Todd Albert	192.311(4); definition of public body: include local government elected officials (like current language for "state officer")
TA	192.311(5)(a); definition of public record: include social media or other language to encompass current and future digital platforms
TA	<p>Fees</p> <p>192.324(4)(a):</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -change language to "up to actual cost"; -establish a tiered system for search, duplication, and review fees based on commercial, education or general request; -establish more detailed criteria with "including but not limited to" language for fee reductions and waivers -require fee reduction or waiver if public body's criteria is met
TA	<p>Exemptions white paper:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> -review feasibility of creating exemption categories rather than specific exemptions; list all "low-hanging fruit" (e.g., exemptions that have never been subject to AG order or judicial decision)
