Q: Epilinks question: When we link a case to a school outbreak, do we also automatically update the Epilink to OB (if not first onset) or does it stay SP until exposure/transmission relationship is further assessed? **Time Stamp 22:16**

Q: I thought that if someone is even a 2nd gen OB member, that the OB epi-link "trumped" all other Epilink types? **Time Stamp 26:39**

Q: Would you like the list view to be the default? **Time Stamp 27:18**

Q: Can we add a "none" option to the Public Settings Followup questionnaire? Some people really have not been anywhere during their infectious period (e.g. PUMs who became positive) **Time Stamp 32:54**
