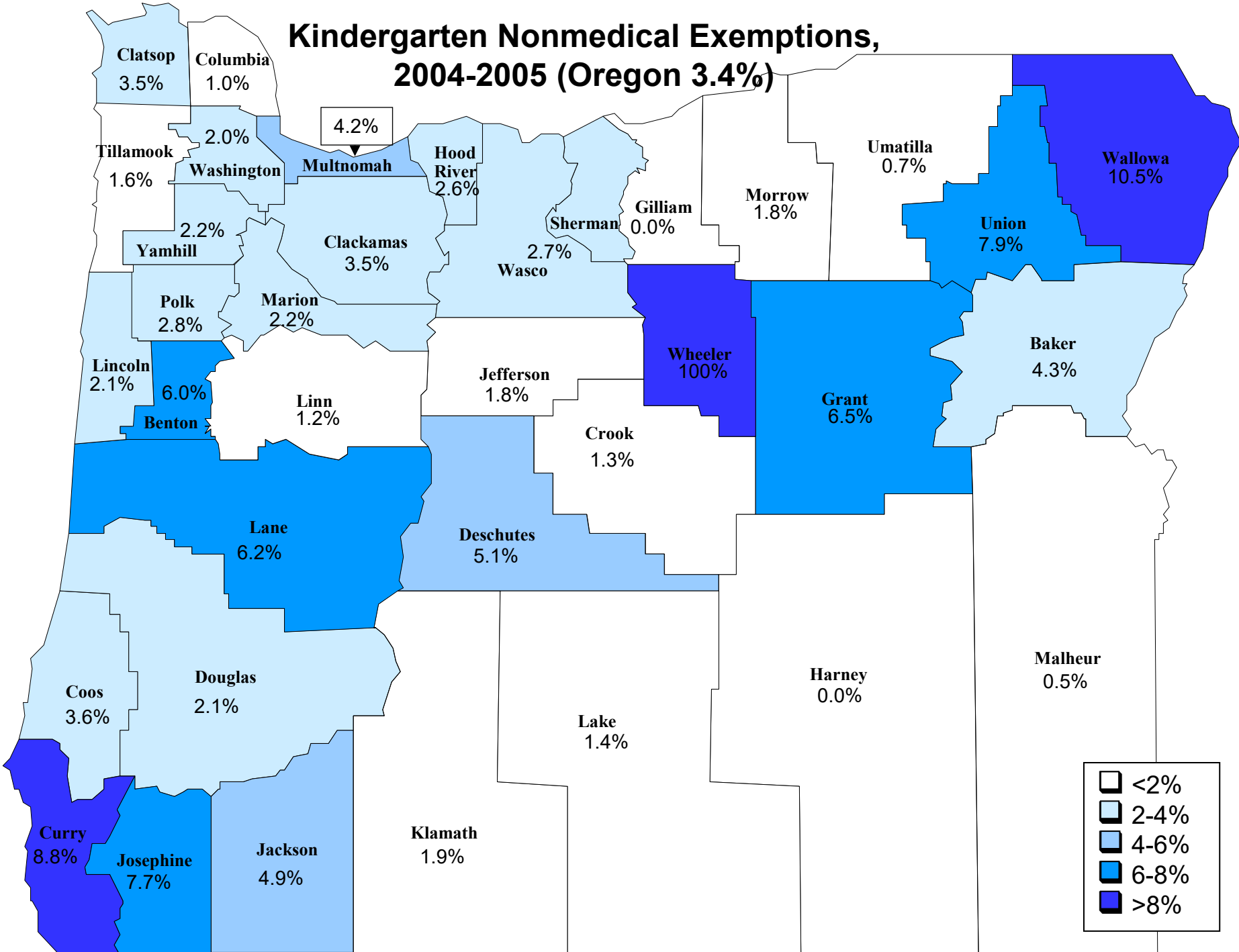
Kindergarten and First Grade Nonmedical Exemptions, 2001-2002 (Oregon 2.4%)



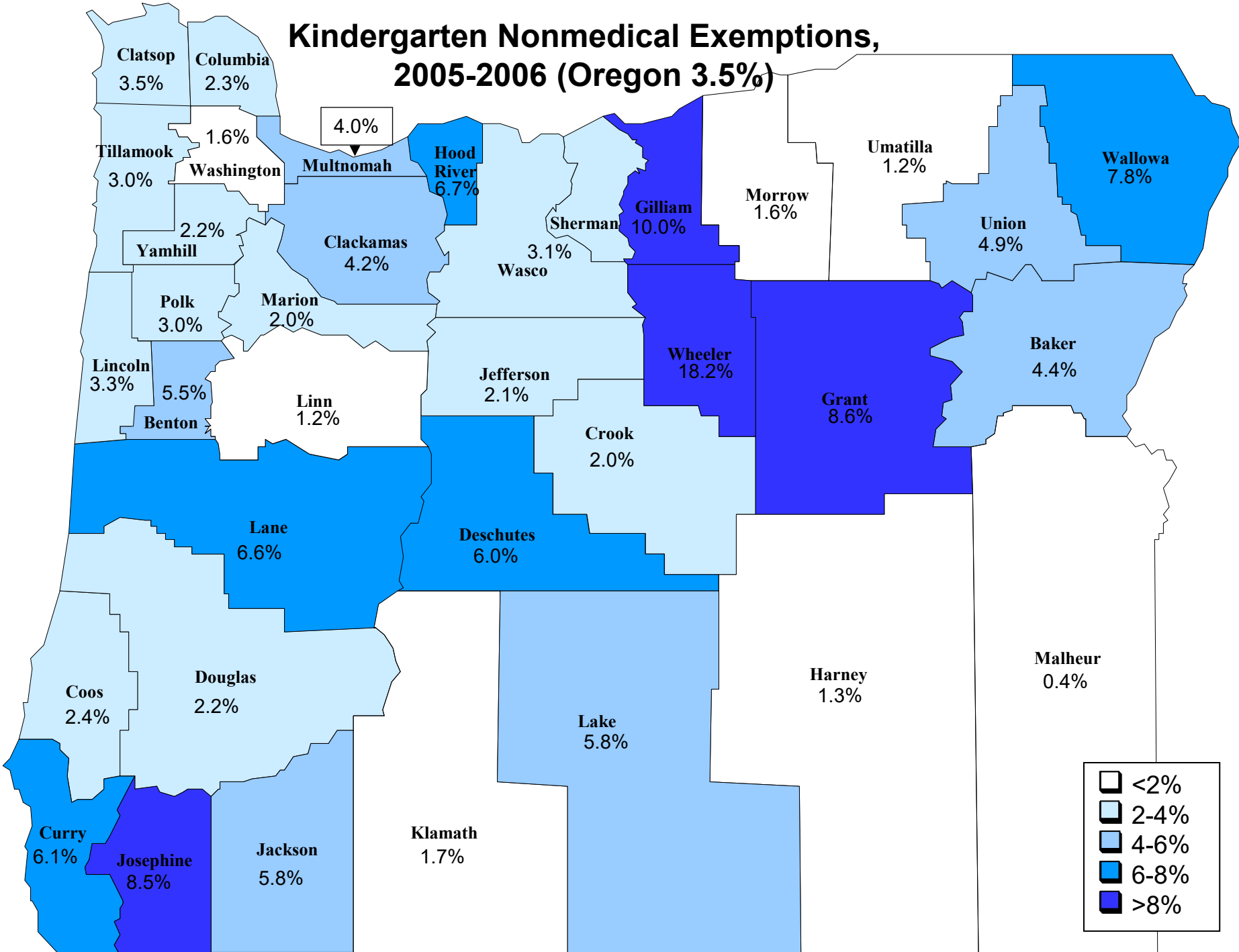

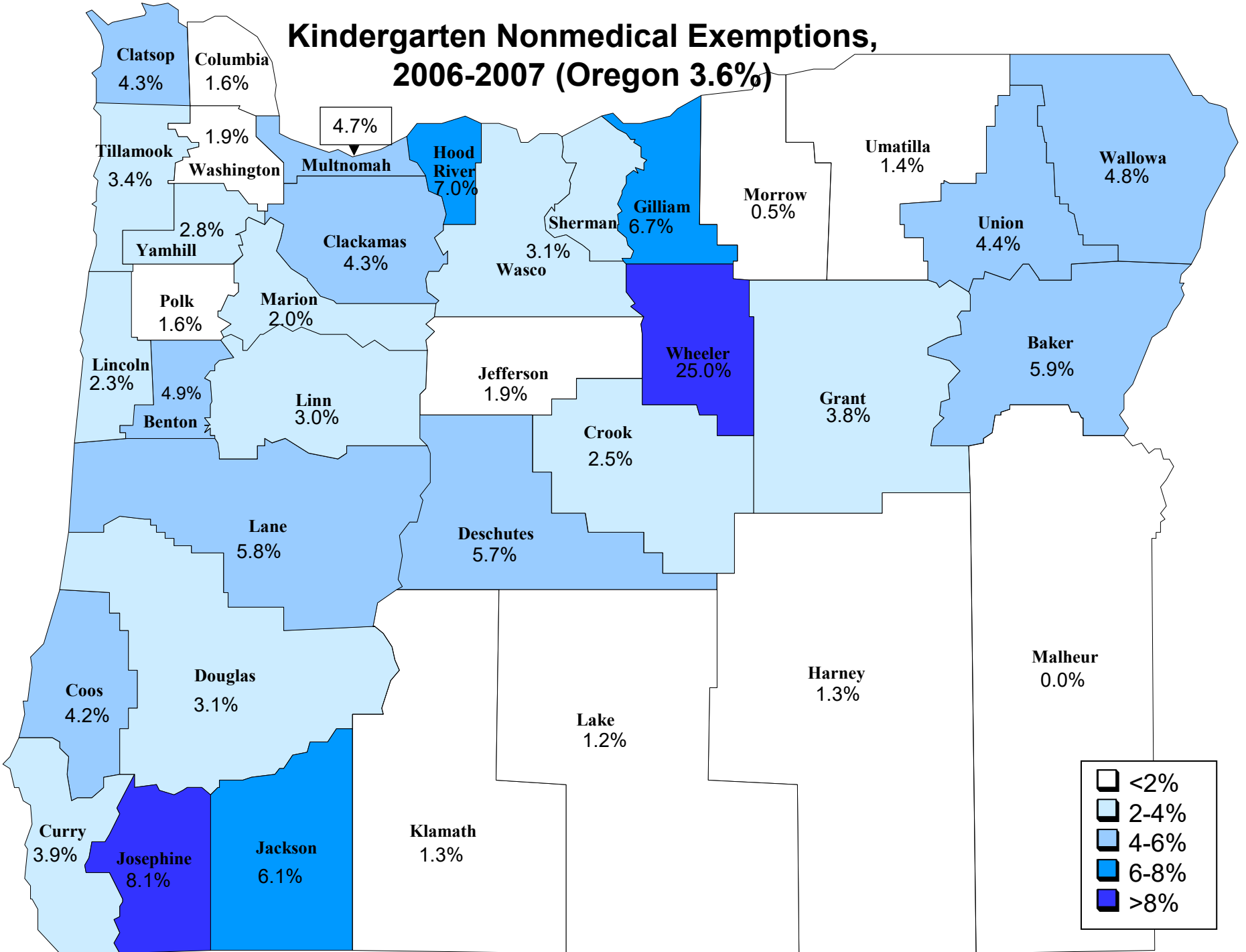

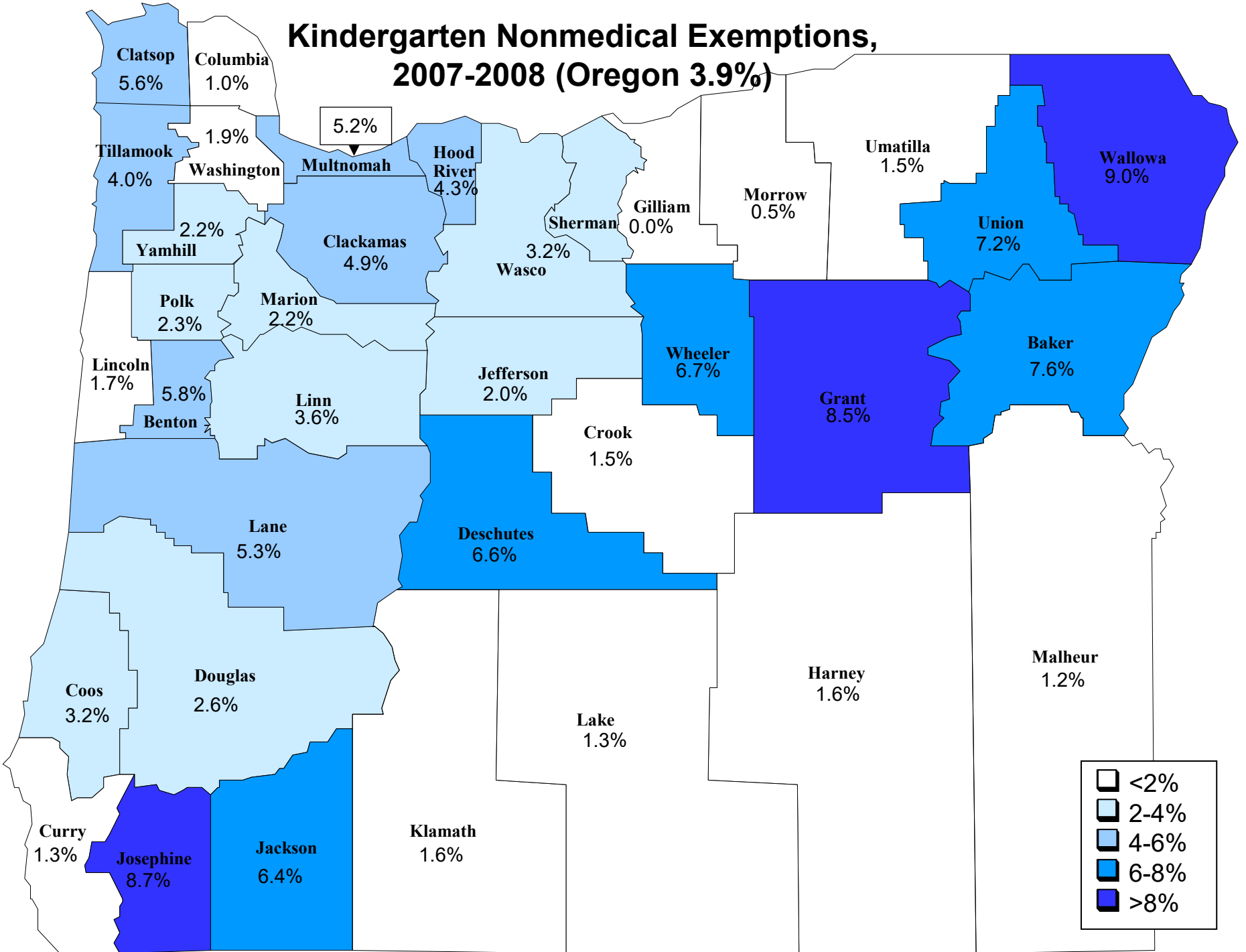

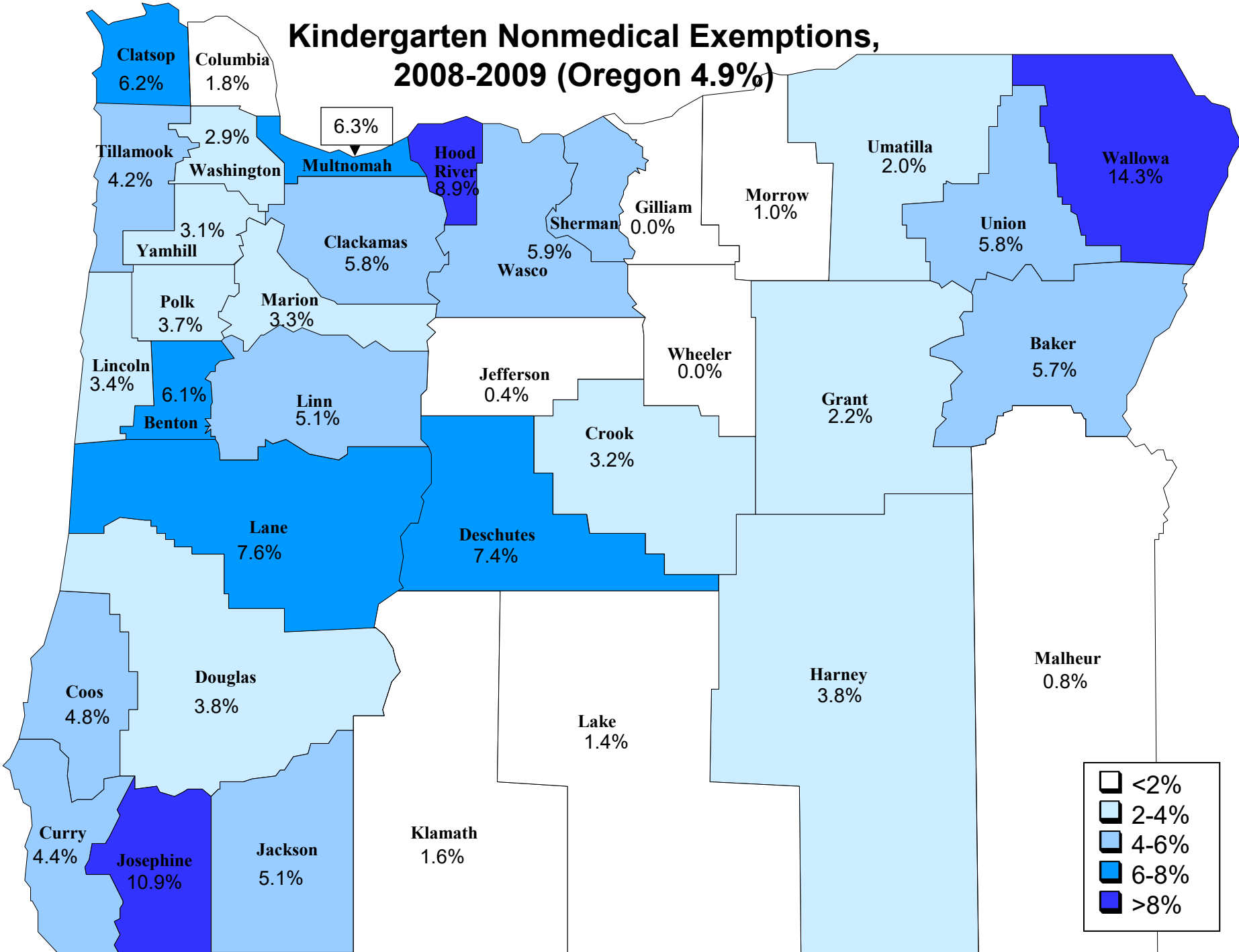

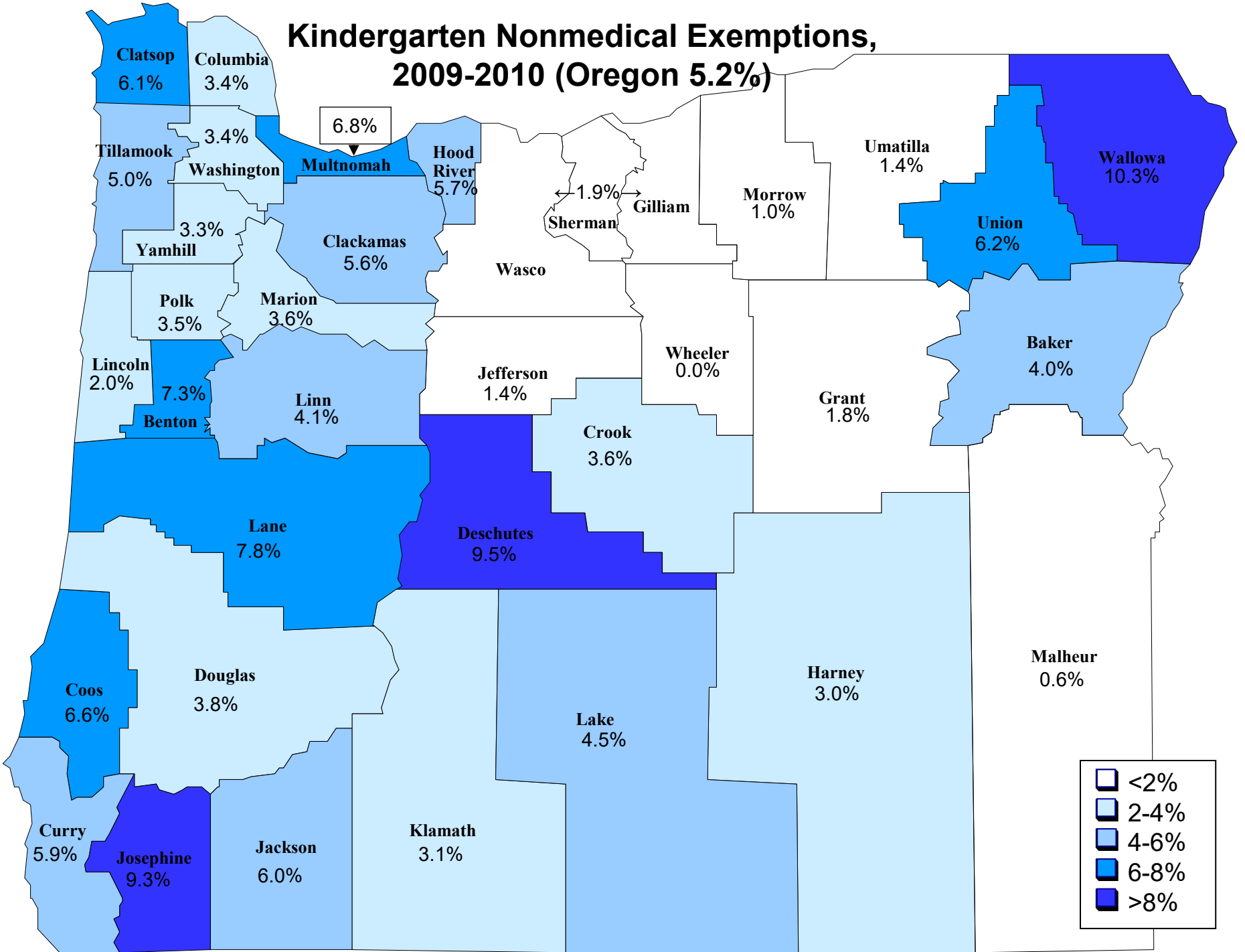

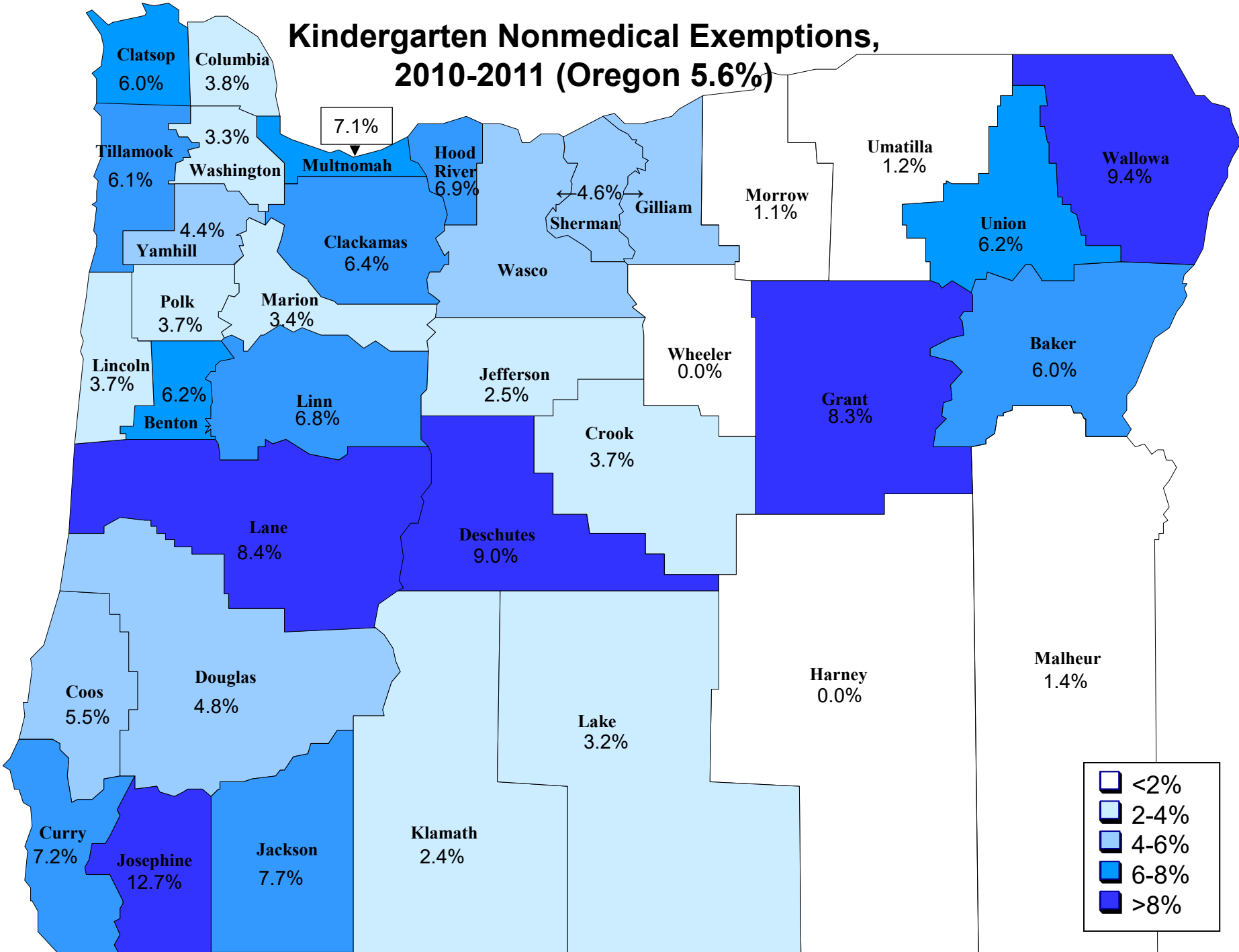

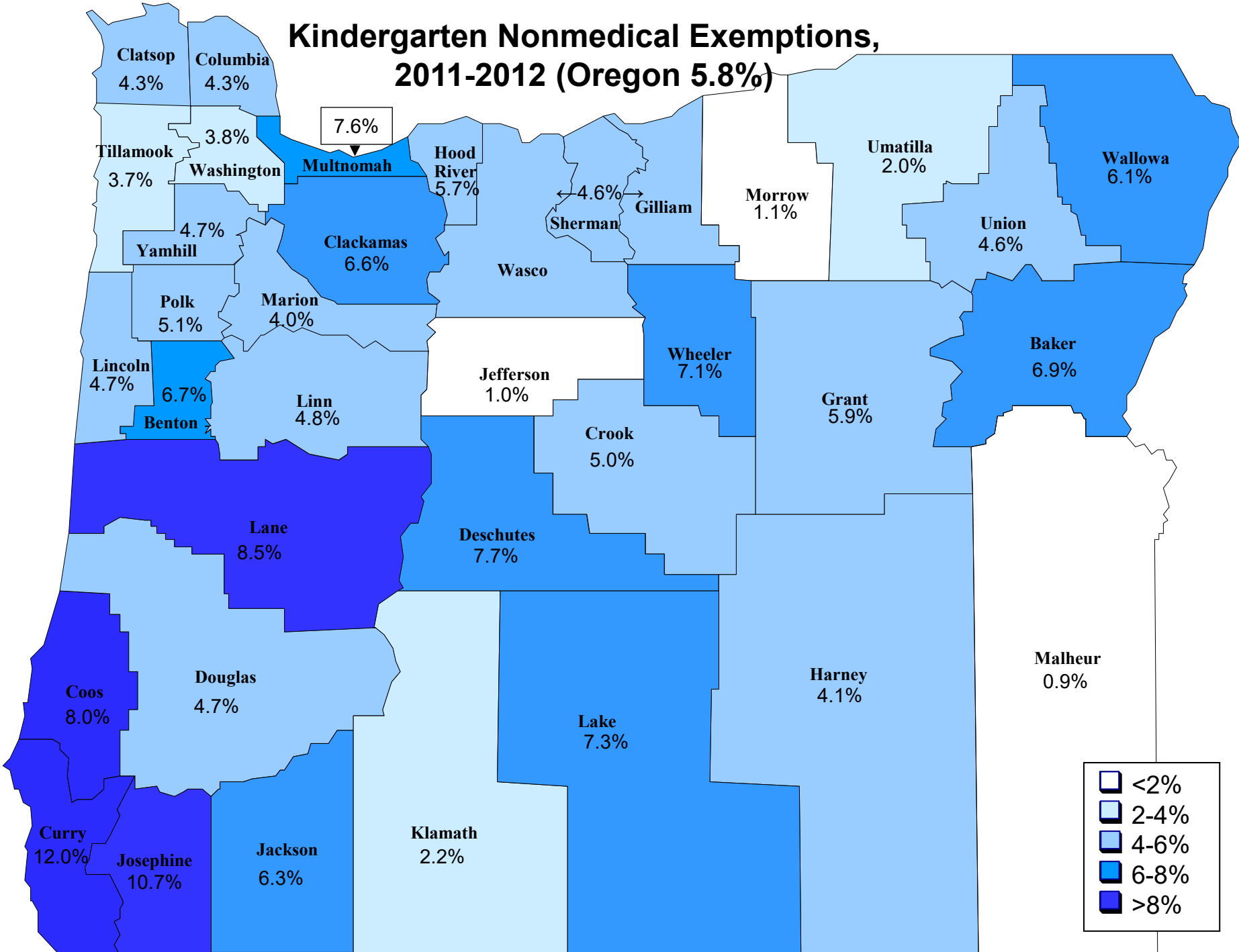

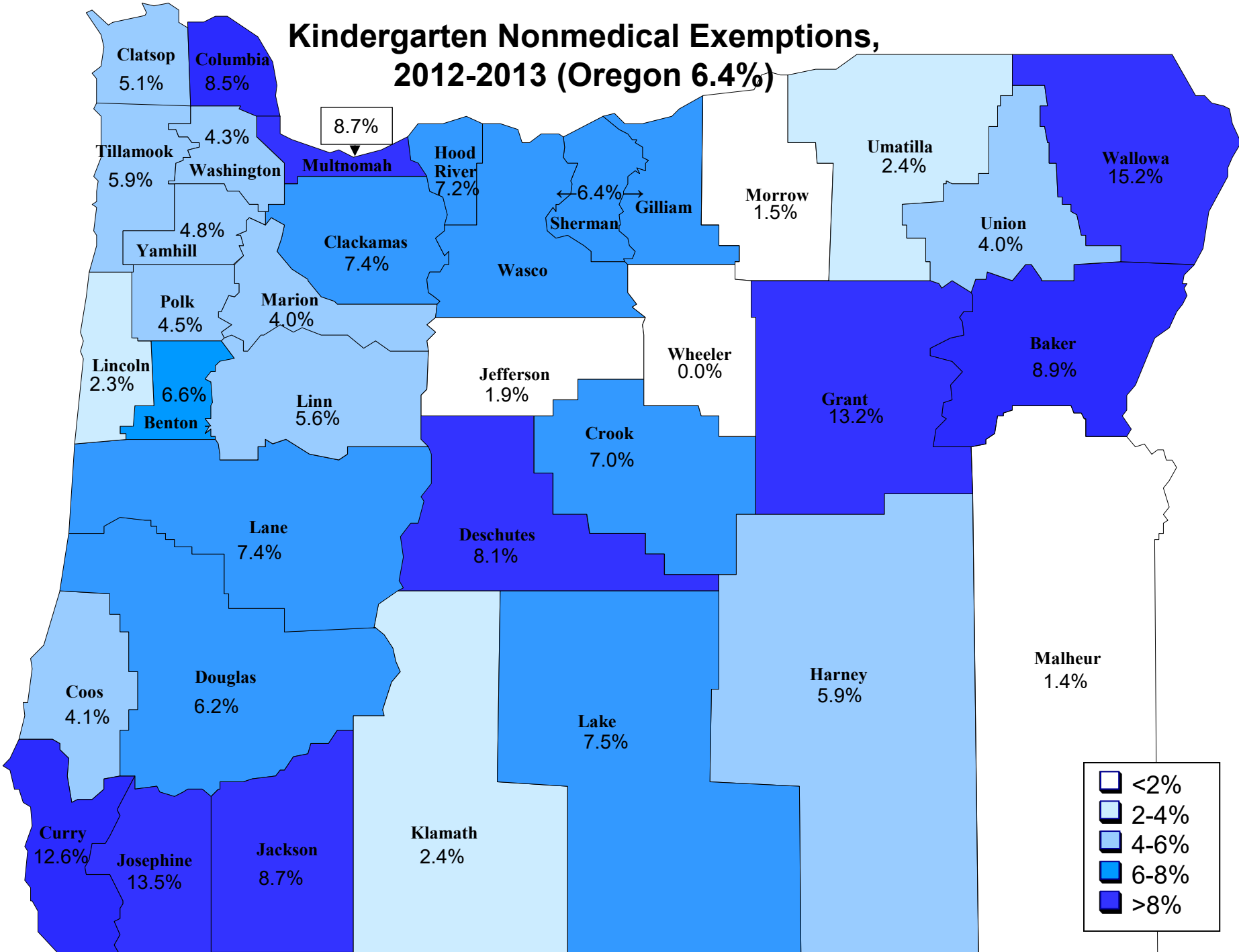

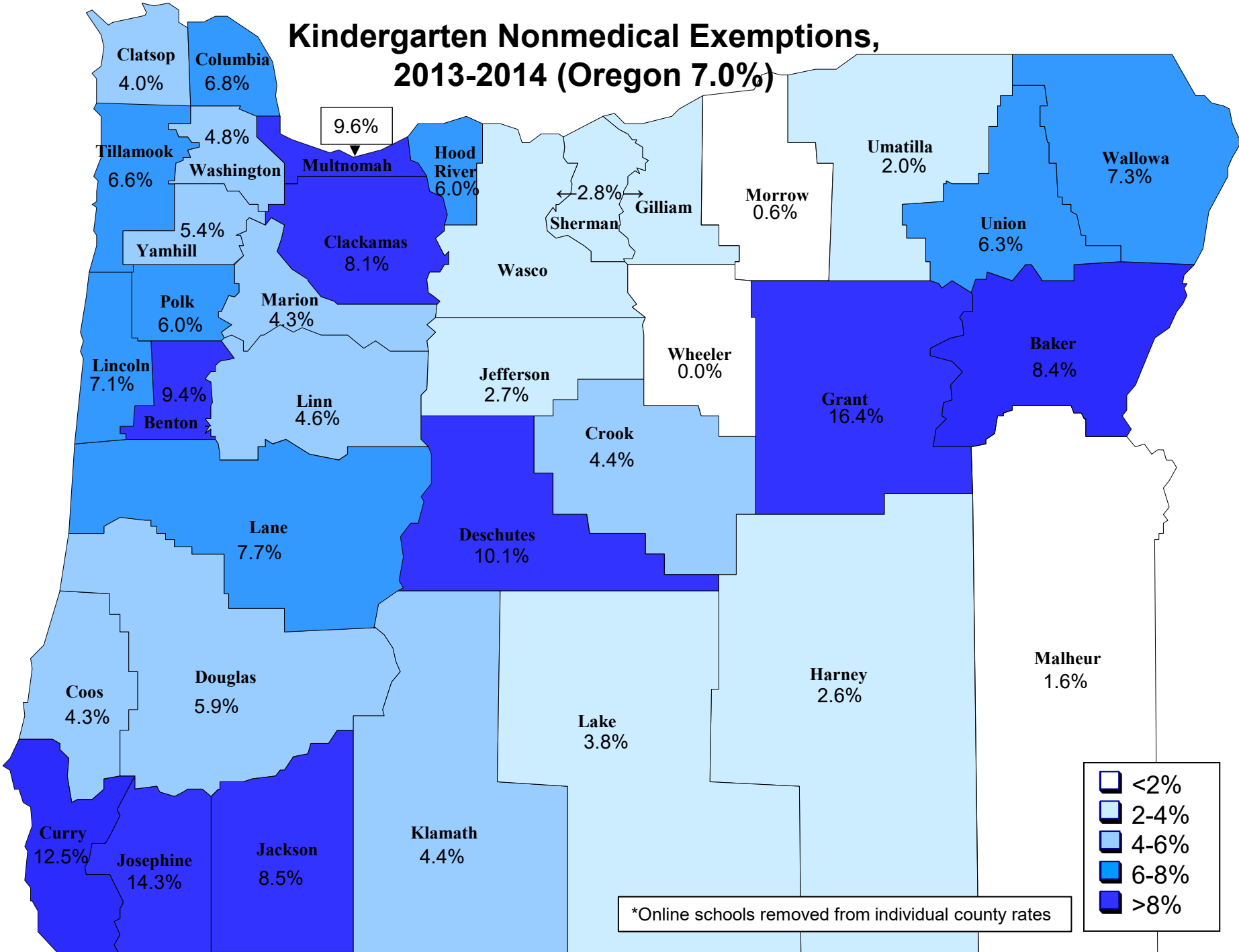

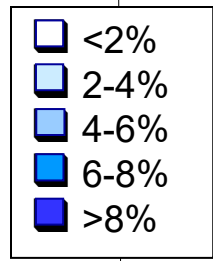

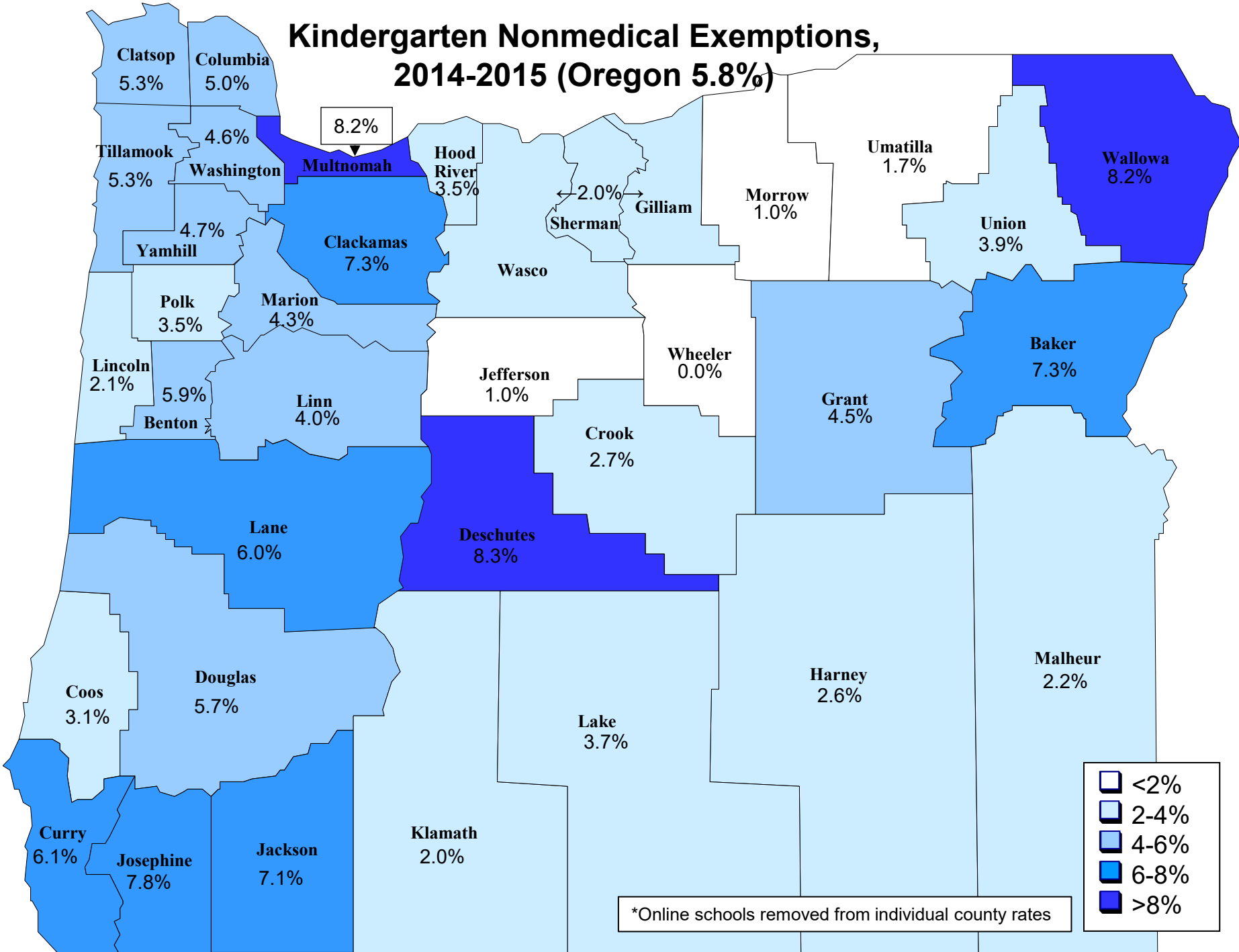

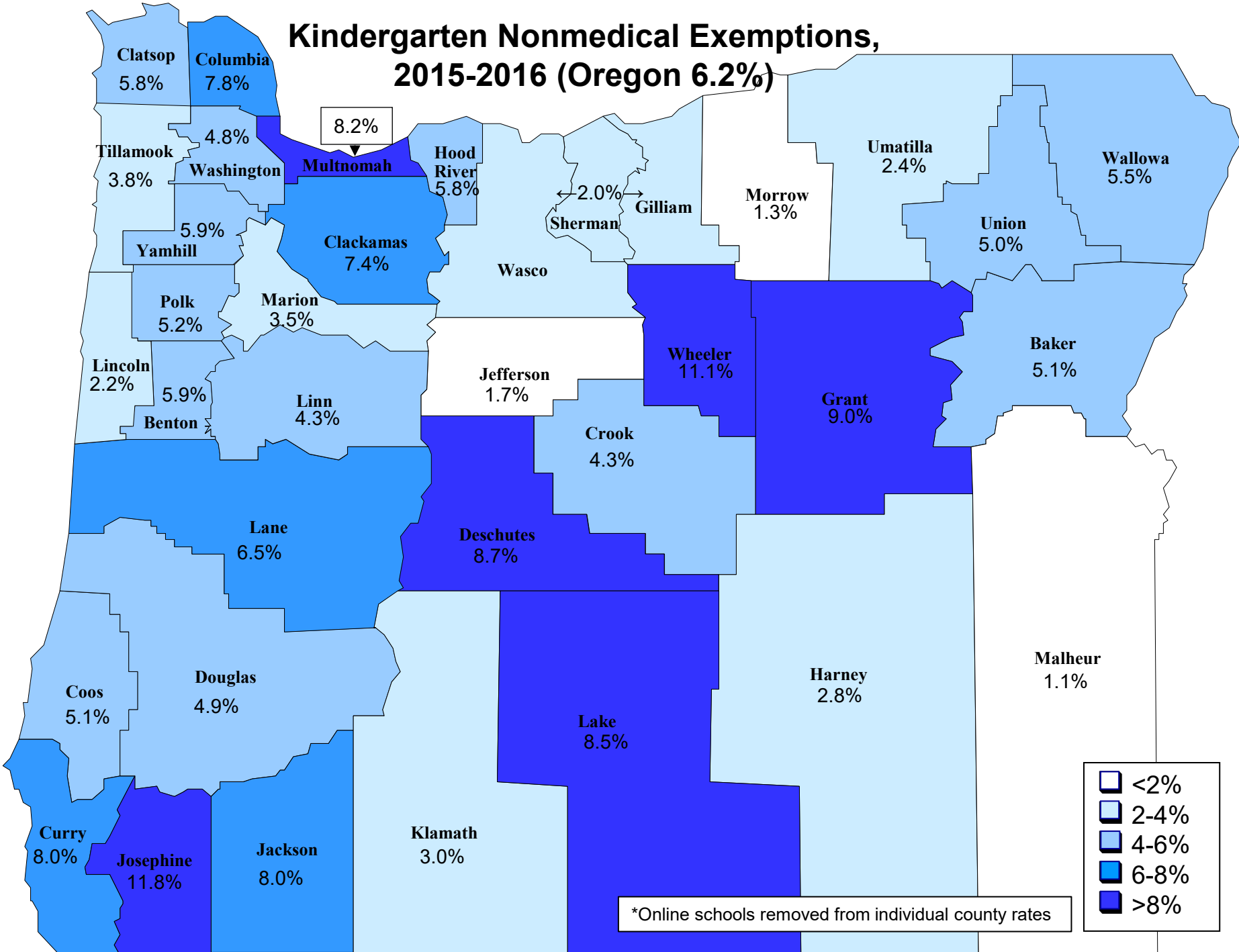

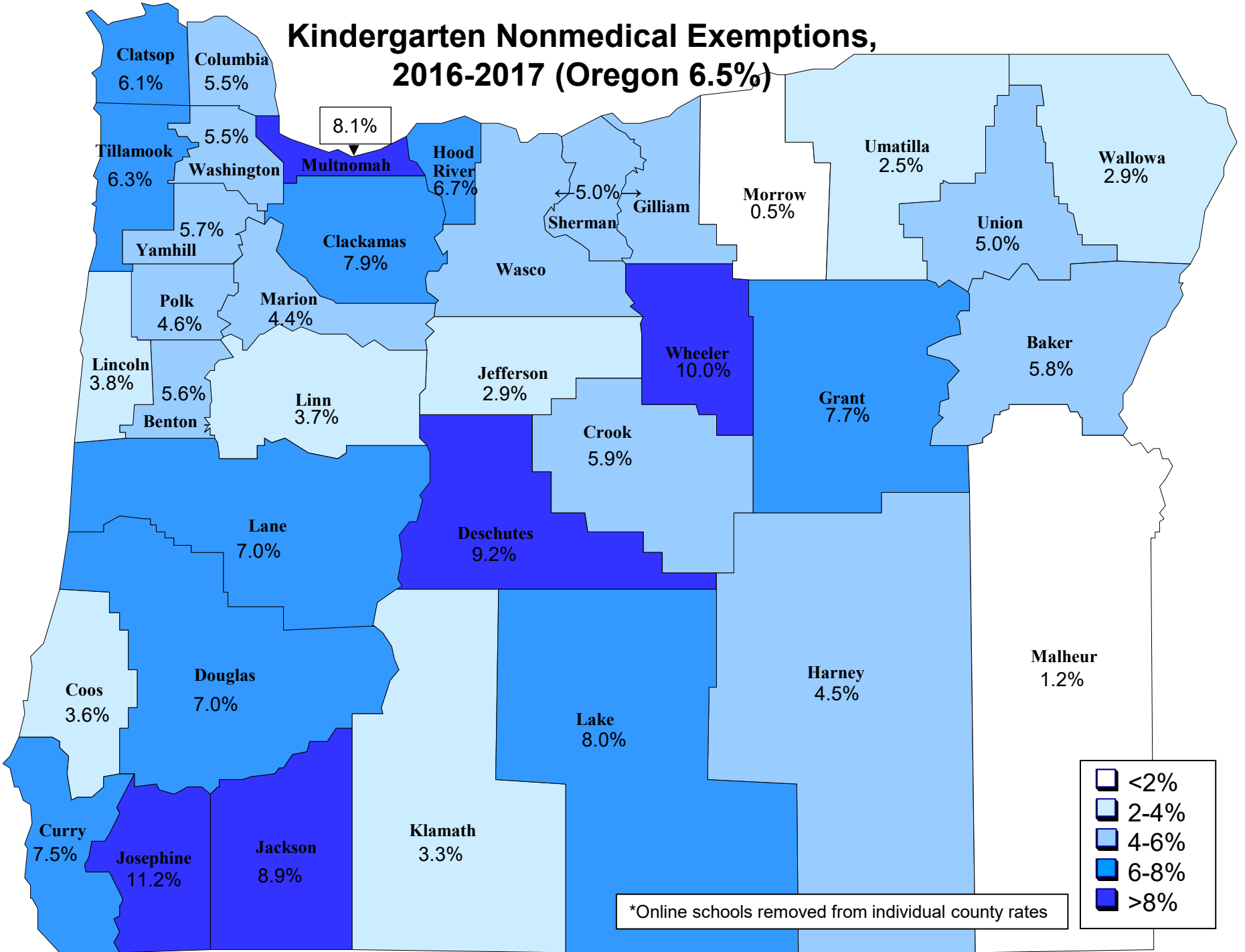

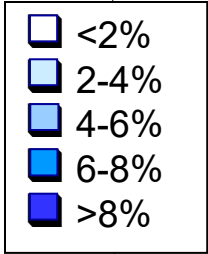

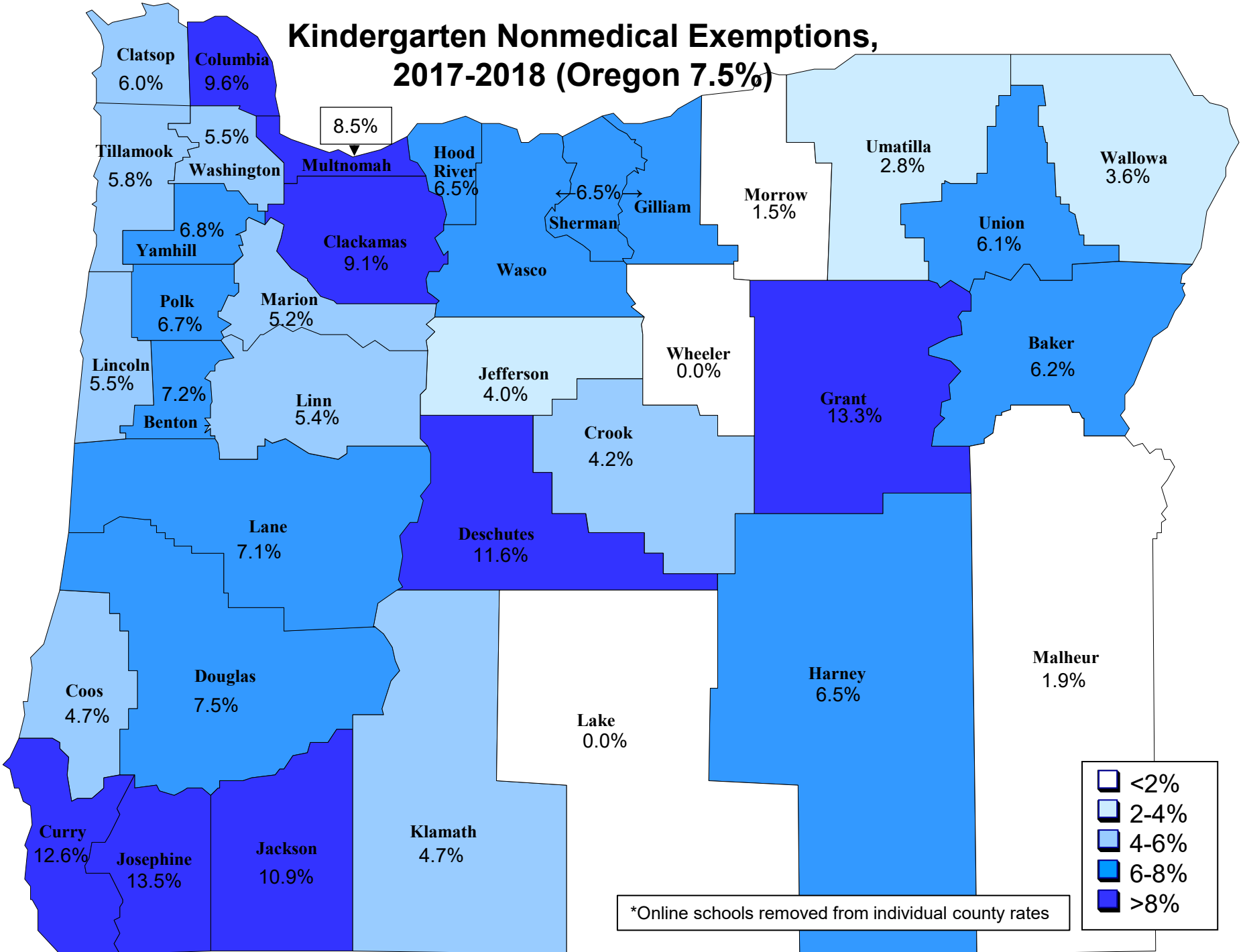
Kindergarten Nonmedical Exemptions, 2016-2017 (Oregon 6.5%)

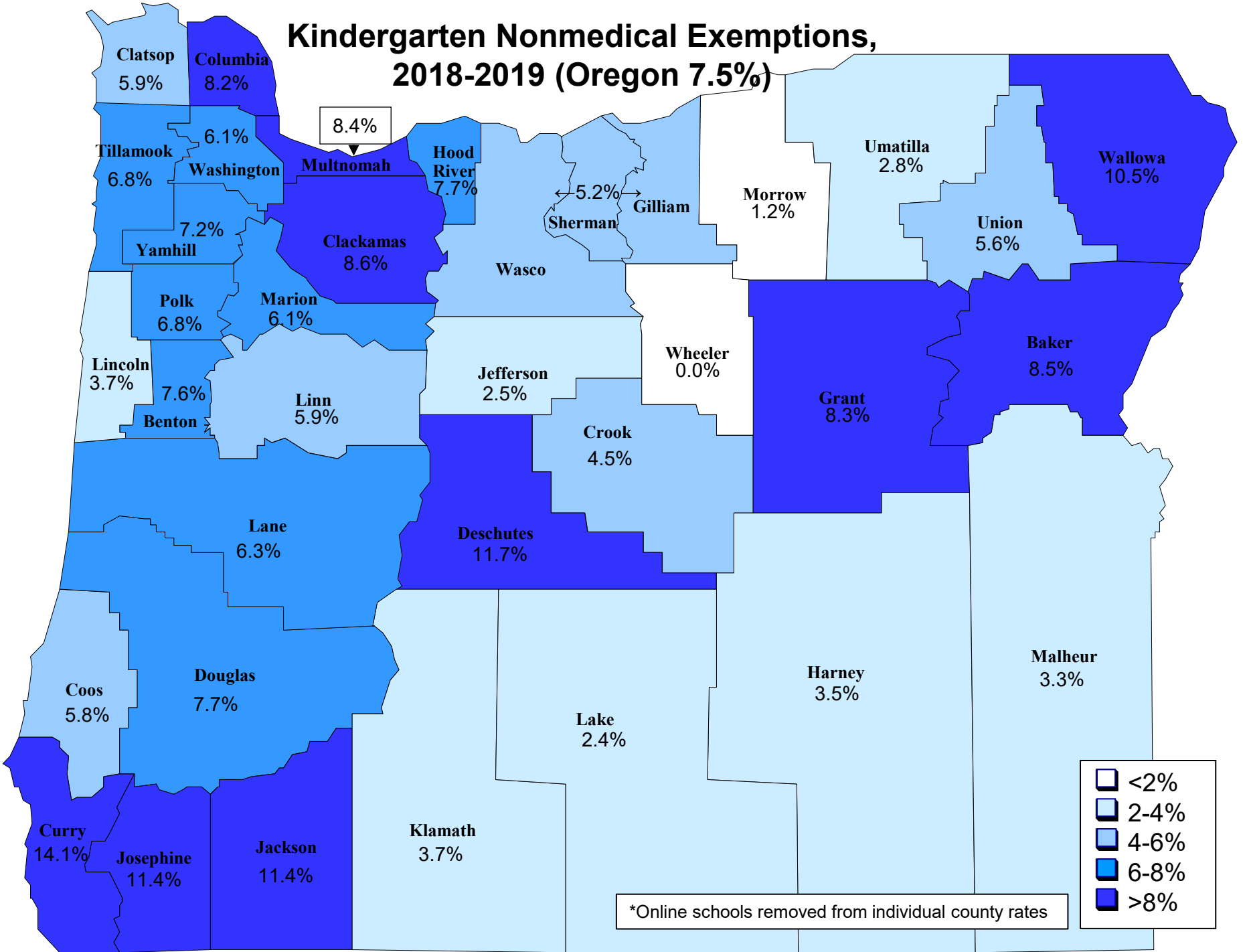


Kindergarten Nonmedical Exemptions, 2017-2018 (Oregon 7.5%)

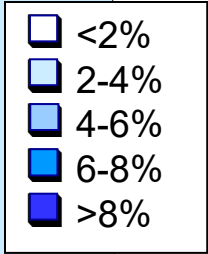

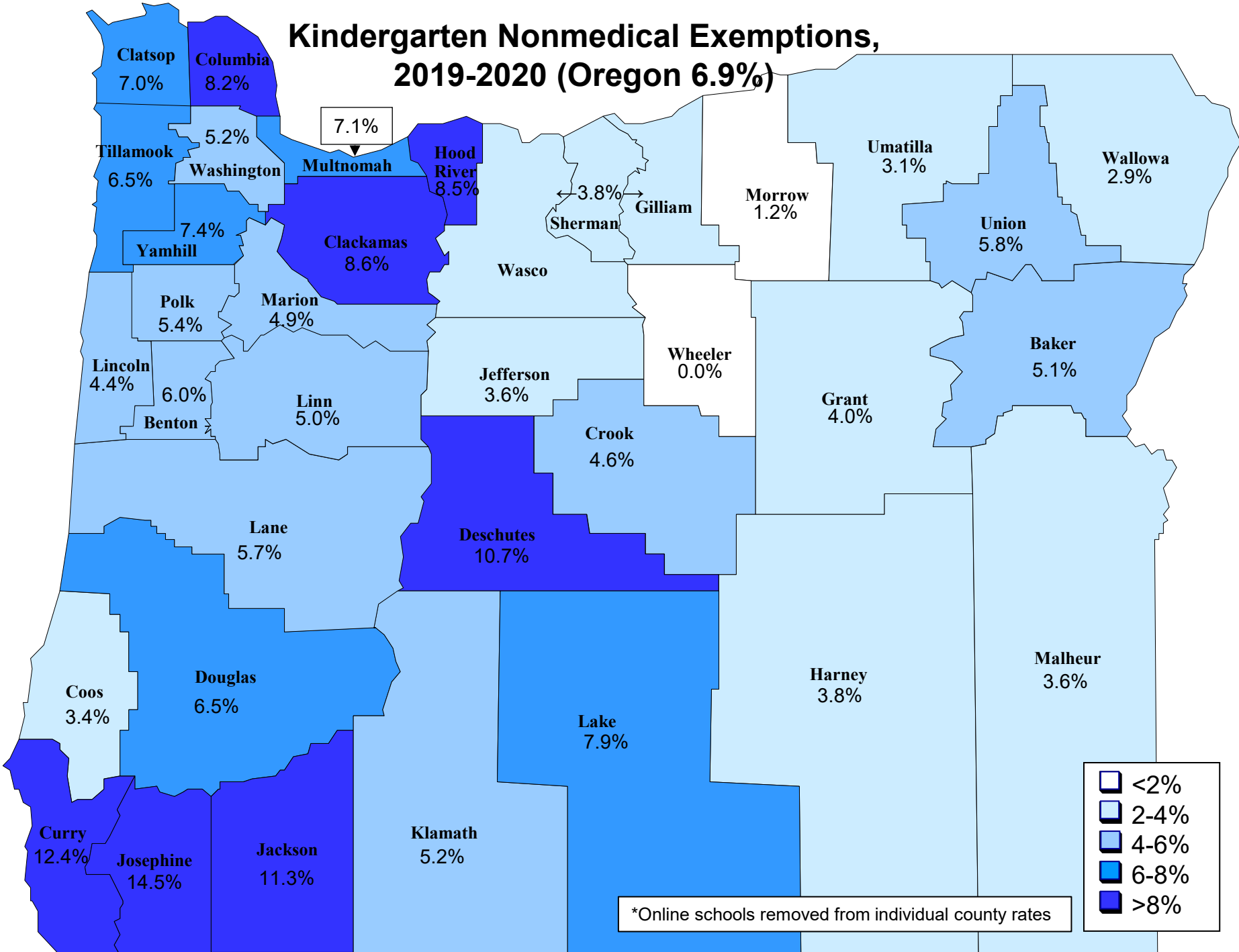

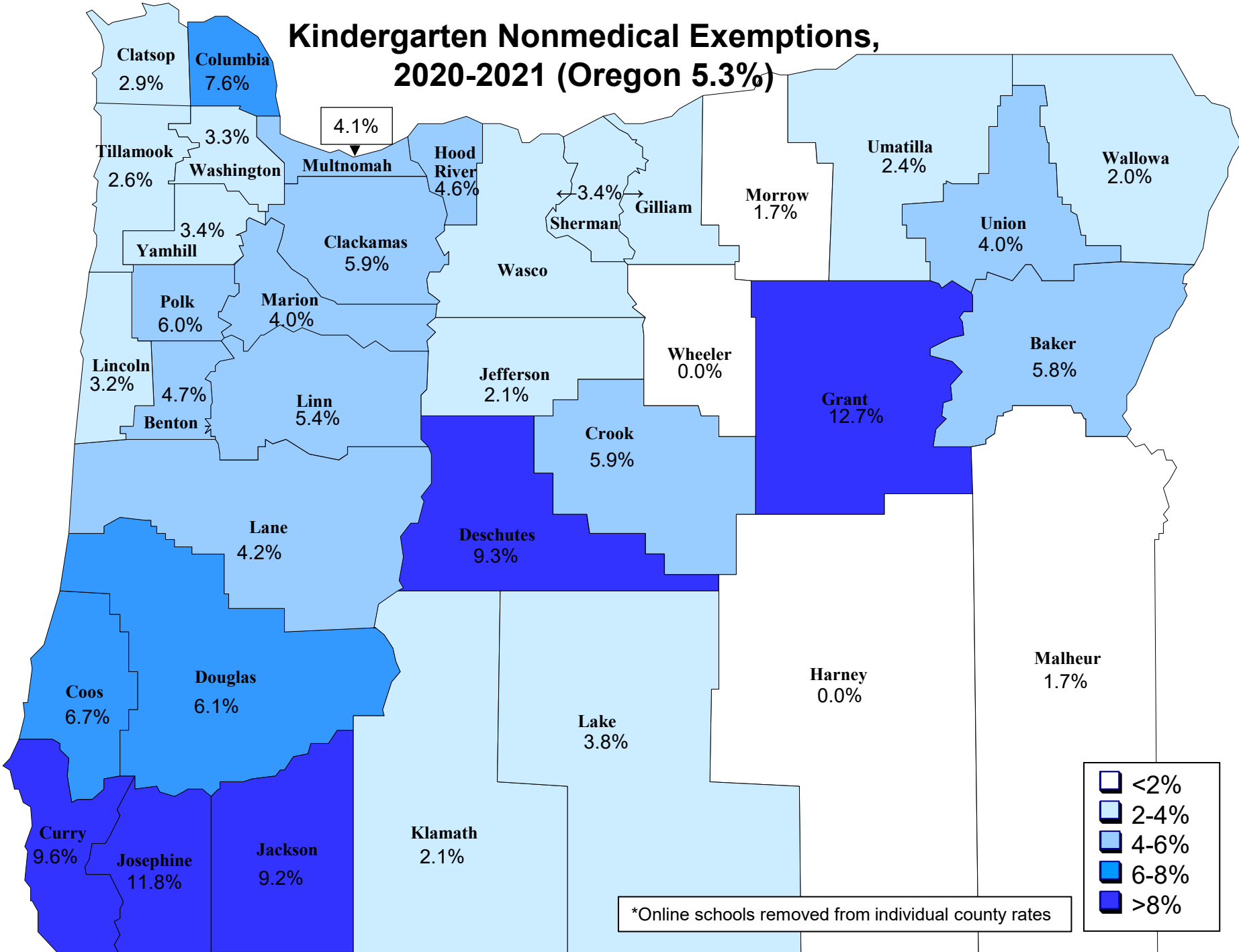

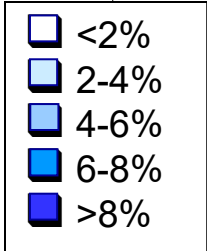

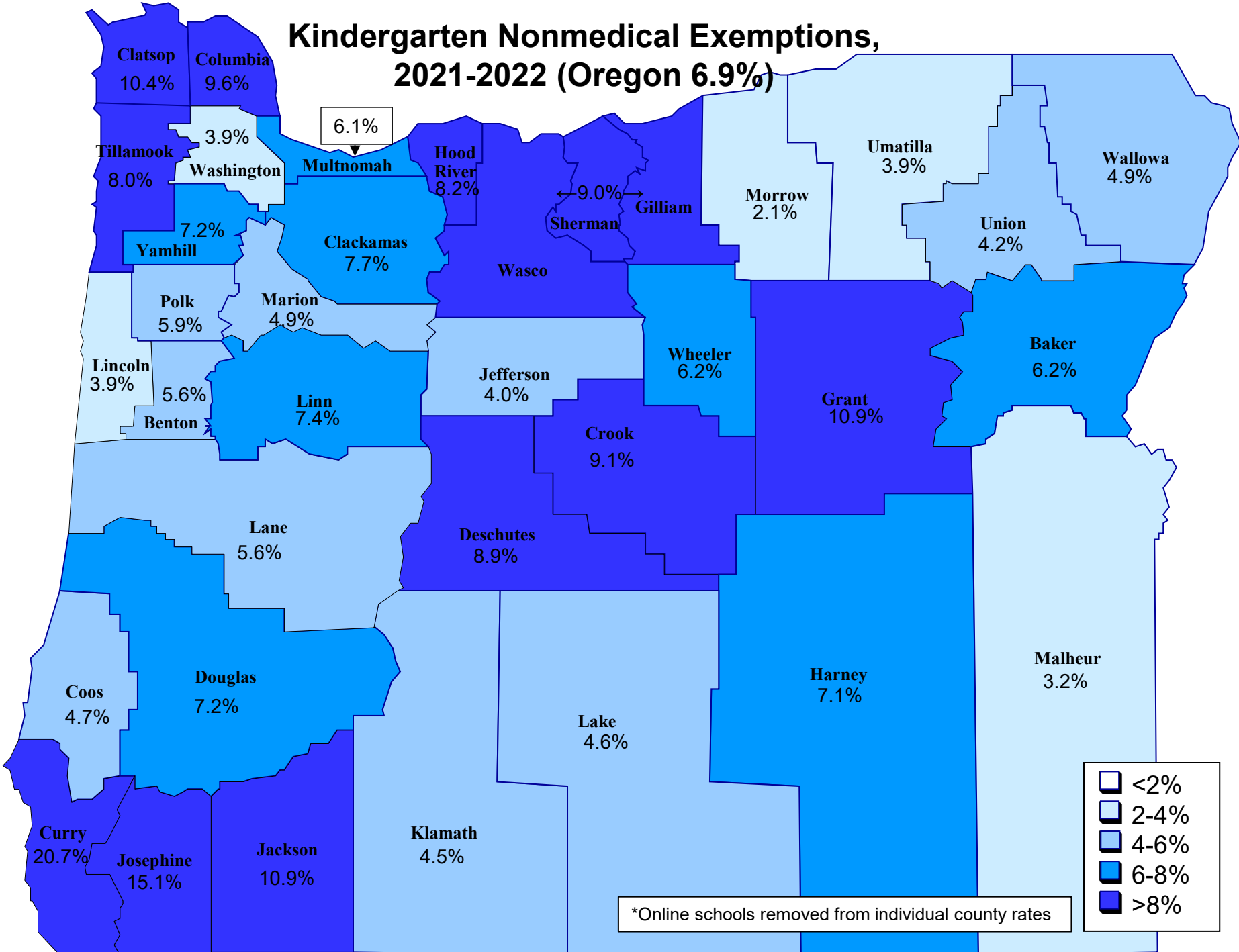

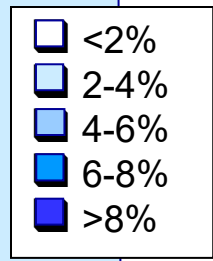

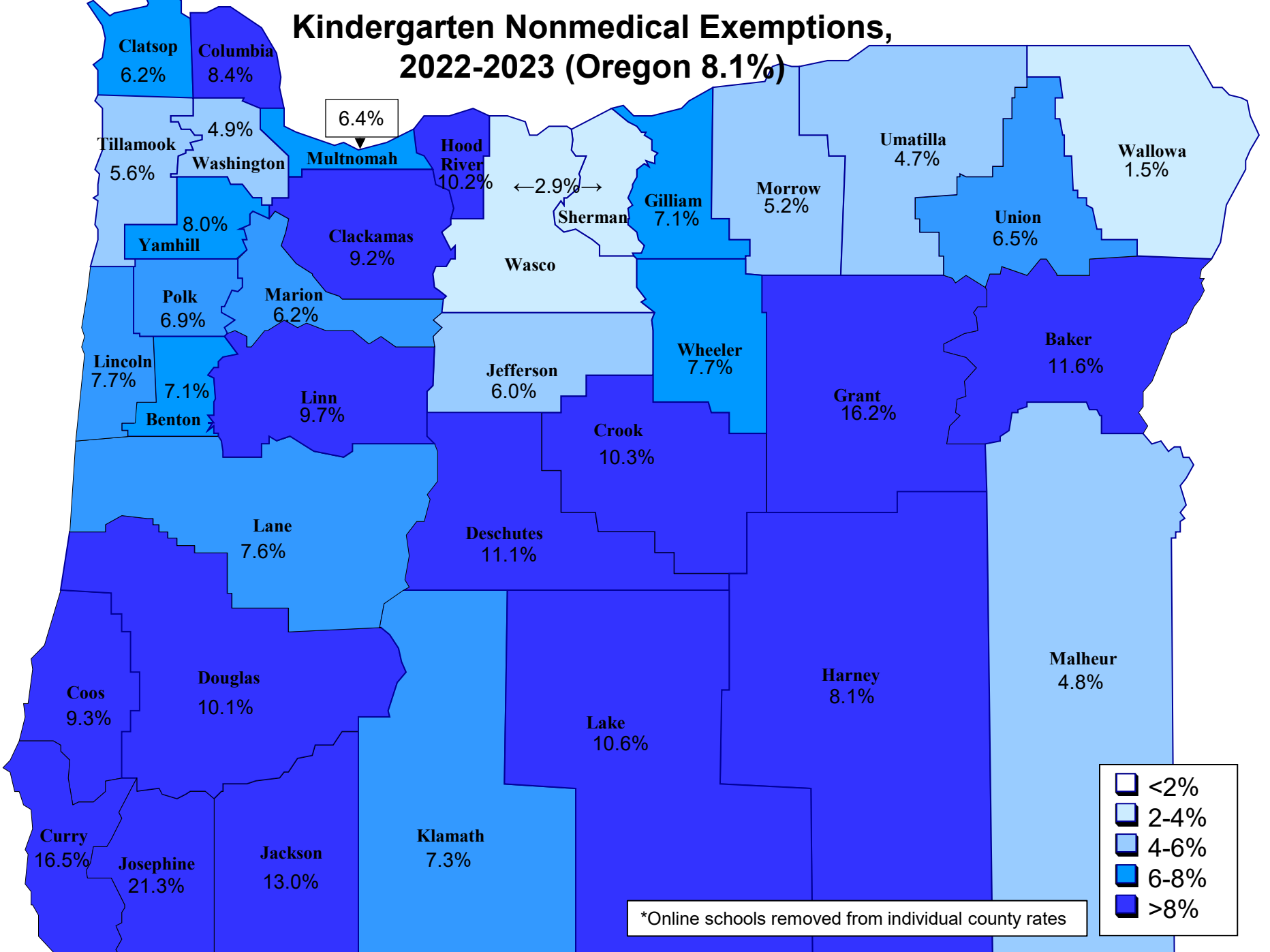

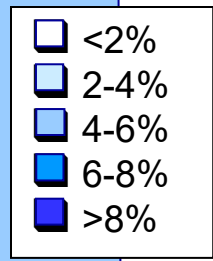
