## New Follow-up Questions Added to “Risks”

- Seven new follow-up questions were added to the “Risks” Questions
- These were added to improve school outbreak tracking
- When you answer “**Yes**” to “**Did the case have any close contact with a confirmed case?**”, the following questions will appear:
  - “Household contact of another lab confirmed COVID-19 case?”
  - “Community contact with another lab-confirmed COVID-19 case-patient?”
  - “Any healthcare contact with another lab-confirmed COVID-19 case-patient?”
- When you answer “**Yes**” to “**Does the case work in a healthcare setting?**”, the following question will appear:
  - “Do they provide direct patient care?”
- When you answer “**Yes**” to “**Did case attend or work at school?**”, the following questions will appear:
  - “Select all school settings that apply:”
  - If yes to higher education, does the case reside in on-campus housing (including Greek life housing)?”
  - “Was the student or staff fully remote?”

- When you answer “**Yes**” to “**Did the case work while ill?**”, the following question will appear:
  - “If case worked while sick, please indicate their work schedule?”
- When you answer “**Yes**” to “**For K-12 students only: Was the case on school campus while infectious?**”, the following questions will appear:
  - “Provide date the case was on campus:”
  - “For K-12 students only: Why was the case on campus while infectious?”
  - “For K-12 students only: What transportation to school or events (e.g., sports games) did the case use during their infectious period?”
