

Good morning,

I wanted to share feedback from a law enforcement listserv where your agenda was shared. I will send each in a separate email. The comment below came from a City with a population of  $\sim$ 13K:

I don't know about anyone else, but the good majority of our records are under 10 pages, with an occasional 20 or 30 pages, but seldom ever have we done anything over 100 pages. We created a brand new position just for records for our agency, because we were so busy with records requests. That revenue does indeed offset the cost of funding the new position. It would be insane to implement some of these rules/restrictions. Please keep us in the loop on any updates on this.
