We have gotten large public records requests from social interest groups. Under this proposal, we wouldn't be able to charge the media, individuals or public interest groups anything for the time spent redacting documents. It also requires only the lowest paid employees who are available and capable of working on PRRs to do the work. This would increase the amount of PRR work for every agency in the state while taking away funding.


