Oregon law provides cities and counties the opportunity to prohibit recreational marijuana businesses in their jurisdiction, with the exception of labs.

Local governments are required to refer ordinances banning recreational marijuana businesses to voters at the next general election.

Prior to December 27, 2015 cities and counties could implement local bans if 55 percent or more of voters in their jurisdiction voted against Measure 91 without referring the ordinance to voters.
